July REport from Dave Lehrschall

I thought I might have a problem coming up with a Pit Stop topic as the Autocross and Rally preparations wrapped up. No way! There is so much going on with the Southern Indiana Region of the SCCA that I don't think I can cover it all.

Those that have followed the transition from last year's board of directors to this year's BOD know that both teams had developed goals aimed at providing the SIR membership with safe events that were fun, opportunities to socialize with other fans of motorsports, and the growth of our membership. There are a lot of really good things going on at the SIR, but I'm going to start with the growth of our region. I believe we have had new members sign up at every Autocross and Rally event this year. Many of our new members had worked the patch parties and are enjoying their place on the Autocross bonus (run) program. It's not a surprise that we're seeing greater participation at these events. The new members have wasted no time in joining in the competition. After a low 3 car turnout at our first Rally, our second Rally had 9 teams participate, and our third Rally had 12 teams in the mix. Our first Autocross had 49 entrants and our second had 36 entrants. Our new members have made a tremendous difference in helping the SIR hit its goal of greater participation in our events.

As we go to press with this issue of Pit Stop we're working through plans for a large contingent of SIR members to participate in the 2016 SCCA Solo Nationals. We already have enough registered to qualify for a Southern Indiana Region dedicated area in the paddock. We have room for more to join us! Getting a group together for this event was another one of this year's goals. For many of us, this will be our first trip to the Nationals. I know that I may finish in last place in my class, but I can hardly wait to join in! Experienced Nationals participants Paul Dornburg and Terry Davis have been serving as mentors to those of us making plans for the event so we can focus on driving and not worry about registration details and hotel planning. We had 8 members registered the last time I checked. We'd really like to add to that number and registration should still be open as you read this!

You may see a few of the new SIR patches that Steve Yockey developed showing up. The patches look great and thanks to Steve's efforts match the SCCA's guidelines for SCCA apparel. I'm thinking that these patches would look very good on "team SIR" hats at the Nationals. Thank you, Steve, for putting this together.

Finally, I want to thank everyone who showed up for our June 26th Autocross. I think that we used all, but about 20 cones with the course setup. Except for the Porsche slalom on the West side, the course route was not that different from those we've run recently. It did present a different look with plenty of "walls" and force drivers to look through the distractions to see the few critical cones. Saying it was hot would be a tremendous understatement. Even so we had a great time. The event was safe and fun. Once again we had several "grudge matches" as fathers and daughters, fathers and sons, and friends set times for each other to beat. It was a good day and the torrential rains and flash flooding held off until we had left the MAAC airfield. I especially liked the interest SIR members had in other's well-being and insuring no one became overheated.

SIRSCCA-Board of Directors Meeting

June 7, 2016

Present: Dave Lehrschall, Regional Executive, Richard Grav, Assistant Regional Executive; Paul Blaylock, Activities Chair; Bob Sonntag, Treasurer, Lora Blaylock, Secretary; Paul Dornburg, *Pit Stop*; Terry Davis, Stacy Grav, guests

Regional Executive Dave Lehrschall welcomed everyone and called for officer reports. Treasurer Bob Sonntag reported that the trailer insurance has been paid, and we have a positive balance in the accounts. Activities Chair Paul Blaylock reported there are still a few late-season opportunities to lead events. An email question was received about being an event marshal. Perhaps a set of "stock" answers should be prepared. Paul Dornburg reported that the results from Autocross #2 (6/26) should be available in time for publication in the July *Pit Stop*.

In old business, Dave updated the board on correspondence with the Great Lakes Conference. He was unsuccessful in convincing them to conduct a virtual meeting. The Conference is mostly concerned with road racing, which is not an activity SIR participates in. He does not plan to attend any of their meetings.

The TMMI autocross has been approved in addition to an intro to Autocross class for the TMMI participants to be led by Dave Lehrschall on July 9. The TMMI signup paperwork will include a little publicity information for SIR. TMMI employees will pay a larger portion of the per-participant fee than last year. SIR members who work the event will earn 5 points.

The event cards prepared by the Grav's are going like hotcakes! Hooray!

In review of recent events, Paul Blaylock noted that although there was significant interest in a group outing to the Bennett Motor Museum, not a large number of folks attended. Those who did go had a good time, and as the museum changes exhibits regularly, perhaps another visit will be arranged during the winter months.

