November REport

This is the November <u>Pit Stop</u> and that means that our year is nearly done. That's *nearly* done. We're not done yet. We have a rally, a membership meeting, an election, and – hopefully – a "for grins" autocross all before we wrap the year up with our awards banquet and holiday party.

Since my last REport, we wrapped up our 2013 autocross season. Mike Buente very cleverly took a new approach to designing a bookend autocross course. We ran the first set of runs one way and the next set the other. Drivers that could keep both courses straight and could get fast quickly found the most success. Congratulations to Kenny Dilger on collecting the autocross championship. It's a welldeserved award. Closest to Kenny in the Autocross Points standings are Paul Dornburg and Berry Beaman.

Over the October 11th and 12th weekend, we managed the Bowler "Day at the Strip" autocross event. This year's format had the DATS looking much more like a Muscle Car Challenge with nothing but autocross action. Saturday, we served 516 timed runs to 31 drivers. Saturday's highlights include our own Richard Grav finishing the day in fifth in the 16 car "old" (before 1980) class and the familiar faces of Tom McBride (first) and Reggie Sandy (fourth) in the 15 car "new" class. Sunday's format had two rounds of eliminations to boil the field down to the fastest five drivers. These drivers then had three more runs tallied to produce an overall time. Richard Grav made it to the finals & finished in the nicest guy position.

Matt Beasley's courses were well received and managed just enough pylon action to keep the drivers challenged without generating lots of pylon chasing. MANY, MANY thanks to our members that helped work the event. Working the event the way we do always garners compliments from the entrants. It is pretty incredible to have an entrant or three come over to say thanks for running the event so smoothly. I think for the first time ever, the entrants had gotten their fill of autocrossing before the end of the second day. It was mostly club members and just a couple of the entrants that finished the day making fun runs.

I do not have the tally, but I would expect that the Day at the Strip generated several hundred dollars for the Cancer Resource and Wig Shop of Lawrence County. Our efforts make that gift possible.

Carrie and Chris Moore's "Rally de los Muertos" rally on October 27 was a great success. Five cars competed. First place in A had the low score of the day. In B, first and second were only 8 seconds apart. It was definitely a route for the drivers. Brisk pace throughout and in one section everybody was busy with 16 instructions just 5 miles. Check the results elsewhere in this issue.

The rally championship is down to the Sonntag/Davis rally on November 10. In the summer, Jim Cannon suggested that we should have a more difficult rally and I committed to one that would be just a half step up. Heading into our final rally of the season, Jim and I are tied for first. If Jim takes a class win, he and I will share the title. If not, we won't. Based on my unofficial figures, 7 of the 21 people with rally points can still collect a year-end rally trophy. Come join us on the 10th at Wink Construction for the "Turn, Turn, Turn" rally. It should be great fun. The route is all paved and has some unusual "features." It really is only a tiny step up in difficulty. Much of the route may even seem familiar to those that have run the past few Sonntag/Davis rallies. Also – and this is big – with larger class sizes there are more rally points to distribute to those that participate. Come see how good, lucky, or shoppy you can get on an SIR rally.

At our membership meeting – Smitty's on the 12th – we will cast and count the ballots for our 2014 board. You should find a ballot elsewhere in this issue. Return the ballots by mail to the club's PO Box (1112, EVV, 47706) or, better yet, bring them to the meeting. My understanding is that this month's program is about how Carrie Moore makes shirts for the Moore family motorsport programs like "Monkey See" and "Little Lamb-orghini."

At the time of the <u>Pit Stop</u> deadline, we are still working final details for a fun autocross at the Roberts Park parking lot, also known as the former Roberts Stadium parking lot. Because of the limited space, this will be a one trailer event. The club's trailer is that trailer. The date? December 1st. That is the Sunday of Thanksgiving weekend. Think of the autocross as an alternative to another day of shopping on Black Friday weekend, something to do besides spending *even more* time with visiting family, taking a break from watching football, or one more chance to autocross this year. Our year concludes with the 60th annual Awards Banquet and Holiday Party on Friday, December 6. The reservation form is elsewhere in this issue. You will need to make a reservation and place your dinner order by either mail or email before November 25th. The dress code usually comes up. Here's my take on it. I believe most gentlemen are dressed with coats, either sport or suit, and more are wearing ties than not. But that might be only a difference of two. 

Reaction Time: A Driver's Year In Review

The 2013 autocross season didn't go quite as planned for me. A winter and spring of engine work and new fuel injection parts promised a better performing car but in reality too many changes caused problems. Those problems surfaced at the first event where the car would not run beyond idle without finessing the gas pedal. Desperate adjustments on the second set of runs made it drivable but the performance was poor and I started the season in a big hole.

All of that would have been okay because we drop the lowest score of the 7 events but event number 2 was very wet and my lack of planning caught me out as the rain tires were in the garage

instead of on my car. The engine performance issue was fixed but a 12 inch wide slick tire in the rain was not good. Now I was really behind.

Event 3 offered a different challenge. A very tight finish with a sharp short turn to the left meant one could not easily get out of the finish lights to end the run. A shorter car would have an advantage over a longer car and

although I knew it and thought about it I didn't put my knowledge to practice. Each time at the finish I'd just roll through the lights. On my way home it dawned on me what I did and how I didn't use what I knew to my advantage. Now I was really in trouble with the points.

Event 4 was an event with 2 first gear turns. Modern cars have much easier to shift transmissions than my 40 year old Porsche so it was a real challenge to get the car slowed, downshifted and turned in such tight confines. To top it off Jim Breidenbach showed up from Paducah and beat our butts. His runs relegated me to fourth overall.

Event 5 was all mine. On Terry Davis' wide open course where the 911 could stretch its legs I was at the top of the charts all day. It was fun to be able to drive a course where the rpms weren't



around 2000 when exiting a corner. I spent very little time waiting for the turbo to spool up that day.

Event 6 went well on the Matt Beasley course which used a route we'd never driven. I was on top again but by now I'd done the math and there was very little chance of being the club autocross champ. Kenny Dilger would have to skip the last 2 events in order for me to win and that wasn't likely to happen.

At the last event Mike Buente took a new approach to the course and gave us two courses to run. It was another rainy day during setup but the rain guit and the concrete started to dry. Just as the

> drivers meeting concluded it started raining again. The first runs were on an almost wet course and that was just enough for Kenny as his fastest time was his first.. He got a bunch of cones on his second run probably as a result of the wetter course and his second quickest run was a full second slower than that first run. But it was over at that point as all my runs were on a wet track. It never did rain hard enough to make puddles so I went with the slicks

hoping that cohesive traction would be enough because there wasn't going to be enough heat in the tires to make any adhesive traction. It was close but I finished second on the charts and Kenny Dilger was the 2013 Autocross Champion.

I'm making plans for the 2014 season. I've got a list of maintenance items to tend to as well as some improvements to the injection system. I'd like to upgrade the brakes and make the transmission easier to shift. The former will just take time and money while the latter is a pipe dream. New graphics might be on the docket as well. Now that my garage has heat I'll be able to do the work over the winter instead of waiting for the warmer spring weather. -Paul Dornburg
