October 2014 REport

Hard to believe I'm already writing my 10th report for the club. Only two left for the year!. The month of September was all about autocross - one held by our Southern Illinois neighbors and two by our club. Check out the Recent Events section below for details on those events.

Sticking with the autocross theme, I thought I would mention my recent attempts to improve my autocross skills (and you all know that I REALLY need to improve those skills) using some mobile technology. At the last few events I've been trying out a mobile app called Harry's Lap Timer (http://www.gps-laptimer.de/Home.html). The app is available for both iOS and Android. It uses your device's GPS and accelerometer to capture data for each run. All you have to do to set up the course in the app is walk to the start, tap a button, then, walk to the finish and tap a button. The app will recognize when you pass the start and then begin capturing data until the finish location is triggered. The data will show speeds at each section of the course and compare your runs against a reference run (usually your fastest run). If you want to get really fancy, you can connect a higher resolution GPS so that you get more data points. You can also connect an OBD device so that you can read throttle position and RPM's from the car (note: I might not do this - it would give Bob hard evidence that I'm lifting the throttle when I shouldn't be). The app can use your device's camera to capture video of the run as well. Check out this video to see it in action: http://youtu.be/C-R-6V3EGOE. That's pretty cool.

Cool, but is it useful? I'm not sure. I'm still trying to figure out the best way to take advantage of this technology so I don't have a lot to report yet. Once I get more comfortable with its capabilities, I'll put a program together for an upcoming meeting.

One thing I found is that having your mobile device mounted to your windshield can be a distraction. On my first two runs, at the September 20th event, the app failed to trigger at the start so my attention was drawn to the app as I tried to figure out why it wasn't timing my run. I got it working on my third run but wasn't able to post a better time. In the second heat I was still struggling to improve my times so Terry jumped in the car with me to see if he could help (Thanks, Terry!). The first thing he said was "Get that thing off your windshield!". I did what he told me and removed the device. My final runs were my best of the day. I think the best use of the device would be to put it in your back window out of view and let it capture the data for later review. If you make notes after each run about what you did on the run, you can review the data after the event to see what worked and what didn't.

And, now, let's move on to the events!

Recent Events

On Sunday, September 7th, the Southern Illinois Region held their 2nd and final autocross of the season at the Mid-American Air Center. I wasn't able to attend, but I've heard from several members who participated and everyone enjoyed the event. Many folks were talking about the very stylish finish by Jay's Datsun. Jay decided to finish one of his runs on only two wheels. If you haven't seen the video, I recommend that you check it out. According to Jay, the video doesn't do it justice, though. Wish we had some video from outside the car. Luckily for Jay, he had some previous two wheel experience in a Suzuki Samurai and knew which way to turn the steering wheel in order to get all four tires back on the course.

On the weekend of September 20th and 21st we held a rare double autocross weekend at the Mid-American Air Center. On Saturday, John Memmer set up his course for the second time as a make up for the postposed August 17th event. It was a warm day, but it stayed dry throughout. John's course was likely the longest course of the season and kept competitors very busy. We were all expecting a wide open course to compliment John's Mustang, but it turned out to be very tight in some places. Even with the tight course, John still walked (drove?) away with the top spot continuing his perfect season.

After a night off, we returned to the site on Sunday for Autocross #6. Paul Dornburg was our event marshall and set up a really fast, wide open course that was a blast to drive. His course was called "Minimalist" and really lived up to that name. It used, by far, the fewest pylons of any course this season. As usual, John Memmer finished the day in the top spot. John has clinched the Autocross trophy for 2014. Congratulations, John!...a perfect season, a huge lead in the Rookie points, AND the Autocross championship. No wonder you were spraying that little bottle of champagne under the tree after the event

With first place at Paul's event dominated by John, the best competition of the day was for second place. Paul Dornburg co-drove Kenny Dilger's Porsche Cayman S and they traded fastest runs all day. Kenny ended the day with the fastest run in the Cayman (44.407 to Paul's 44.440), but Paul's early heat success gave him 2nd place in the autocross points, but just barely. With the best run, though, Kenny took the class trophy for the day.

You will find the complete results of both events including course maps later in this issue.

Upcoming Events

On Sunday, October 5th, we'll be back at the Mid-American Air Center for our final points autocross of the season. Dave Lehrschall will be the event marshall for the event. Dave is a veteran from one of the Texas regions but this will be his first course design for the Southern Indian Region. Don't miss your chance to gather some late season points at Dave's event. First place is already wrapped up, but you still have the opportunity to knock your RE down a few notches.

On Tuesday October 14th, we'll hold our member meeting at Roca Bar North (12301 Highway 41 North, Evansville, IN 47725). We'll gather at 6:30 for dinner, and the meeting will start around 7:30. We don't have a program yet, but we'll post that information on the club's mailing list and on the site as soon as it's confirmed. If you plan to attend, please send me your RSVP to RE@sirscca.org. I'll need those RSVP's by Thursday, October 9th.

Also, don't forget, we will be nominating candidates for the 2015 SIR.SCCA Board at the October member meeting. If you are interested in a board position or know someone you would like to nominate, please plan to attend the meeting to add your nomination. Board participation is a vital part for our club and we welcome new board members. I've been on the board for two years and it's been a very rewarding experience.

Our last event in October will take place on Sunday, October 16th. Don Kelly will be the rally master for our 6th rally of the season. It will be his first time designing a rally and will take place in Owensboro. We don't have the starting location yet, but, as soon as it's confirmed we'll post the information on our site (www.sirscca.org).

