May REport from Dave Lehrschall

The Southern Indiana Region's Rally season has begun! We had a good turnout for our first 2017 points Rally. The Rally Master, Paul Blaylock, reported that everyone finished and had a good time. Our next points Rally, "The Cool Rally", will take place on May 7, 2017. Ben Davis is the Rally Master for our second of seven points Rally's. Ben always does a great job on Rally planning. You won't want to miss this! The Rally will start at the parking lot at TowneSquare Media, 117 SE 5th Street, Evansville, IN. This Rally event will run from 12:30 pm - 5:30 pm.

Last month I stated that our Autocross season would begin on Saturday, May 20th with a Test and Tune (no points) event. We're still on schedule for the event, but after participating in the first days of Patch Parties, I feel like the Autocross season has already started. We've had excellent attendance and participation in the course maintenance by many of our regular Autocross participants. Everyone worked hard and earned their way into the bonus program for additional Autocross event runs. The weather reports looked ominous, but we lucked out and had near perfect weather for the Cut Day and Dig Day. Mother Nature must have wanted to remind us that she was still in charge as we had to cancel plans for our scheduled Fill Day. Hopefully, we will get it done on Saturday, May 6th. (*Ed. Note: We did the Fill day on May 6th*)

Our first Autocross event will be held on May 20th. This will not be a points event, but a Test and Tune event. It will present a safe, less structured opportunity to make handling adjustments and to work on dusting off your driving skills prior to the next day's points event on May 21st. Paul Dornburg and I have switched event Marshal dates. I get to be this year's first points Autocross Marshal and the Test and Tune Marshal. Yeah! I've prepared a plan for a 270-degree constant rate turn, two slalom variations, and a little room to accelerate. Ernie Roales suggested I throw in at least one Chicago Box, but it's out for this event. The Test and Tune will run from 9:30 am to 4:30 pm at the Mid-American Air Center on Airport Rd, Lawrenceville, IL. I want to remind you that this will present a great value for weekend members. The cost will be \$30 for members and \$50 for non-members. Non-members can compete the next day for just \$30 if they participate in the Saturday event.

The Women of SIR's Ladies Autocross is being promoted across the SCCA and we are preparing for visitors from around the Division as well. The event will take place Saturday, June 10, from 9:30 am - 4:30 pm at the Mid-American Air Center. The event will be an Autocross event for Ladies only. We plan to limit the registration to 60 drivers. The cost will be \$30 for members and \$50 for non-members. Non-members can compete the next day for just \$30 if they participate in this event. We'll need help from all club members to put on this event. Guys, like our TMMI events, workers may get a sneak preview of the course for the next day's Autocross. You are always welcome to join us for our Membership meetings. We'll have dinner and talk about motorsports, cars, and share SIR events' experiences. Our next meeting will be held at Smitty's Italian Steakhouse in Evansville on Tuesday, May 9, 2017. We'll gather around 6:00 PM for bench-racing, begin eating around 6:30, and then start the meeting at about 7:30 PM (Central). SIR SCCA Board of Directors Meeting April 4, 2017

Present: Dave Lehrschall, Regional Executive; Richard Grav, Assistant Regional Executive; Paul Blaylock, Activities Chair; Jr Crowe, Assistant Activities Chair; Bob Sonntag, Treasurer; Lora Blaylock, Secretary; Paul Dornburg, *Pit Stop*; MacKenzi Crowe, Women of SIR; Terry Davis, Stacy Grav, Brad Schroeder, guests

Regional Executive Dave welcomed everyone to the meeting and called for officer reports. Treasurer Bob reported that the club has funds available, and we have made over \$100 in patch sales! Activities Chair Paul Blaylock reported that there is one Rally still looking for a master on June 4, and an Autocross in need of an event marshal on August 20. Thanks to all for confirming and clarifying dates via email. He also offered his support to the Women of SIR with programming events. Finally, Paul Blaylock thanked everyone for coming out to his first rally - all 9 cars made it to the finish, stopping at all the checkpoints along the way! Paul Dornburg noted that *Pit Stop* is on the way to mailboxes, and we added 3 members since last month. Assistant RE Richard noted that *Pit Stop* is available in two formats on the website - as a downloadable .pdf or to read directly on our page. RE Dave reported that our charter renewal has been approved, and he's waiting on the paperwork to return from National.

