#### June 2014 REport

#### Sports Car Club of America - Southern Indiana Division - Board of Directors Minutes - May 6, 2014

#### Attendees:

Matt Beasley, Regional Executive; Paul Blaylock, Activities Chairman; Lora Blaylock, Secretary; Bob Sonntag, Advisor to the Board; Barry Schonberger, Assistant Regional Executive; Ben Davis, *Pit Stop*/Website; Mike Buente, Assistant Activities Chairman; Paul Dornburg, John Memmer, members.

#### Officer Reports:

The minutes were accepted as sent.

Bob reported that we have spent approximately \$1,100, and still have a positive balance available. The trailer insurance will be paid this month.

Activities Chair Paul is glad to hear the first autocross of the season went well. He will get a few trophies to Matt to keep in the trailer, as we have done with the Rally kit. He has not heard any more information on the 'incident' in Western Kentucky last weekend. Matt shared that he heard a car went out of control in the hands of a weekend member, careening into a deck, cleaving the roof off the car and hospitalizing the passenger with a concussion. The Western KY folks have reported the incident to the proper authorities and insurance folks. Matt will stay in touch to see if there is anything SIR needs to do.

Mike thanked John Memmer for helping with tech at Sunday's autocross. There were lots of cars to check, and they were able to complete their task just in time.

Ben reports that Pit Stop is headed to the USPS tonight.

Advisor Bob suggests that we be thinking ahead to oil change needs for the autocross equipment.

Barry noted that there will be no history report at this month's membership meeting.

#### Old Business:

Mike reported that he will obtain the new patch items to keep in the trailer. He will also send a quote to Matt for stabilizer to use on the rough/low area. The new pylons arrived, and a few were put into service at this past weekend's autocross. More will be rotated into the regular stock as the season continues. The Dornburg's are on the lookout for a good price on radios; however, there were plenty available for use last weekend. Two folks from March's Safety Steward class were able to complete one assistantship. We did receive formal approval for the Lawrenceville dates for the rest of the year. Bob will send the confirmed information to Ben for the website and *Pit Stop*. Our Charter has returned from review at the national office, so we are official once again.

#### **New Business:**

Terry's autocross was well attended, but there were some timing issues. The cables and the reflector caused problems during the first heat, but those issues were fixed by the second heat. Berry Beaman is going to refine the new reflector for the timing light. There were inconsistent problems with the cables. Paul Blaylock will bring equipment to check/repair the cables at the next autocross. The extension cord for the computer/display was damaged, and is being repaired. It was decided that Bob will obtain a 'spare' of at least 75 feet.

The books were off at the April autocross. There was confusion with receiving a new member at the event. Bob and Paul Dornburg will work on a 'cheat sheet' of costs to head off this problem in the future. Paul thanked Mike and John for doing a great job of getting card numbers and classes at tech, which made getting everything into the computer an easier task than normal.

Ben's Saturday April 12 rally was well attended, with 7 teams. With that success, another Saturday date will be planned into the 2015 calendar. There was an issue with a confirming landmark in the instructions, which played havoc with a number of teams.

Bob's rally was rescheduled to April 27 when Roberts Park became unavailable to SIR/SCCA. Five teams attended, and earned good scores. There was a bit of excitement with a brief hailstorm during the rally, but no incidents (or dents!) were reported.

There was a question about buying exact time during a rally. According to the official rule book, one is allowed to buy exact time if there under special circumstances that happen within sight of a control. Following discussion, it was decided to not publicize this, as it is likely to create confusion. Time will be available at 30 seconds, and 1 minute intervals after the first 30 seconds.

Paul Blaylock will check with Ernie Roales about marshalling the June autcross, as Mike may be unavailable.

Ben shared an autocross idea with the board. We would host an autocross in Evansville that featured local 'celebrities'. We would need to obtain 3 or 4 identical cars for the celebrities to drive. What if we could rent the cars from a local rental agency? It might bring more new folks out to an autocross, and generate publicity for the club in general.

Terry Davis will look into the after-Thanksgiving schedule for Roberts Park for a late-season autocross. Last year's event was a lot of fun and a good recruiting tool.

Event results are being posted to the website seperately from points. Ben intends to have them available within a few days of events. Paul Dornburg noted that he has found it is easier to use Facebook to coorindate member pictures rather than create a new page with all their info.

Paul Dornburg's Ice Cream Rally has been rescheduled to August 3. He will know and report to the board after this weekend about a short rally in Owensboro on June 7. This would be a non-SCCA event; however, the Sunset Cruisers would appreciate both workers and participants from SIR/SCCA. (Note: Paul did find out that the June 7 rally would not happen.)

