October Report

At the October Evansville club meeting we will be taking nominations for club officers. You may not know that the current roster consists of people who have been serving for a million years. Okay, maybe just a few years but the point is that we have very little turnover, which isn't necessarily bad, but new thoughts and opinions help keep the club on a progressive path and avoid burnout of the current Board members. The obligation is not big, just show up at Board meetings and offer your thoughts and opinions about current club activities. It helps if you keep up with things going on in the national scene through websites and forums. Attending divisional and national meetings and events helps, but is not required. You just need some common sense and an understanding of the club laws to be a Board member. Think about it and volunteer.

September was the "Big" month for the SCCA with National events for the Solo drivers in Lincoln, NE and the road racers at Road America in Elkhart Lake, WI.

Labor Day week some 1160 Solo drivers converged on Lincoln Air Park in Lincoln Nebraska for a week of autocrossing. Words and pictures cannot begin to describe how big this place is. I'm glad I brought a bike to get around. We were paddocked in row 10 almost ¼ mile north of the competition courses and at least that far north of us was the test and tune course. I didn't see the paddock completely full but it had to be ¾ full Tuesday or Wednesday. If you missed the September club meetings you missed the slide show and stories. Here's condensed results. Terry and I finished 21st and 23rd out of 23 in SSM (Super Street Modified) because it rained on our second day of competition. Bob finished 13th out of 15 in what I thought was a great competition amongst the B Mod crowd. Except for the rain during our heat on Wednesday the weather was warm, sunny and mild. The Welcoming Party Monday night was at the Museum of American Speed which is right across the street from Speedway Motors and it was spectacular. Make it a must see if you go to the 2010 Nationals.

Tom Bootz competed in the SCCA National Runoffs at Elkhart Lake. He qualified 4th and made a decent start but a few laps into the race the engine gave up. I don't know the details but I'm hoping Tom will be at the October club meeting to tell us his stories from the week.

In the last newsletter I said the first 6 autocross events at Mid-American Air Center in Lawrenceville had been held under beautiful skies. The September event wasn't as nice as rain plagued us all day long. A downpour during the drivers meeting was the hardest it rained before tapering off to mist for most of the afternoon. Chris Moore gave us a new course design that we'd really like to run in the dry. We utilized a new section of patched concrete that shortened the slalom and crossed us over the course for a run to the finish. One thing I noted is how much grip our concrete has when wet when compared to the concrete at Lincoln. At Lincoln I could not turn or put the power down but a Lawrenceville I really had good grip in the wet. Terry says it has to do with the stone used in the concrete mix. As we were loading up the car the sun broke through just long enough to make me work up a sweat. As soon as the car was on the trailer it got cloudy again.

Our annual Awards Banquet/Christmas Party is Friday, December 4th. I can guess that the menu will be beef, chicken, pork and fish but it's not definite yet. The details will be in the November Pit Stop and also distributed through email. Make plans to be at this always fun night.

I'm still working with St Mary's hospital to support their Teen Driver Academy and they are helping me get students for another Street Survival school. Stay tuned for details on when and where we will hold our next school.

We will not have a Rally Cross in October. I can't get a Rally Cross Safety Steward lined up to match a date we have open but I'll keep working on it.

There's an SSCA Tour event at Blytheville Arkansas on the weekend of October 24th. Registration is open and it needs entrants. It's a good way to get the experience of the Solo Nationals but on a much smaller scale. Check it our in the Solo section on www.scca.com.

October Activities Update

Here is the latest on our activities. In the short form, is there is one more autocross event and three rallies (if this article is published before the fourth) to finish out the year. The year-end point standings are published elsewhere in this issue. Check them out. Then plan to come improve your position in the standings.

Autocross final standings are determined totaling autocross points from the best 6 of 7 event scores. The first place trophy may be all locked up by Bob Sonntag. However, the rest of the positions are up for grabs. Many of drivers have missed more than one event so those drivers have pretty much been eliminated from the top of the end of year standings. If you are one of those drivers, your participation in the October 11 autocross could greatly improve your position.

Of those seen within striking distance of a year-end trophy, Paul Dornburg, Terry Davis, and Yancy Smith have points only from 5 events. Based on previous event performance each of these drivers can be expected to improve his position by at least 910 points. Paul and Terry have both put in 1000 point performances earlier this year. After the rain at the September events, Paul's Nationals tires are still quite fresh. Can either take the top points again? Bob (975), Berry Beaman (957), Jim Cannon (937), Brad Mull (905), Allen Christy (886), Cathy Christy (873), Gene Young (780), Julia Young (787), and Mike Buente (780) already have six events scored and will have to better their lowest score to improve. The lowest score for these drivers is shown in parentheses.

The second half of the rally season is in full swing and as the temperatures begin to drop the rally competition is heating up. It's getting quite heated in fact. Terry Davis and Bob Sonntag present the October 4th rally. Paul and Carolyn Dornburg have the November 1st rally. Bob, Paul, and Carolyn are in a tie at the top of the rally standings. Carrie and Chris Moore (with Miles observing) hold the second spot and are well within striking distance of the top spot. Terry is in third. As rallymasters are given first place rally points, these three are assured of at least one more round of first place points. With our small rally turn outs, the competing team has a more than reasonable chance of a first place finish. Expect the final rally to be quite hotly contested. Will there be a Class A battle royal to settle things? Will one team switch to Class B in hopes of an easier or perhaps uncontested win? Join us for these rallies to make sure that there are no uncontested victories.

Jim Cannon is the rallymaster for the final 2009 rally – Sunday, November 15h. Jim has a history of routes on good rally roads and has frequently referenced some fun landmarks. (Though the "fun" of the water tower wasn't quite enjoyed in real-time.) This year Jim as a real treat lined up for us all. The rally will begin and end at the headquarters of Air Ride Technologies in Jasper. Club member Bret Voelkel of Air Ride will give us a tour of the shop and is helping Jim with the post-rally hospitality. It's sure to be the highlight event of our rally season and might well be the neatest club activity of the year.

That's the recap of our coming events. These events are sure to be fun. But each of them will certainly be the most fun YOU are participating too.
