August Report

Let me tell you what happened to me the last weekend in June.

Sunday June 28th was the day for our autocross points event #2. I was hoping to debut the turbo 911 that day but I made myself sick and here's how I did it.

I took Friday June 26th off to work on the 911 and that included hauling out to Gene's house for fuel injection tuning. (remember the paragraph in the last newsletter where I thanked Gene for his help?) It was very, very hot that day and I sweated out a lot of fluid. I drank lots of water to keep from getting dehydrated.

Then Saturday the 27th, another blistering day, I worked on the 911 adding weight to make it legal for the addition

of the turbo. Again I drank a lot of water to replace all the fluid I was sweating.

On the day of the autocross I had no energy. (kind of like the feeling you have when you get mono) I went out to the truck and drove it around back to hook up the trailer but I just couldn't do it. I sat in the truck for about 10 minutes before deciding I wasn't going autocrossing. I went back in the house and went to bed. Carolyn called Tim Green and he stopped by and got some stuff that would be needed for the event. I spent the day in bed drinking lots of GatorAde and trying to eat. I had intestinal cramps so bad I thought I had a hernia. I finally started feeling normal about Wednesday.

The moral of the story is that it takes more than water to keep your body healthy. Food and drink that replenish the chemicals you sweat are also vitally important. (I can see our Dr. members rolling their eyes now) So that's why I missed the autocross event and it's also my excuse for not being the autocross champion this year. (I'm planning ahead)

Speaking of planning ahead the August Membership Club meeting is being held at the Log Inn in Warrenton IN. Just drive up 41 from Evansville and turn right after you drive under I-64. Drive another mile more or less and it's on the left. The food is served home style which means you order your meat and they bring out a plate of the meat along with bowls of vegetables. There is always more food than one can (or should) eat and it delicious. It's typically one of our best attended meetings so get there early to get started on the food. We'll ask the waitresses to start taking orders as the tables fill up. That will speed up the order taking and fulfillment process and keep the meeting from lasting too long. For Owensboro members it's worth the trip to this meeting because I'm going to be out of town so there will not be an Owensboro meeting in August. Be there around 6:30 for a fine meal. One more thing, They accept checks and cash but not credit cards. (at least that was the case last year)

Elsewhere in this newsletter are the results from the June 28th and July 12th autocross events. I missed the June 28th event (see the first story above) but was at the July 12th event. In both events the attendance was down from our 37 average with only about 20 drivers at each. In June they made 7 runs and in July 8 runs were made. In both events the course was setup to avoid areas of the concrete that had deteriorated since the patch party in April. Our "Ramp" on the north side of the course had become more pronounced and may require a day of repair in order to continue using that part of the course. The Board is having that discussion.

Another event that transpired was the Bowler Transmission "Day at the Drags" autocross event on Saturday July 18th. The club conducts an SCCA style autocross for Bowler Transmission. Club members that volunteer to work are rewarded with free runs after the course is set up before the Bowler event begins. Bob Sonntag was the on-site head honcho this year because I was in transit after a week of work in Maryland. Bob has written a report on the event which is in this newsletter. Next year we will begin asking for firm commitments from club members earlier in the year because each year we barely get enough people to help. A big "Thank you" to all of you who helped out at the event.

Upcoming August events include 2 points autocrosses on August 2nd and 23rd, a Southern Illinois/Southern Indiana joint autocross event on August 9th and the "Sillyness Repeated" rally on August 30th.

Looking a little bit farther at least 3 club members will be making the journey to Lincoln Nebraska for the Solo Nationals. This is the first year the Nationals are being held at Lincoln Airpark and it's a return to a concrete surface after 3 years on the asphalt of Heartland Park Topeka. The site is so big that there will be a practice course open while the 2 competition courses are being used. A problem that is unique to a concrete surface with lots of cars on it is slag buildup on the tires. The best place to see what the buildup looks like is during a NASCAR Cup race when they show the tires taken off the race car after a pit stop. All that buildup happens at a concrete autocross. By the way that forum also has some great discussions about car classification, car preparation and event results. If you are interested in what is going on in the world of SCCA road racing, autocrossing or rally it's a good site to read. There is also an official SCCA forum at http://www.sccabb.com. It's not as well attended as the other website but it is moderated by the SCCA so it's a way to get your voice heard if you have something to say.

