#### Autocross #5 of 7

Our 5th autocross of the season was held at the MAAC on Sunday, August 30th. David Lehrschall designed the course for the event. At this event we had two entrants at the top with 1000 points. Paul Gibson in 1st place and Paul Dornburg in 2nd. I guess it was a good day to be named Paul.

Also in attendance was long time member Tom Bootz driving what many have called the most beautiful grand touring coupe ever made - the Audi S5. Um, I may be a bit biased in that opinion. Anyway, it was great to see Tom back out on an autocross course.

#### Sports Car Club of America - Southern Indiana Division - Board of Directors Minutes - September 1, 2015

#### Attendees:

#### Officer Reports:

Bob reports that the club's cash balance is recovering nicely as the season progresses, and bills due are less than \$150. *Pit Stop* is headed out tomorrow night. Ben reports that he is suddenly unable to edit the website, and there are problems with the calendar. He is working to fix all these issues, and will send autocross details out via email. The club currently has 113 members in good standing.

#### **New Business:**

PaulB requested that copies of event results be sent to him as well as to Ben, and to use full names in the results. This will help him post points to the correct members!

Matt updated the board on the progress with the TMMI autocross. All entrants' information has been received, and PaulD has offered to enter it into the computer. Bob and Matt are in contact with entrants whose chosen vehicles may be unsuitable for the event. The club will provide insurance via SCCA for the event (a cost which should be included in the fee for future such events). The board discussed the possibility of making this a charity event, which would reduce the insurance cost greatly. Bob will take care of filling out the weekend membership forms for insurance purposes. Terry will be the Event Marshall, and a site visit to finalize physical details will take place on September 19. A tech station will be used instead of tech people visiting cars individually. SIR setup will begin at 8:30 a.m. on the day, with TMMI participants arriving at 9:30 a.m. A driver's meeting/course walk will begin at 10:30 a.m. The event will have 2 heats, with participants receiving 5 runs each. Ernie and Jay Wolf will move the trailers between TMMI and MAAC. Matt will invite TMMI contact Scott Milam to next week's Membership Meeting to iron out any final questions.

Autocross #6 on September 20 still needs an Event Marshall. PaulB will ask Jim Cannon. Bob Sonntag is the Event Marshall for Autocross #7 on October 4.

Matt noted that there is no program booked for next week's Membership Meeting. Additionally, the October meeting can be held at Smitty's, as there is no conflict with the Fall Festival this year. He hopes to have a particularly good turnout for the October meeting, as board nominations will be received.

As there was no further business, the meeting adjourned.

This not only gives lots of exposure to potential new members, but also earns the club money. Watch your email for a worker RSVP and say yes!

Other upcoming events include a Southern Illinois Autocross at MAAC on September 13, Jim Cannon's Autocross #6 on September 20, and Autocross #7 on October 4, Marshalled by Bob Sonntag. Thanks to our Event Marshalls!

Bob Sonntag shared results for Terry Davis' recent rally, "The Prisoner Recaptured", which featured 9 checkpoints in a looping route. 5 teams participated, and more than ½ of the checkpoint scores were under 10, with two teams scoring 0!