Finally, I'd like to announce that we'll be returning to Roberts Park in November for a couple of non-points autocross events. Our plan is to hold an event on Sunday, November 16th and on Sunday, November 30th. Those dates are still tentative, but, keep them open as these events are likely to take place. We'll have more details after the next board meeting.

Sports Car Club of America - Southern Indiana Division - Board of Directors Minutes - September 2, 2014

Attendees:

Mike Bente, Assistant Activities Chair; Paul Blaylock, Activities Chairman; Lora Blaylock, Secretary; Bob Sonntag, Advisor to the Board; Barry Schonberger, Assistant Regional Executive; Ben Davis, *Pit Stop*/Website; John Memmer, members. The meeting was led by Barry Schonberger, as Matt Beasley had unavoidable work obligations.

Officer Reports:

The minutes were accepted as sent.

Bob reported that the club's finances are in good shape. He continues to whittle away at some old SCCA invoices, sending \$170 in the past month for several open invoices. He is working with Dan from the Western Kentucky chapter on shared chapter dues from the past two years.

Paul reported that there are a few new rookie names in the latest event reports. The rained-out autocross from last month has been rescheduled for Saturday, September 20, followed by the already scheduled autocross #6 the next day, and word has been spread on all our media avenues. Paul confirmed that weekend members will get 'two events for the price of one' that weekend. Bob reported that camping will be allowed, and that trailers may be left overnight. Paul confirmed that the tentative rally date of September 14 is not needed and will be removed from the calendar. He also confirmed that points on the website will reflect what is reported in *Pit Stop*, but event results will be updated on the website within a few days of the event.

Ben confirmed that Bowler Day at the Strip will not happen, and will be removed from the calendar. He also confirmed that we will need to talk about elections until the October membership meeting. However, he did note that any dues increase would need to be voted on at this month's membership meeting. After a brief discussion, the board decided not to increase dues for the next year. Bob will pass this information on to Matt for inclusion in the membership meeting agenda.

We have 104 members in good standing. With Kevin Smalley moving out ot state, we need a new membership chair. John Memmer has volunteered to fill the position. He will talk with Kevin about the details of the job.

Old Business

Mike reported that the quick patch kit is ready and in the trailer. He will prepare some instructions to go with the materials. John Memmer will provide and extra bucket to go with the kit, which will also need a trowel. Depending on time and conditions, it is planned to test the materials at the end of autocross #7 on September 21. Mike will also obtain a gallon of the previously discussed stabilizer agent to test at the same time.

New Business

The Ice Cream Rally was well attended: 7 cars with 2 guest teams.

Autocross #5 was rained out as reported earlier. The rain made timing impossible.

Jim and Darlene Cannon's rallon on August 24 was also well attended with 6 cars.

Bob will make sure Matt Beasley has confirmed the September meeting at Smitty's. A review of this year's SCCA Nationals will be the program.

The October membership meeting will be held at the Roca Bar North. RSVP's will be needed. The restaurant wants a sizeable deposit for exclusive use of the room.

The earliest available date for an autocross at Roberts Park is November 16. Following discussion, it was decided to ask at the membership meeting if two events in a row (successive weekends) would be desired. The board supports having two events, but needs confirmation that a quorum would support both dates. These would be non-points (competition or Berry) events. Specific dates will be confirmed later.

As there was no further business, the meeting adjourned.

Sports Car Club of America - Southern Indiana Division - Membership Meeting Minutes - September 9, 2014

Barry Schonberger, Assistant Regional Executive, welcomed everyone to the meeting, including visitors and new member Raj. Regional Executive Matt Beasley is out of town.

The minutes of the August meeting were accepted on motion and second. Bob Sonntag, Treasurer, reported that the club has members and money hooray! Paul Blaylock reported that September is a light activity month, but that we do have a dual autocross weekend on September 20 and 21. Weekend members get two events for the price of one! Bob advised everyone to have fun tonight (and for everyone to wang chung tonight!).

In Old Business, Barry reported that the board discussed the Autocross setup schedule in some detail, and while strategies will be employed to hurry the process along as quickly as possible, run times are not planned to begin earlier. He encouraged everyone to read the current issue of *Pit Stop* for further details

Paul Dornburg handed out trophies for the Ice Cream Rally held on August 3. We had 8 cars driving around Owensboro and having a great day. The low score of the day was achieved by Class B - Ernie Roales and Ben Davis. Thanks was also expressed to Paul for paying for the ice cream at the finish!

Autocross #5 scheduled for August 7 was rained out (!) and has been rescheduled for SATURDAY, September 20. John Memmer promises to set the course up as close as possible to the original layout.

Darlene Cannon was unable to attend the meeting, so her assistant, Jim, handed out the trophies. Class B again won the day, with Jay and Sue Wolf achieving the low score.

The Southern Illinois autocross on September 7 was attended by about 25 cars. Bob noted that the event made him appreciate how much cleaning and blowing off the course makes in grip. He also noted that a few of the new patches are coming up, and it is hoped that there will be time and appropriate weather following the autocross on September 21 to try the new patch material.

As mentioned earlier, Autocrosses # 5 & 6 will be September 20 and 21. All equipment will be picked up at the end of Saturday's autocross, but camping is allowed and trailers may be parked overnight by the glider hangers for those attending both events. The course for Autocross #6 will be designed by Paul Dornburg.

Looking ahead, our final points Autocross of the year will be on October 5, and the course will be designed by Dave Lehershall. This is Dave's first SIR course, but he carries with him a great deal of experience from his previous region.

Barry reported that the Board has decided not to increase dues for 2015. They will remain as follows: Regular \$18, Family \$25, and First Gear \$10.


