February **RE**port

This will be another ambitious year for our region. We've got a full schedule of rallys and autocrosses starting in February all the way through November wrapping up with our awards banquet the second Friday of December.

Coming up real quick is the national convention in San Antonio. I've received a bunch of emails from the National office all but begging me to attend but it's not in the cards this year. Our own Dr. Jim Butler has agreed to pick up any awards we may have garnered. The latest email from the Region Development Manager advised me we will be getting an award but he could not divulge what it was lest put a hit out on me. As such we will be holding the February club meeting on Wednesday the 13<sup>th</sup> instead of Tuesday the 12<sup>th</sup> so mark your calendars.

Speaking of the convention, there has been a lot of conversation on a Solo Chairman email list about the temporary membership that regions will be required to administer for all Solo and Rally events. What that means is that any quests that choose to participate in our events will have to pay a premium for a temporary membership. That premium can be applied towards a full time membership within a given period of time. What we have yet to decide is how big that premium is going to be. Nationals suggests \$15. We'll decide on the price at next month's board meeting.

In the December PitStop I tried calling to task all the non-participating members of our club. I hope I didn't step on any toes as I tried to understand your thinking

process. And there are members that do put in time for the SCCA although it may not be for our region. Dr Jim Butler comes to mind. But I still want to see more participation by our missing members especially when we put on the Street Survival event.

In case vou've been wondering what the Street Survival event is let me explain. (and see the document on the next page) The event will be a one-day event probably on a Saturday in June or July. It will be a driver education for teen drivers. The Teens will be in their daily drivers and will be instructed by our club members. The driving involves hard braking and lane changes on dry payement. Then the surface is wetted with soap and water and the drivers are put through oversteer and understeer exercises. We'll need about 15 instructors and at least 20 support people. There will be registration, car safety checks, tire inspections, classroom instruction, breaks with drinks and snacks, lunch, driving, more snacks and drinks with a final recap session and awards. It will be a full day for everyone involved but well worth it if we can teach just one driver how to deal with their vehicle in an extreme situation. Getting ready for the event will involve talking to the media to get the word out. We'll be appealing to parents and grandparents to enroll their kids in the program and drag them to the event. Perhaps the biggest obstacle right now is securing a site for the event. Gary Heck has been making presentations to the Evansville government asking to use one of the Roberts Stadium parking lots. We'll need a good-sized lot, 400' x 600', which is why we targeted Roberts

Stadium. Gary is keeping us informed of the progress in his talks. As the event draws nearer we'll be calling asking for your help.

The first SCCA Tour Event is the next weekend in Cecil Georgia, February 23<sup>rd</sup> and 24<sup>th</sup>.

Bob's got an event on the schedule for February 29<sup>th</sup>, the extra day of leap year.

Then there's Easter, which is followed by our annual Snow Buster autocross on Sunday March 30<sup>th</sup> at the Owensboro Airport. 9tenatively) We've been very lucky with the weather for this event and I'm hoping this year is no different with warm temperatures and no rain.

I thought Tom got a lot of air time, considerably more than anyone else that wasn't running up front. # **FAST FACTS**

# How big a problem are accidents and deaths from teen driving?

According to NHTSA, in 2004 alone, 7,386 people perished behind the wheel of a car due to crashes involving drivers aged 16 - 20.

#### What is Tire Rack Street Survival?

The Tire Rack Street Survival<sup>™</sup> program is a teen driving school held at local venues around the country and run by the BMW Car Club of America Foundation. Its goals are to teach students the basics of car control, to enhance their enjoyment of driving and to improve their competence as drivers. Students learn how their actions govern their own car's responses and therefore become safer, more effective drivers.

### How does the program work?

Accompanied by a trained driving instructor giving real-time feedback, students maneuver their cars through acceleration, turning and braking exercises laid out with orange traffic cones in a closed parking lot. They experience each exercise element several times in order to learn from their mistakes and to improve their skills. There is no stopwatch or head-to-head competition with other cars.

# What makes Street Survival different from other programs?

Students use their own cars so they learn the behaviors and limitations of the vehicles they will be driving every day. In addition, students, parents and community leaders may request a Street Survival school come to their neighborhood by visiting <a href="https://www.streetsurvival.org">www.streetsurvival.org</a>.

#### How many Street Survival schools are scheduled for 2008?

The goal is to hold at least 50 schools across the country.

#### Who is eligible to participate in the program?

Any licensed driver aged 16 - 21 can participate. Permitted drivers 16 or older may participate if they meet state legal requirements and have held their permit at least half the period required by the state. Parents are encouraged to attend with their teenager.

#### How much does a school cost?

The cost is \$60 per student, payable by Visa or MasterCard only when registering for a specific school.

# **Annual Leap Day Event**

This year is a leap year and that means we will have our annual February 29<sup>th</sup> activity later this month. This year's edition will be a low-tech take on a geo-cache rally event. NO GPS technology required! A map and a compass will suffice. That's all I used to set up the route.

The event will start from the US 41 North Hardee's restaurant in Evansville. Tech and registration will start at 6:30 P.M. The plan is to have the first car depart about 7:15. The route is full paved. This is NOT a Time/Speed/Distance event. Bring a means of knowing which way is north and have a map. More information will be shared at the February membership meeting. That additional information will be whether the helpful maps will be of the country, the continent, or the world. If things go according to plan we will all be socializing at the post-route gathering about 9:15.

As our first with-car event this year this will also be our first event that requires ALL entrants to be members. This is a new requirement by the SCCA. As a region we will still have a separate class for "guest" entrants in our events. If you have been playing cars with us as a guest, you are still most welcome to join us...either for events or to become members. Or better yet both! If you are not an SCCA member, in addition to the \$20 (\$18 with pre-registration) entry fee, there will be another \$15 required for the weekend membership fee. The \$15 weekend membership comes with a coupon for \$15 off of an SCCA membership, so it is possible to recoup \$15.
