September Report

It is a little difficult to believe that our autocross championship will be finished by month’s end. My purple toenail from a patch party incident has just about grown out. I guess that means the autocross year is really about done. This month two of our own will travel to Lincoln, NE for the Solo Nationals, and we’ll have a road racer or two participate in the National Championship Runoffs in Elkhart Lake, WI. Good luck gentlemen.

Our event entries are on an up-tick. Our first two Roberts Stadium events had just over sixty entrants each. Our third was down to “just” forty-eight entrants. That is still about a third more than normal. The Moore’s “South of the Border II” rally had two three-car classes. That’s a strong showing for one of our rallies. In both rally classes, the top two positions were highly contested. Those results are in this issue.

The large number of guests at the Roberts Stadium autocrosses has led to some revamping of the tech, registration, and worker assignment processes. Along with those changes we have implemented formal worker check-in before each heat. With these changes, our August 19th autocross went very well. The first three timed runs were completed by our target noon start time. Incredible! We also finished early enough that we managed 30 minutes of fun runs before 4:30. Wow!

Special thanks to “Chief Registrar” Paul Dornburg who has one of the most stressful jobs at our autocrosses. Thanks too to our TownSquare Media guys Ben Davis & Mike Hutchens for a tech/registration tent and a great PA system. Tim Green and Mike Hutchens have also fixed some hardware issues with our timing system. Our ticket printer was back in action and the lights were set-up without difficulty. It is so cool when everything comes together.

We return to Roberts Stadium for our September 16th autocross. I think it would great fun to see if it is your entry that overwhelms our new registration process.

On Sunday, October 28th, we will have another attempt at the Dornburg “Ice Cream Rally.” Watch the website and YahooGroups postings for more details on this time/speed/distance rally event on some fun roads in the Owensboro area.

The month concludes with our seventh, and final, point autocross of the year on Sunday the 30th. Its location is to be determined. We are unable to book Roberts Stadium more than two or three weeks in advance. That is why so many of our autocross events this summer have been “location TBD.”

We will finish our autocross season next month with the Southern Illinois Region autocross on the 7th and the Bowler “Day at the Strip” autocross on the 13th. Both events will be at the Mid-American Air Center in Lawrenceville, IL.

As we approach the end of our year, it is time for you to consider your role in the club’s leadership for next year. I have been making it known that all are welcome at our board meetings. This month, the board meeting will be at the Dairy Queen, 1159 East Virginia Street, EVV on Sunday, September 9 at 2:15 P.M. Stop by for a treat, and have some soft serve too.

Bowler Autocross

In October there will be a FREE FUN autocross to anyone that wants to make the trip to Lawrenceville.

On Saturday October 13th our club will be putting on the Bowler Transmission "Day at the Strip" Autocross at the Mid-American Air Center, also know as the Lawrenceville-Vincennes International Airport.

There are 2 scenarios for competitors.

1. Show up Saturday to work and run and there will be no charge to you for the autocross. But you have to work.
2. Pay the \$40 entry fee to Bowler and compete for rewards. I don't know what the rewards are but you can ask when you show up. The \$40 also includes a meal and trips down the drag strip Sunday.

Some of use will be going up Friday afternoon to set up the course. If you'd like to help you are more than welcome. We'll meet at the site entrance around 3:00 PM Central time.

If you want to run Saturday be there by 8:00 AM because the runs will begin at 9:00 AM and you'll need to get signed in and checked over by Tech.

This event is a fund raiser put on by the Bowler Transmission Company. We're supporting their initiative by donating our time and effort to help them raise money for their local charities.
