Autocross

Points autocross number 3 was held at the Owensboro Daviess County airport on the last Saturday of June. 42 drivers took to the hot concrete to race around the Gene young designed course. Gene put together a nice layout on the cramped tarmac in front of the airport terminal. And for once there were a lot more SCCA members than guests.

Champion Ford Salesmen Tyler and Duke Brubaker brought over some new Fords for us to look at and one of them took a couple of rides in cars. Tyler got a ride in Jeff Jackson's 2003 Porsche Boxster and Paul Dornburg's 1973 Porsche 911. Wonder what he thought about the 2 Porsches so different in age? I'm sure you all know the first question any parts guy asks these days is what does it fit on? Can you imagine the look on their faces when they start punching in 1973 Legrand? Ask Bob to tell you the story the next time you see him.

Jeff Jackson returned to the autocross wars in Owensboro. In the fast time category he was the only top 10 car that wasn't a modified, the Boxster being a B Stock car. Driving all the way from Olney IL were John Coen, Ted Eagleson and Frank Totten. Also putting miles on the car were Dr. Mario Matos from Vincennes, IN and Gary Niles from Elizabethtown, KY. Club regulars Jim Cannon and Steve Backer made their treks from the northeast area of the region.

You might wonder how Tim Green can win his class in Owensboro but finish third in the autocross points calculation. Did you? Well here's how. To win a class you must have the single fastest time of all the cars in that class. To win points for the autocross trophy you must make 1 good run in each of the two sessions. Those two fastest runs are added together and multiplied by a Performance Index number to get a total indexed time. The fastest total indexed time of all the drivers becomes the high point man that all are judged against. Take the total fastest indexed time and divide it by your total fastest indexed time and then multiply by 1000 to get your points. Simple isn't it?

Our next event is at the "Centre" in Evansville at the end of July. Come out and see Tom Bootz in the Dornburg 911. Hopefully we'll have a story soon about why Tom sold his LeGrand and is taking to the door slammers. Pre-register at MyAutoEvents.com and save two bucks.
