Recent Events


Rally #3 of 7

Sports Car Club of America - Southern Indiana Division - Board of Directors Minutes - July 7, 2015

Attendees:

Matt Beasley, Regional Executive; Paul Blaylock, Activities Chairman; John Memmer, Assistant Activities Chair; Bob Sonntag, Treasurer; Ben Davis *PitStop*/Website; Lora Blaylock, Secretary, Paul Dornburg, Advisor to the Board; Ernie Roales, Assistant Regional Executive

- -Treasurer Bob reports that the club is operating in the black, and there are minimal outstanding bills. He also noted that the national SCCA website has been updated, and reports that the board often accesses have been moved under the "profile" tab. Finally, he suggests we continue to remind folks that exact change is appreciated when paying for events and that members are able to pay by check.
- -Activities Chair PaulB posed questions about member join dates: is the join date when the membership fee is received, or when they show up on our lists from national? Traditionally, SIR has taken the pay date as the join date if it makes a difference in Berry or Rookie points in favor of the member. Also, if one was a member (youth, family, or otherwise), lapsed, and then rejoins, can they earn Rookie points? Yes, if no events were entered during the original membership.
- -Regional Executive Matt is looking forward to returning to participating in events after a personally busy spring. He noted that we have 111 members in good standing, with 6 expired memberships over the past 2 months. He reported that the Western Kentucky chapter is still working toward becoming its own region.

New Business:

- -Bob and Matt reported that they have been in touch with TMMI and are looking at new dates for the autocross that do not conflict with the Southern Illinois event on September 13. Even with the date change, there is concern about getting enough workers without offering runs for them. Bob and Matt will try to work out this detail with TMMI, and make sure they are not excluding workers to avoid confusion with TMMI employee awards. When soliciting volunteers, we should be sure to remind folks that this kind of event is how the club makes money.
- -Ben Davis reported that folks are reporting odds and ends about the website to him, and he appreciates the feedback and is making corrections/edits. Upon suggestion, he will re-order the results list to show most recent events first. He further confirmed dates, locations, and event masters for the calendar.
- -In upcoming events, Ernie Roales is ready for Autocross #3 on July 12, and Matt is ready for Autocross #4 on August 2. Matt will contact specific folks for targeted cross-training. PaulD reports that Rally #4 on July 26 has been updated due to road construction, and is ready to go! Possibilities for the program at next week's membership meeting include a report on the recent historic car event at the Brickyard, and a report from member Chris Moore, who recently raced at Laguna Seca in California. Finally, the Log Inn has been secured for the August membership meeting, with thanks to Leslie for securing the Lincoln Room for the club.
- -As there was no further business, the meeting adjourned.

- -Matt Beasley, Regional Executive, gaveled the meeting to order and welcomed all, especially new visitors. Secretary Lora Blaylock encouraged all to read minutes of Board and Membership meetings on the website or in *Pit Stop*. Treasurer Bob Sonntag reported that we are operating in the black. Activities Chair Paul Blaylock noted that Autocross #5 on August 30 is needing an Event Chair; please contact him if you would like to create a course.
- -In new business, Bob reported that autocross cross-training is going well, and encouraged folks to continue to come early and try new things! The details for the autocross for TMMI continue to be refined. It was moved, seconded, and approved to offer the date of September 27 to TMMI. While SIR members will not likely be eligible for prizes, workers should be able to take fun runs. Please plan to help out with this event, as it is a good money maker for the club
- -Matt noted that while attendance at tonight's meeting is quite good, previous months' attendance has been low. If you have an idea why, or a suggestion on how to boost attendance, please contact Matt via email.
- -The club is looking forward to the upcoming Ice Cream Rally on July 26. Paul Dornburg notes that the annual rally route has been updated due to road construction in Owensboro, but everything is ready to go, so come out and have fun (and ice cream)! Matt shared a map of his upcoming Autocross, set for August 2; to the chagrin of some and consternation of others, the route features not one, but two chicanes.
- -Trophies were presented for recent events. Terry Davis' autocross #2 on June 7 featured 10 weekend members, No Stinkin' Chicanes (except that one), and saw Paul Dornburg earn the only perfect score of the day. Don Kelley's rescheduled Rally #2 on May 31 saw 7 cars finish, with Class A taking overall 1st and 3rd places. Congratulations to Dave and Suellyn Lehrschall on their first place finish.
- -Member Chris Moore reported on his recent racing experience at Laguna Seca in California. He rented a seat in a '97 BMW E36 in a ChumpCar race there. The car was all stock, with a straight pipe for a muffler, which caused them a noise disqualification on the first day. A new muffler was installed, and racing continued into day 3 when the clutch blew apart. Carrie Moore even enjoyed a ride-along in the ChumpWagon during live racing check Facebook for details. Chris enjoyed over three hours of wheel-to-wheel racing, and had a great time. He highly recommends series like ChumpCar or WRL if you are looking for a good racing experience.
- -Several SIR members visited the Brickyard in Indianapolis recently for the Vintage Racing event. A mere \$15 provided up-close and personal views of historic, pedigreed racecars, their owners, and famous drivers. This annual event lasts four days and is highly recommended to all.
