It is with great sadness that I write that our friend and my co-driver Ken Andrew died on June 2<sup>nd</sup> of complications from cancer. Ken became an SIR member in 1984 shortly after he moved his family to Evansville from Ft. Wayne. In the 22 years of their membership Ken and Nancy participated in all aspects of the club. Ken held some kind of Board position for 16 of those years. He was Regional Executive 6 times, Treasurer 3 times, Advisor or Assistant RE the rest of the times. Ken became my co-driver in late 1999 and drove the car for the last time at the 2006 Snow Buster. In between we had a great time as 2 friends sharing a common passion. At the last club meeting we all shared our thoughts about Ken. Here's what was said.

Tim Brown - when I joined SCCA in the early 80's, even though I drove a "turd" (Toyota Celica), he always encouraged me. When I quit to raise kids, he would always ask about what was going on. Just very personable. When I did return he always encouraged and supported me with words of advice.

Darrin Bailey - never a dull moment.

Teresa Bailey - his relationship with his wife, Nancy. To watch the two cut up. He always added a little extra spice to the meetings. Mimsie Coen- at Owensboro I was taking pictures and learning everyone's name, I asked if I could take his picture. He said, "I don't take a good picture." When I showed him the picture on the camera, he smiled and said, "Maybe you'd like to take another one?" John Coen – The Halloween rally and his red costume, "The Driver of Death"

Jim Cannon - He always thought of the club as a wonderful group of people. For several years he led the group. He picked up a lot more cones than he ever knocked over. He always dealt with issues respectfully. I remember Nancy commenting about the rare holiday that the entire family was in and when they sat down to eat, Ken would be sitting at the head of the table, just looking at everyone and smiling.

Tom Bootz - I remember him hacking & coughing with tongue out - and he says, "never-mind me, just choking on my own spit." Jan Bootz - His laugh. Inventive and creative, he just had a ball.

Terry Davis- back in old days, sharing a room in Wabash, and we went out to eat, "Saddle Up" to the bar, he ordered a martini and said to the waitress, "I would like some olives, not a wimpy olive, a big olive." --- I later got him a bottle of BIG olives. Incontinent rally - shaking my water bottle. Finally got far enough ahead to stop by some woods so he could do his business.

Gary Heck - I first met Ken as members of the Optimists club, when autocross's were done to support the Rally events. Ken was involved with the auto club and he got me involved. When I bought Ken's Porsche 914, stale gas & it smoked. Ken said, "it's a fine machine" then that laugh. Another memory is Ken going to Nationals without a ride I let him borrow my Miata. He brought back a great picture in the car. He would have been proud of his children, the way the handled themselves at visitations.

Jim Barrow - a perfect gentleman at all times. Remember, trying to keep up with Bob on the Christmas Light Tour, saying I had to do 75. Ken said, "We were going 85."

Glenn Wior - first autocross I participated in, I brought a helmet from Simpson Racing where I use to work. It was a \$6000 dollar carbon fiber helmet used in Indy car racing. He wouldn't let me use it due to the expired Snell rating, so I had to wear a sweaty loaner.

Gene Young - I heard there was a car club in Evansville, but I didn't know anyone involved. I went to a KY race and they gave me Ken's phone number. I was hesitant to call, but I finally did. He was very welcoming.

Mike Freeman - digging through pictures, Ken was always up for a good time, even if he was the butt of the joke. The first event we can place Ken participating in was a Rally put on by Jimmy?? & Rosie put on early 80's, and he came back.

Barry Schonberger - impressed with how he came in and just got involved. Represented us well as a class act. National Convention trip to receive awards, Ken's red "brothel" van with the stereo, speakers and lights. Drove all night. Last night of conference, banners - Road America and Goodyear banners acquired from the hotel, just like kids. Kent, as a kid, remembers the Freedom Festival meeting friendly and warm. - Class act guy.

Paul Dornburg- the time he beat me in my Porsche and he wouldn't let me take his picture. Every now and then I would sneak one in. Always wore shorts, even when it wasn't "shorts" weather.
