August REport

What a July it was! We had only one event and only one meeting. But, still it was a mighty fine month! Our first autocross at Roberts Stadium in many years started off our month and we finished the month with another autocross the Stadium.

In other news, by action at the Board meeting in July, the club's policy of only distributing trophies to members at club meetings has been revised. That long-standing policy was to help motivate members to attend our meetings. Our new policy is that those members more than an hour's drive from the membership meeting have the option of collecting their trophies by making an arrangement with the Activities Chair.
