# March REport

On Saturday March 18<sup>th</sup> we'll be going to the Mid-American Air Center in Lawrenceville to work on the playground. The club is doing this as a "thank you" to the airport for letting us use the area for our autocrosses. We'd like to have help with our chores as we plan on putting a lot of mulch under the jungle gym while doing repairs/improvements to the other playground equipment. If you've got the time, let one of the Board members know. We'd love to have the help.

The second half of the SIR Bowling Tournament was held at Diamond Lanes South. Three members showed up to vie for the 1.5 million in monopoly money. Coming in third and receiving 400,000 was Tim Green. Tim rolled a 137 and a 112 for a total of 249. Carolyn Dornburg Got the 600,000 for second place with a 179 and a 152 for a 331 total. Barry will be competing in GT2 with his Ford powered Tiger while Tom Bootz will venture into the DSR class with his new racecar. We wish them all a lot of luck and to be safe.

April starts off with our annual Snow Buster autocross at "The Centre" in Evansville (also known as the Civic Center). You can register on-line at MyAutoEvents.com and save yourself two bucks or you could pre-register for the whole season. Contact Gene Young if you are interested. I've registered for the National Tour Event in Arkansas that weekend so you'll be missing me again.

I want to congratulate Bob Sonntag for getting the club 1<sup>st</sup> place Gold Medal in the "SCCA Small Region - Region Achievement" in 2005, as he also did in 2004 and 2003. The awards were handed out during the breakfast meeting at the National Convention. Dr. Jim Butler was gracious enough to attend the meeting to pick up the awards and then attended the February club membership meeting to hand them out.
