After the service awards we got down to presenting the serious hardware. First up was the Rookie of the Year Award. It was a close battle for the title that was finally won by Mitchell Seeber over Kyle Bledsoe. If you've not been to any of our events you've missed out on Mitch's constant energy and enthusiasm. The look on his face when he was presented the award was priceless. I hope this is just the beginning of his club involvement.

Next on the agenda were the Road Rally awards. We had seven events this year that counted towards the trophy.

All alone in third place was Julie Seeber. Julie had 2 wins and 2 thirds on her way to the trophy. Gene Young and Paul Dornburg shared second place. Gene also had 2 wins and 2 thirds while Paul had 3 wins and 3 seconds with 4 different drivers or navigators. On the top step of the podium was the undefeated team of Bob Sonntag and Terry Davis. They entered 5 rallys and won every one of them. They get to split the traveling trophy for the coming year.

Gary started the Autocross Trophy presentation with some quick facts about the season. To summarize, the scores were closer and the winning margin was just slightly larger than last year. With the best 6 scores counting, out of 7, you had to be fastest in at least two events in order to be in the running for first place. Third place finisher Jim Cannon had 2 fast times and was just 7 points out of second place. Tim Brown finished second in points, 25 behind first place with fast times in 4 events. Jim and Tim waged a yearlong battle in the Street Tire Class with Tim holding sway but neither driver could catch Paul Dornburg and his 911. He made every autocross, which allowed him to drop his lowest score. That was an advantage that neither Jim nor Tim had as they each missed one event. Paul was just 11 points from a perfect 6000 points on his way to his fourth title in the last 7 years.

The last trophy to be handed was the Berry Trophy. The Berry Trophy is given to the club member who accumulates the most participation points throughout the year. You've got to get to a lot of events to beat this years quartet of winners. Gene Young had 76 points to come in third. Paul Dornburg and Terry Davis tied for second with 83 points while Bob Sonntag was the points hog with 98. I meant to count how many times Bob has received this award in the last few years but missed it. Maybe this year I can get some history about the trophy from the long time members.

The Ken Andrew Indian Award was not awarded this year. We started looking for candidates in June. Through the last half of the year we looked for people who exemplified what the award stood for. Our criteria are very subjective. Who was at all (or most) of the events and supported the club like he/she was a board member? We didn't feel that anyone fit that criteria this year, hence no award.