Over 40 cars participated in the first autocross on May 22! The trailer upgrades worked wonderfully. Registration and tech inspection went well, in spite of the large turnout. A better 'cheat sheet' is needed for tech. The weekend membership forms need to be passed around earlier in the day (this would be good at Rallies, too), and folks need to be reminded of the order of course preparation.

Dave and Suellyn's Rally on June 5 had a huge turnout of 12 cars! The combination of the large turnout and start location made it difficult to get organized quickly. Everyone had a good time, and only one car called for help. Dave and Suellyn will make a 'need-to-know' list for new Rally masters that Bob Sonntag can use at a future Rally master school.

In new business, Paul Dornburg reported that new tires for the cone trailer are on the way. Thanks, Paul!

An email has been received that new insurance waiver forms (from national) are being written for 2017. It appears that the release for minors will be more complicated. A new supply will be ordered.

Dave shared an idea for the presentation at the June Membership meeting. He has a power point presentation on autocross course design by Roger Johnson. It is also helpful for driving the course. He plans for 10-15 minutes of presentation time including a handout of the area at MAAC for folks to plan a course and return at the next meeting.

As there was no further business, the meeting adjourned.

SIRSCCA-Membership Meeting

June 14, 2016

Regional Executive Dave Lehrschall called the meeting to order and welcomed members and guests alike. The reading of the minutes was dispensed with upon affirmation of motion and second. Treasurer Bob Sonntag reported that the club is operating in the black. Assistant Activities Chair Junior Crowe has reworked the tech book for autocrosses and will try it out later this month. All are encouraged to attend a Board of Directors meeting; check the club calendar for details.

Awards were presented for recent events: Ernie Roales' "KISS" Autocross on May 22 had a large turnout of 49 participants! Paul Gibson with his Black RX-8 took home 1000 points.

Nine teams vied for trophies in Terry Davis' "Baskett Case IV" rally on May 1. Team Yockey in class A took the day with a total score of 145. Class B had 6 teams, so first and second places were awarded to team Crowe and team Cannon, respectively.

An informal protest for the recent (6/5) "Sweet and Spicy" rally was presented by Chris Moore for navigator Miles Moore, who could not be at the meeting. Results of the that rally will be presented at the July meeting.

In upcoming events, it was noted that registration for Solo Nationals in Lincoln, NE opens this week. If you are planning to go, be sure to register early! The next Autocross is set for June 22 and will be a "Nod to the Nationals". Activities Chair Paul Blaylock noted that there are still a few opportunities to lead events at the end of the season. Remember, you can earn first place points for chairing an event!

In new business, Dave reported that he has spoken to a contact at Lucas Oil about working with the club on promotions.

Member Steve Yockey reports that he has worked with an embroiderer to create SIR patches in the shape of the SIR club logo. The Board will discuss and decide on a price in July.

Dave reported that the September TMMI autocross has been approved, and he will conduct an Autocross school on July 9 for participants. Remember, members who work at this event earn 5 points.

Dave shared information on how to design an autocross course for the program portion of the meeting. There are many ways to set cones for the same course. Dave shared examples and handed out a blank course design sheet, encouraging all to bring it back next month with a course design.

The meeting adjourned after Ernie Roales won the door prize.

SCCA: A club with many interests

Many faceted in its endeavors, the Sports Car Club of America (SCCA) might best be described as a service organization. It serves over 50,000 members throughout the United States by sanctioning and administering a variety of automotive related activities through more than 115 independently chartered regions. No other single motor sports organization in the world conducts more events than the SCCA. These events range from amateur and professional road racing to road rallies, autocrosses, rally crosses, hill climbs and auto shows. The SCCA is an ever-growing organization for the automotive enthusiast. Because the SCCA is member oriented, the club stresses participation on a broad basis. Regardless of your experience or background, if you are an automotive enthusiast there is a place for you in the SCCA. The avenues available range from amateur or professional road race driver to weekend rally or autocross driver to race worker or official. In order to successfully sanction and conduct a comprehensive autocross/rally/road racing program many experts in timing and scoring, communications, safety inspection, medical, flagging, course/race control and other skills are needed. Schools are held to train the drivers and workers and various degrees of licenses are awarded based on knowledge, ability and experience.
