August REport

As you read the next paragraph keep in mind that I am not complaining. I am just trying to explain a problem and my solution to it.

At the first Owensboro autocross a lot of people told me that they pre-registered for the event yet I did not see their entry on-line. Knowing that people generally won't fib to save two dollars I took their word for it and gave them the discount. I looked at the entry list after the event and it was no different than before the event so I'll have to make some rules here to prevent future occurrences of this sort. I don't want our registrar (the money collector) to be put on the spot by someone whose name is not on the list of pre-entrants. It puts them in an awkward position because if they balk at someone's statement that they did pre-register they basically are saying that the person is fibbing. And I don't want anyone in that position. So here are the rules.

The registration deadline is 6:00 PM the day before the event. After 6:00 you're out of luck.

The pre-entry list will be posted on the trailer by the signup window.

If your name is not on the list you're going to pay \$20

If you have trouble registering on-line send me an email and I will do it for you.

We have been using myautoevents.com for over 3 years and it works nicely after one learns how to use it. Nuff said. We finally held the Owensboro Airport autocross on Saturday July 14th. This time Mother Nature gave us a beautiful

day and 33 drivers came out to compete. Almost half (16) of the drivers were guests. Gene Young laid out a different looking course that gave a lot of the less experienced drivers fits when trying to find the gates. Bob Sonntag set fast time of the day at 36.173 seconds. At the other end of the scale was first time autocrosser Melvin Little in his Chevrolet Syclone at 56.400 seconds. Results should be in this paper.

The Bowler autocross was another successful event. It was a fun with a good mixture of hot rods and autocrossers. For some the long day started as early as 5:30 AM and ended as late as 9:30 PM but I'm sure all felt it was worth it. I remember the cloud of clutch smell that lingered at the start line after Tim Brown told Tom Bootz he could slip the clutch more. Then there was Juls Seeber looking for her son, 13 year old Mitch, who was over at the Air-Ride display showing everyone how the Air-Ride system worked. Jim Cannon taking my 911 for a spin, literally. I could go on but I'll save them for the August club meeting.

Every year the club trailer ends up at Gene Young's house for it's annual refurbishment. This year Gene did another terrific job, replacing the rotting window covers, adding insulation to the roof, replacing interior shelves and legs and marking the floor for cone placement. It may not sound like much but it was a lot of work. Thanks to Gene and his helpers for the improvements. And a big "Thanks" to Don Kelley for supplying the aluminum diamond plate for the new window covers. In a few weeks we'll see the new scoring monitor courtesy of Gary Heck. Without the help of all these volunteers and donators our club trailer would be in dire straights.

The Solo Nationals are just around the corner and if you are thinking about going you need to start making arrangements like filing your entry and reserving a hotel room. Let me know if you need any help. I think there's a block or rooms reserved for the SIR group.

There is a good program going on called Street Survival. Here's an explanation of the program.

Formed in April 2002 by the BMW Car Club of America Foundation, the Street Survival® safe teen driving program was launched. With the help of several corporate sponsors (BMW of North America, ZF Corporation of North America, The Tire Rack, and Liberty Mutual Insurance), Street Survival® was initiated. Street Survival[™] is built upon the premise that 'safe driving is learned by doing.' From the outset, Street Survival[™] has always been "hands on" and designed to go beyond the typical high school driver's education program. The program teaches students to avoid accidents by thinking and looking ahead. Street Survival[®] is unique in that it offers students instruction in their own cars so that they learn the limitations of their 'daily drivers.'

The year 2003 was the pilot year for Street Survival® and several successful schools were held around the country. In 2004, more than a dozen schools providing instruction for several hundred students will have been held. The year 2005 had 18 successful schools across the country. During 2006, 34 schools were held, training even more teenagers to become safe, responsible drivers. Our goal for 2007 is 50 schools, from New Hampshire to California and Florida to Washington. Most of us are aware of the carnage that occurs on American highways and good driver education will help reduce accidents. With your support and help, the goal of the BMW Car Club of America Foundation Street Survival® program will help make our teenagers safer drivers.

On July 26th the SCCA announced its involvement with the program. If you go to the SCCA home page you can find the link to it or type in "street survival" in the search window to find the article. This is something we need to do for our young drivers.

That's all for this month. Remember the club meeting is at the Log Inn and Bob needs a head count from all that plan to attend. The Mid-year autocross is August 5th at Lawrenceville, another autocross at Owensboro on August 19th and a Southern Illinois autocross at Lawrenceville on August 25th.