Matt shared the marketing materials that arrived from the national office. They are compact, and have room on the back for a sticker containing local contact information.

As there was no further business, the meeting adjourned at 8:01 p.m.

#### Sports Car Club of America - Southern Indiana Division - Membership Meeting Minutes - May 13, 2014

Regional Executive Matt Beasley called the meeting to order at 7:41 pm and welcomed members and visitors alike. Following a reminder that all Board and Membership Meeting minutes are available via *Pit Stop*, a motion was made, seconded, and accepted to receive the minutes as printed. Treasurer Bob Sonntag reported that we have money in the bank. He further noted that SIR/SCCA will begin publicizing that event payments are "cash-only" affairs. Member's checks will still be received, but we are not able to accept credit/debit card payments at events. The *Pit Stop* deadline is the last Wednesday of the month, and submissions are always welcome. The website is coming along nicely, and recent event results are available there.

Due to a mix-up in the Roberts Park/ABATE schedule, the April 27 autocross was cancelled. It is hoped that another autocross can be scheduled at Roberts Park later in the year. In its place, Bob's "Noob" rally was held as a points event. A total of five teams competed in the hotly contested (in both classes!) outing. On Saturday, April 12, the "West Side Warmup" rally was well attended, with 7 teams participating. There was a problem with the route instructions that foxed some teams, and several appreciated being able to call in for help.

In upcoming events, the Southern Illinois group will hold their first autocross of the year at Lawrenceville on May 18 with setup beginning at 9:00 a.m. SIR's second autocross will happen on June 8 in Lawrenceville with setup at 9:30 a.m. Paul Dornburg reported that the Owensboro Sunset Cruisers will not hold a rally in June, as previously hoped. Please be in touch with Activities Chair Paul Blaylock if you are interested in being an Event Marshall, as dates are available beginning in early fall. Jim Cannon gave an early reminder of his June 29 rally, and hopes that many will be able to attend.

Member Dave Lehrshall presented a helpful program on autocrossing and car classifications. When driving, he recommends thinking about the 'big picture' and looking at where you can go slower to achieve a faster overall time. Two books he recommends for driving technique are *Secrets of Solo Racing* by Henry A Watts and *Going Faster* by Skip Barber. Dave then shared an explanation of Vehicle Classes and how to find them through the *SCCA Solo Rule Book*. Cars change sub-classes (street, touring, and prepared) based on modifications. Sometimes a modification can make an otherwise winning car non-competitive due to classing rules, so it's always wise to check in which class the car will end up before making a modification. He also explained the PAX Index, which looks at cars from different SCCA regions to try to mathematically even the playing field between vehicles.

Matt thanked Dave for his presentation and reminded all that the next Board meeting is Tuesday, June 3, and the next Membership meeting is Tuesday, June 10. Paul Blaylock won the door prize, earning a free entry to an upcoming event. As there was no further business, the meeting adjourned at 8:54 p.m.

## Autocross #1 for Incontinent Racing

The season didn't start off so well for Team Incontinent. When Terry took the car out for its first run it acted like it was too rich. Between heats I made some hurried adjustments to the EFI program and it seemed to run better. We both made runs and everything seemed to be okay with the car. Terry started his next set of runs but something was amiss. There was a ticking noise in the engine and he said it lacked power. We put it on the trailer and finished our runs in Terry's 2014 Carrera C4S. (Nice car, BTW)

Once the car was back in the garage the engine came out for repair. There were some pesky oil leaks that needed repair as well as finding the problem with the engine. As it turned out the ticking noise was the least of the issues. A broken exhaust was the ticking noise (see top picture and red arrow pointing toward break) and also the culprit with the lack of power. Any exhaust leak on a turbo system reduces the power output. So that seemed like an easy repair, just get it welded by a compitant welder.

The next things to be tackled were the oil leaks. Oil had been leaking for some time from a couple of case through-bolts so now was an opportune time to fix them. I pulled off the heads and cylinders to get to the bolts. The plan was to replace all the O-rings under the flat washers of all 12 bolts. (see middle picture) With 10 of the 12 O-rings replaced, the final 2 were hiding under the oil cooler. (see bottom picture) The nuts came off a little too easy, the first sign something wasn't right. When torqueing the nuts there was an ominous crack that signaled the threads giving way in the aluminum/magnesium block. Curses! Now the engine would have to be disassembled to fix the stud holes.

At this point the engine is apart and being cleaned. Parts are on the way and it will just be a matter of time until it's back together. It doesn't look like it'll be back together for points event #2 so we'll have to make do with whatever ride we can find.