Day at the Strip

The 2009 edition of Bowler Transmission's "Day at the Strip" was a success. The weather was nearly too good to believe. For some it was a bit cool in shorts and for others it was very comfortable shorts. Either way the temperature was nearly perfect. It wasn't too sunny and the spotty cloud cover never really threatened rain. No alarms were raised when a few drops were felt.

For the first time ever, we ran one of our complete Lawrenceville layouts for the Day at the Strip. Running counter-clockwise the main slalom was set with 75 ft gates and we added some offsets to the straight that leads to the finish turn. We also tightened up finish turn entry to avoid the high-style finish line spins. It didn't take us long to get the course out and start getting some seat times ourselves. Club members and those that came to work the event managed 50 scored runs in the course of the day.

Bob Sonntag and Terry Davis had a solid plan for the day and few refinements were made in the course of the day. The tweaks to the plan for next year's event are already happening. With help from some club members, a visiting new Southern Illinois Region member, and with wonderful help from some non-members we managed to staff the event. There were also some quiet volunteers from Air Ride that just wondered out to the course to cover a few pylons.

Thanks to club members Bob Sonntag, Terry Davis, Berry Beaman, Chris, Carrie, and Miles Moore, Mike Freeman, Jim Cannon, Darrin and Teresa Bailey, Allen and Cathy Christy, Gene Young and Julia Grundhoefer Seeber. Ivan Bonnenberger too. Thanks also to new Southern Illinois Region member Brian Hanson who drove in from Carbondale, IL to help. From the University of Evansville SAE club we had Michael Hughes, Ian McGiffen, Seth Spencer, Eric Bunner, Chase Miller, and Ethan Meek. Nothing much beats young legs in running down pylons. Jumping in with both feet were Duane and Jeremy Duke from Henderson, KY. We had met them for the first time at the July 12 autocross and volunteered at the membership meeting to help with the event. Mitchell Seeber spent the day in the trailer working timing and scoring and keeping track of pylons and DNFs as they were called from the course. That was a huge help as calls from the course seemed to coincide with queuing-up the next driver.

For most of the day we had two cars on course, one at the start line, and one on deck. Solo event manage does not get much better than that when registration is being done on the fly. By the end of the day, the 57 drivers were in the scoring system had completed 450 runs. A few drivers managed only a run or two. Had there been a prize for the most runs it would have gone to Mario Matos and Steven Rupp with 22 each. Of the 57 drivers, 23 were workers for the event. Air Ride Technologies came over from Jasper, Indiana for a day of autocrossing. There were a few drivers representing Bowler Transmission and the remaining drivers filled out the two classes competing for a set of tires and other such prizes. Unofficial results have the winner of the 1980-and-older class as Brian Finch who drove his Corvette to a 47.524. The 1981-and-newer unofficial winner was Bill Howell with a 49.910 and was done with a Corvette.

In addition to the usual collection of performance cars from Air Ride, this year we had Steven Rupp's Bad Penny Camaro all the way from California. Phil Gerber driving a beautiful green Buick came along to kick the competition level up a notch or three. The event concluded with Tom McBride driving Bad Penny to a time slightly better (by .010) than Steven's own best time. Oops! Steven hopped in and tried to better his time. Following Steven to the line for a final run and hoping for it to be a "best of all" was Phil in the green machine. Steven drove hard. Too hard. He hit a pylon going into the finish straight. Phil managed to do just a bit better...sort of. He didn't hit pylons and DNF until at the finish. The fun-spirited competition at the end of the day was a thrilling end to an enjoyable event.

Better set the third weekend of July 2010 aside for next year's Day at the Strip.




