

This is strange. I don't have to write a report for the Pit Stop but here I am anyway. I guess I'd better make it good. The 911 is apart after suffering a pinion gear failure at the last point event in October. I'm waffling over buying a new (to me) transmission to rebuild or just replace the ring and pinion with pieces I already bought.

What has me worried are some cracks in the side cover area of the differential housing. I could get them welded but I'm worried about how clean the weld would be because of oil contamination.



If this were a street application I wouldn't worry but the amount of torque the engine is now putting out has me concerned about the side cover being pushed off the side of the housing causing more problems. Decisions, decisions...

I'm getting some new pieces made for the fuel injection system. There's an insulation block/injector holder on each intake port. They're made out of a Bakelite material and are over 30 years old. I had to bore holes in them to hold the electric injectors and it wasn't a "clean" process. I ended up with some holes that I had to epoxy shut, and, in order to aim the injector properly and seal it in the fuel rail each block is machined differently. (see the little yellow lines in the top row of blocks?)



I'm getting some new blocks made up and I'm hoping I can get the injector angle the same for all the blocks so I can just make a jig for boring the holes. I'm going to use the stock non-turbo intake manifolds as guides for the new blocks I'm making.

One more thing I am considering is adding power steering to the car. I've got 2 feet of rubber on the ground in the front and there are times when I cannot turn the steering wheel fast enough. A few drives in modern cars has shown me that I'm not driving the car as hard as I should for fear of getting behind on the steering. You may be thinking, "won't that add a lot of weight?" yes, it will, but I've got over 200 lbs of ballast in the front of the car so I've got lots of weight I can remove. I need to call some steering rack manufacturers and see if they can provide what I need. Early 911s like mine never had power steering and the later models use a different rack that won't fit the early cars.





The unit on the center is what I need. Here's what the stock unit looks like.

I guess it's just a matter of how much I can afford to spend.

That's it for this month. Hopefully the weather will warm up so I can get to work in the garage. All I've got for heat is a side heater.
