Rally #1 of 7



Matt welcomed everyone to the meeting and asked for officer reports. Bob reported that the club has funds and outstanding invoices of less than \$250, which he plans to pay in the near future. Upon Bob's recommendation, it was decided to hold the reserve funds at \$3,700. Ben reported that *Pit Stop* is available now via PDF, and the paper copy should leave the printer tomorrow. There are 120 current members, and 11 are due to to renew this month. John will check in with these folks.

In new business, the desire to add an additional event notice to the regular email was discussed. Paul will ask event chairs to send a special note to the yahoo group, highlighting the 5 W's. Once Ben gets the email, he will put it on the website, which will is set up to copy it to all of the club's other electronic channels. The target date for the email from the event chair to go out is the Monday prior to an event.

The need for new information on the front page of the website was discussed. This will be helped by the addition of new content as discussed above. In addition, Ben will update the "expiration date" of stories on the front page. Paul will update Berry points for 2015.

Bob and Terry visited TMMI last Saturday and viewed two possible sites for an autocross. Both possibilities have a minimum of room for a course. They have answered questions from the TMMI safety team, but have not yet heard if they're ready to go ahead with the event. Additionally, they do not have an answer if SIR cars will be able to participate in the event.

The MAAC site survey date is Saturday, March 21 at 9:00 a.m.. Matt will bring maps and ensure a few key folks are in attendance. Bob will bring the marking paint. Thanks to Jay Wolf for volunteering to be the equipment marshall for the dig/cut/fill days.

Terry reported that he has heard that ABATE is not providing motorcycle training for the state this year, as the state awarded a contract to a California firm. He is going to talk to ABATE about the availability of the Roberts site.

At the moment, no program is planned for the membership meeting. Terry and Barry will check their notes to see if they can remedy that issue.

As there was no further business, the meeting adjourned.

Terry and Barry presented a program on the Sports Vintage Racing Association event at the Brickyard. The SVRA, a privately owned organization, was formed from several smaller vintage groups. The event in 2014 covered 4 days and featured racing on the road course as well as exhibitions on the oval. The atmosphere was extremely friendly, and included access to the pits, cars, owners, and celebrities. Check online for this year's dates and pick up your tickets (2014 tickets were only \$40!) early.

All are invited come out to the National Corvette Museum Track this weekend and see local race teams Monkey See Motorsports and Kentucky Spirits race in the World Racing League.

Jim Cannon shared pictures from a visit today to RideTech in Jasper, as they began building a 1978 Corvette in only 48 hours. He noted that folks can either visit in person, or follow the build online.

As there was no further business, the meeting adjourned after Stacy Grav won the door prize.
