Planning for our first Rallycross was well underway when it hit a snag. The venue is having some problems and is not sure the site will be available so we've decided to postpone the event. We'll be looking for another site if Windy Hollow is not available.

I went to my first SCCA Convention this month. I attended a lot of meetings and gathered a lot of information about the SCCA and how it functions. One thing that stuck in my mind dealt with new people that show up to our meetings or events. When they show up do we ask them to join the club? I've not ever done that but I will in the future.

I sat in a meeting of Rallycross enthusiasts and picked up quite a few pointers for putting on a Rallycross. There were a lot of good conversations about timing and scoring, course setup and event planning. I had to laugh when they talked about putting spectators upwind, so they could see what was going on.

I attended another meeting about Road Rallys. The presenter had kept Rallys put on by a 5 time Rally champion from the early days of the Rally program. It was called a Month of Rallys and consisted of 28 different rallys written by the champ. One that stood out in my mind instructed the teams to drive to a place, stop the car, remove and install the spark plugs then go back to the start. The spark plug R&R was timed and penalty points assessed after all teams had completed the task. Then it returned them to the same place where the navigator had to carry the driver around the car. It also was scored after all teams had completed the task. You'll have to attend the March club meeting to hear about more of them.

One of the things I was looking forward to at the convention was the Region awards handed out at the Thursday luncheon. In the past our region had been the recipient of the Small Region Achievement Award on numerous occasions and I was hoping that this year would be no different but alas the award went to the Chattanooga Region. This year the awards were determined statistically and we didn't do as well in the measurement areas. I believe we need to put more effort into converting the weekend members into full members and making sure we retain the members we currently have. It's a topic the Board will talk about in the next few meetings.

While at the convention I talked with the guys that run motorsportreg.com and learned a few more things about their service. They told me about some options with their system and I told them I'd come back and talk to you about them. I'll do that at the March club meeting.

The Great Lakes Division, of which our region is a member, is holding a Solo Series. Unfortunately for us the events are centered around northeast Indiana at Toledo, OH, Columbus, OH, Oscoda, MI and Peru, IN. Here's what the SCCA says about these Divisional Championships.

## **DIVISIONAL CHAMPIONSHIPS**

Currently an optional program for all of SCCA's nine Divisions, the Tire Rack® SCCA Divisional Championships have been developed to create a clear ladder to National Solo competition. Participating Divisions will crown class champions in whichever manner they chose, whether it be through a point series or one winner-takes-all event.

Beyond the experience and confidence gained by taking part in events at the Divisional level, Soloists competing in the Tire Rack SCCA Divisional Championships will benefit via contingency programs and National Championship eligibility. Divisions enrolled in the new program can expect increased support from the National office in the way of fees and promotional items.

Additionally, Divisions will compete against each other in the Tire Rack SCCA Division Cup Challenge at the Tire Rack Solo National Championships. Each participating Division will earn points based on their total entries, number of rookie drivers and number of trophies earned. The Division accumulating the most points will earn the "Tire Rack Division Cup."

Bridgestone has already signed on as a contingency sponsor for the Tire Rack SCCA Divisional Championships. Soloists competing on Bridgestone tires in select classes will be eligible for cash awards if they finish in the top three of their Division's Championship standings. Drivers must register for the program before competing, and run with the required decals. Online registration will be available soon by logging in at scca.com and selecting Contingency from the Events tab.

I'm hoping to make a couple of these events probably at Peru. Judging by the other division's calendars our division has a pretty good chance at "Tire Rack Divisional Cup". I hope some of you soloists will join me in supporting the series.
