June REport from Dave Lehrscha

I was so ready for our Autocross season to start that I might have run the risk of being disappointed. No problem. Yesterday's 1st points Autocross event of the Southern Indiana Region's season was a tremendous event! We had beautiful weather, a great course thanks to the event marshal, Ernie Roales. It was one of the best attended events anyone can remember. We had 49 Autocross competitors!

The event was as it should be. It was safe, it was run smoothly, and it was a lot of fun! As with all of our SIR events, this was the result of participants doing whatever they could to support the event. We had most of our usual dedicated setup and event support from our regular members. We also had a fantastic group of new drivers show up. They helped make registration and tech inspection run much better than it might have run. We had people and vehicles we had not seen before as well as new helmets to check. It could have been chaotic and delayed the event, but thanks to this group it went very well. There was a lot of friendly competition and encouragement going on between these drivers. It was great watching the excitement as developing driving strategies resulted in improved times. Competitive spirits were evident, but at the same time everyone celebrated when a driver turned a faster time. Our next Autocross event is set for June 26, I'll be the event marshal and I'm already working to create a different, but fun course. Ernie set the bar pretty high so we won't be re-running any recent course layout. I hope to see the same large turnout. Course setup begins at 9:30 AM (Central) at the Mid America Air Center off Hwy 50 at Lawrenceville, IL.

Speaking of great turnouts, we had 9 teams compete in the May 1, Rally! This was also a recent record number. The Rally was fun and the finishes were pretty close. Afterwards, we took over the patio at Mr. B's, had dinner, and traded stories from our Rally experiences. Bob Sonntag and Terry Davis put together a great route and event. This was also run safely, smoothly, and was a lot of fun!

We're hoping to make the great Rally turnout a regular thing. The next Rally is set for June 5th. The Rally master is my favorite navigator, Suellyn, my wife. We've driven this new Rally route at least 7 times now. (We'll run it a few more times before the 5th). We're still a little new to this area so we figured that phone calls from potentially lost teams to Suellyn and I might not produce the best results. In addition to phone assistance, we will provide sealed envelopes with clear instructions for rejoining and continuing the Rally. Teams may break the envelope seal(s) to get back on track or turn in the still sealed envelopes at our finish destination to avoid scoring penalties. We'll begin registration at 12:30 PM (Central) at the McDonalds on Hwy 41 just north of Hwy 57 and the Evansville airport at Mt. Pleasant road. The first car should be off at 1:00 PM.

We had a nice turnout for our May membership meeting. We had spread the word that John Memmer was going to present information on instrumented vehicles and competitive driving training. John did not disappoint us. The information was well presented..

I am extremely pleased by event turnout, but not totally surprised. There have been focused efforts to communicate what our events are about and when they are scheduled. We've put on classes to explain the mechanics of Rally and Autocross events. We've partnered with the Toyota team to manage an Autocross event. We've handed out business cards with event dates and our SIR website information printed on them and we are sharing our events and fun on Facebook. Our website provides event instructions and tells the story of an active SCCA region. I heard all of these mentioned by new participants in our latest Rally and Autocross events. We've raised the interest of the TMMI participants from last year and we'll present an Autocross class there in July. I encourage you all to keep talking about the SIR and our events. It is key to growing our membership.

Finally, there are at least 8 of us planning on participating in the SCCA Solo Nationals in September in Lincoln, Nebraska. If you're interested in joining the group for the road trip and event please let us know. It should be a great experience, but reservations should be made soon!

Board of Directors Meeting

May 2, 2016

Present: Dave Lehrschaal, Regional Executive, Paul Blaylock, Activities Chair; Junior Crowe, Assistant Activities Chair, Bob Sonntag, Treasurer, Lora Blaylock, Secretary; Matt Beasley, Advisor to the Board, Terry Davis, guest

Regional Executive Dave welcomed everyone and called for officer reports. Treasurer Bob reported that we spent \$1,707.81 on patch party supplies and still have a healthy balance in the accounts. 28 people worked over the course of the project, and we used 10 fewer yards of concrete (value approx. \$1,000) than last year. It was the smallest concrete order in recent memory. Membership currently stands at 119 including 24 Western Kentucky people, who will be listed with us until they individually inform the national office that they wish to be affiliated with Western Kentucky.

