Our own 10 Time National Solo II Champion, Tom Bootz, was a contributor to the most recent edition of the SCCA's house organ, SportsCar. Tom was one of 10 tapped to write a piece about the "Secrets of Solo Masters". His advice for going faster was let a faster driver drive your car. Excellent advice that Tom proved to me last year when he drove my car and beat me every time out. Talk about an "Uppity Boy"! Despite the beating my ego took I was forced to look hard at what I was trying to do with the car. And I did improve.

Patch Party II was delayed a few weeks because of people's schedules and the weather. The second day was a gloomy one as light showers were present until noon when they got heavier. The July event at The Centre in Evansville has been moved to the following Saturday in Lawrenceville, the 22nd. The August Owensboro Airport event has been moved to Sunday the 20th. The events are posted on-line in 3 places, our website (www.sirscca.org), www.myautoevents.com and the Yahoo Groups SIRSCCA calendar. (http://groups.yahoo.com/) The Owensboro events changed days because the airport now has 2 flights on Saturday so we can't be on the tarmac. The July event changed at the request of the organizer of a car show at the Lawrenceville airport. He asked if we would consider putting on an autocross while they were putting on a car show in front of the airport terminal. We said yes and changed the July event to a week later, at Lawrenceville and on a Saturday.

In case you didn't know the SCCA has dropped the "II" after the Solo name. Now all autocrosses are Solo events. There's an article about the name change on the SCCA.org website. Here's the new logo.

Friends, Rivals, Meet in New Venue from Phil Wells



Over the first weekend in May, longtime friends, competitors, and multi-time National Solo Champions Bruce Domeck and Tom Bootz battled on the road

course at Indianapolis Raceway Park as Indy Region hosted its double regional races. Domeck, from Louisville (Ky Region) and Southern Indiana Region's Tom Bootz have long been competitors in B-Mod at the SCCA National Solo Championships with Domeck



campaigning his white/purple Ralt RT-4 and Bootz wielding his blue LeGrand (now owned by SIR's Bob Sonntag). While their competitive

numbers are the same with Domeck wearing his familiar number 28 and Bootz again showing #36, the vehicles to which those numbers are attached are different and the classes in which they compete are also different. While Domeck's Red Ralt RT-4 is a sister car to his autocross mount and competes in Formula Atlantic, Bootz' new steed is a brand new Speads sports racer that competes in D Sports Racing. It just so happened that at this particular race weekend, the FA and DSR classes were in the same run group which pitted the two competitors against each other on track, even though they were actually competing for different class honors. After suffering a suspension collapse in a Friday practice session and contemplating withdrawal from the weekend's races, Tom did some scurrying for repair parts and along with crew members,



Ryan Bootz and Terry Davis, secured a fix which would permit him to compete in both Saturday's and Sunday's races, both of which were necessary to allow him to achieve a National competition license. As his confidence in his repairs increased, his lap times correspondingly decreased. After qualifying 5th overall (1st in class) on Saturday, Tom finished 4th overall and retained his 1st in class position. On Sunday, after qualifying 6th overall (again 1st in class), he finished 4th overall but again was the champion in DSR. For his efforts, the corner workers designated Tom as the recipient of the "Hard Charger" award. Domeck

qualified on the pole for Saturday's race but dropped to 2nd overall while retaining his FA class win and on Sunday qualified 3rd and finished 3rd, again retaining his FA class win. Through much of Sunday's race, Domeck and Bootz were nose-to-tail with Tom setting a slightly faster single lap time but finishing about 10 seconds back after pushing perhaps a little too hard and having a slight off-course excursion.