Activities Chair Paul Blaylock reported that there is still one autocross (10/2) and two rallies (9/11, 11/6) without leadership. Events have generated several recent visitors or interests from out of state, but Julia Yockey is the only Rookie at this time. The visit to Bennet Dream Museum is all set up. At the Membership meeting, he will ask for RSVPs to the museum, interest in group trips to or activities at the Vintage Racing Weekend in Indianapolis as well as SOLO Nationals in Lincoln. Dave is putting the finishing touches on Rally #3, which will start at the McDonalds on US 41 and Mt. Pleasant, and end at the Hacienda on Green River and Washington. (Thanks, Dave!)

Rally #2 was enjoyed by 9 cars, including a few new folks and a couple from Paducah, who plan to stay in the Southern Indiana Region. Thanks, Terry and Bob for a fun afternoon.

Assistant Activities Chair Junior Crowe has been working on a flyer to leave at Larry's Automotive. A first draft is printed in *Pit Stop*. Larry's Automotive is interested in having a link to his website on the SIR website. In return, he would make a donation to the club for any sales generated by the link. Dave moved to place a link to Larry's Automotive on the SIR website. The motion was seconded and passed. It was not felt that this would be a conflict with the Tire Rack promotion already on the website. Junior also reported that he has had no success with getting a media outlet interested in covering the club. Dave wondered if we should reach out to auto dealerships, and will contact Lucas Oil about club activities.

Terry had no new news on the TMMI event. Dave will check with interested folks and offer a shortened version of February's autocross school.

Dave reported that he has not yet seen the charter renewal paperwork. He will check with Rick Myers at the national office. He also reported that John Memmer will provide the program at next week's membership meeting, sharing with us his new coaching job.

As there was no further business, the meeting adjourned.

Membership Meeting

May 9, 2016

Regional Executive Dave Lehrschaal welcomed members and visitors to the meeting and called for officer reports.

It was moved, seconded, and agreed to dispense with the reading of the minutes. Secretary Lora Blaylock noted that they are available in *Pit Stop* and invited folks to watch Board minutes being made at any monthly Board meeting. Treasurer Bob Sonntag reported that the club is still operating in the black, despite spending \$1,707.81 on patch parties.

Activities Chair Paul Blaylock reported that the most recent rally (#2) was a smashing success with 9 cars participating. He sent around a sign-up sheet for Saturday's visit to the Bennet Motors Dream Museum, interest in group attendance to / activities at the Vintage Races in Indy and SOLO Nationals in Lincoln. There are a few opportunities left to earn first-place points by leading an event: Rallies on September 11 and November 6; and the Autocross on October 2. Thanks in advance to Ernie Roales for designing Autocross #1 on May 22 - see *Pit Stop* for a map of the course; and to Suellyn and Dave Lehrschaal for marshalling Rally #3 on June 5, which will begin at the McDonald's at US 41 and Mt. Pleasant.

Thanks to Paul Dornburg for his work on *Pit Stop* - this good looking document should be in your mailbox today, and is available on the SIR website. Assistant Regional Executive Richard Grav reported that he was damn glad to be in attendance, and to contact him if you need more event cards to share with car folks.

Awards were presented for Rally #1, marshalled by Bob Sonntag. Although only 3 cars participated in the event, they brought their "A" game. Team Yockey won in Class A, and team Mercer/McClay won in class B with a total score of 229, including a 0 at checkpoint 1.

John Memmer shared what he's been up to recently: data acquisition and coaching with a team that runs in Porsche GT4 Club Sport. These are factory-built racecars cared for by a team. For the owners, it's basically an arrive-and-drive situation. John analyzes data from the car, including acceleration, g-forces, braking, and much more. It is a game of fractions - shave part of a second here, part of a second there, and advance in the series. John's also been driving as part of a team with a BMW, and is doing well in those races.

Stacy Grav won the door prize, after which the meeting adjourned.

SCCA: A club with many interests

Many faceted in its endeavors, the Sports Car Club of America (SCCA) might best be described as a service organization. It serves over 50,000 members throughout the United States by sanctioning and administering a variety of automotive related activities through more than 115 independently chartered regions. No other single motor sports organization in the world conducts more events than the SCCA. These events range from amateur and professional road racing to road rallies, autocrosses, rally crosses, hill climbs and auto shows. The SCCA is an ever-growing organization for the automotive enthusiast. Because the SCCA is member oriented, the club stresses participation on a broad basis. Regardless of your experience or background, if you are an automotive enthusiast there is a place for you in the SCCA. The avenues available range from amateur or professional road race driver to weekend rally or autocross driver to race worker or official. In order to successfully sanction and conduct a comprehensive autocross/rally/road racing program many experts in timing and scoring, communications, safety inspection, medical, flagging, course/race control and other skills are needed. Schools are held to train the drivers and workers and various degrees of licenses are awarded based on knowledge, ability and experience.