MacKenzi noted that the next Women's event is on April 25 at the Breakout Room in Evansville. Reservations are required. Please keep sharing info on the ladies' events on social media, email, and by word of mouth. Don't forget that women do not need to be SIR or SCCA members to join in the social events. The group is interested in gathering the Friday before autocrosses to review the course (if available) and talk strategy, etc. MacKenzi and "Barbie" have received national attention from SCCA and Mazda for her efforts in getting more women involved in autocrossing. A Women's meeting is planned at Nationals again this year.

In old business, Dave expressed thanks to the Board for their thoughts and patience in discussing Patch Party dates and details online over the past month. Earnest teamwork has led to some new opportunities. He is still interested in confirming a 'leader' for the event. Richard and Jay Wolf will take care of the equipment reservations and concrete ordering. Dave reported that the Memmers will again provide barrels and pumps. The Cut day is 4/22, Dig day is 4/13; Fill day is (Saturday!) 4/29. The schedule is firm, and start times will be confirmed on the website, email, and social media.

The Women of SIR autocross is scheduled for Saturday, June 10. Paul Dornburg is helping prepare the course. What other needs are there? MacKenzi reported a list of potential workers would be helpful, and solo safety stewards will be needed. Paul Blaylock asked about trophies - they don't have to be the regular trophies, but could be anything! MacKenzi will think about trophy options. Dave will invite women from nearby SCCA regions to join us, with a maximum of 60 entrants.

The Test and Tune day is set for May 20, the day before the season's first Autocross. Dave has the layout ready: it will be a smaller course with slaloms and a big radius. The course will be flipped and added to for the May 21 autocross.

Paul Dornburg is working with Bob on obtaining new loaner helmets. The current best pricing is between \$63 and \$180 per helmet. Lora noted that 'bouffant caps' (like those worn in food service) have been donated and will be used with the loaner helmet if the user does not have their own balaclava. Hopefully these, along with our protocol of sanitizing and odor-removing sprays will help keep our new helmets fresh for a long time!

In new business, Dave reported that no one from the general membership has contacted him about joining the Bylaws committee. A few change/update suggestions have been received via email, and the committee will review them and present proposed changes at May's membership meeting.

Dave is accepting ideas for getting more folks to attend the monthly Membership meetings. He plans to share patch party and bonus program details. Richard will have a fresh box of event date cards available for folks to share.

As there was no further business, it was moved and voted to

adjourn.

Membership Meeting

April 11, 2017

Regional Executive Dave Lehrschall welcomed everyone to the meeting on a lovely spring evening, and called for officer reports. The reading of the minutes was dispensed with following motion and second, and Secretary Lora Blaylock encouraged all to keep up with Board and Membership minutes in *Pit Stop*. Treasurer Bob Sonntag reported that the club is current with all bills and has a positive balance in the bank. In addition, sew-on SIR patches are available for a mere \$5 each, or more in multiples! He presented the fresh-from-the-mail approved Charter paperwork (including an official certificate!) to Dave. Paul Dornburg reminded folks to let him know if you no longer need a paper copy of *Pit Stop*. Assistant RE Richard Grav reported that he was damn glad to be in attendance, and had a fresh box of event date cards for folks to pick up and pass along to potential attendees. Dave thanked the board for their persistent work on the patch party scheduling.

Activities Chair Paul Blaylock reported that competition season has begun, and we have events! He thanked the 9 teams that came out for his debut rally on April 2. All teams made it to the finish, passing all the checkpoints along the way! Be sure to come to the May membership meeting for the trophy presentation. The next points-earning event will be Ben Davis' Rally on May 7. Watch your information streams for details. One Autocross (August 20) and one Rally (June 4) are still lacking leaders; contact Paul Blaylock to claim your first-place points by leading these events!

April is Patch Party month! This year, three workdays are scheduled: Cut Day is Saturday, April 22, beginning at 10:00 a.m. CDT. Bonus and Berry points will not be earned on this day, as the required number of workers is small. Dig Day is Sunday, April 23, beginning at 9:00 am CDT. This will happen rain or shine, so wear appropriate clothing. A full day of digging will earn 5 Berry points and 1 bonus run. Fill Day is scheduled for Saturday, April 29 (rain date 4/30), beginning at 10:00 a.m. CDT. All the holes that have been dug must be filled. A day of filling will earn 5 Berry points and 1 bonus run. RSVP to: patchparty@sirscca.org. Hand tools such as shovels, hoes, rakes, and concrete finishing tools are welcome. Thanks to Memmer Tile for the use of water pumps, barrels, and hoses. If you only earn one bonus run this season, it must be taken in the first heat without exception (due to scoring difficulties).

Women of SIR Chair MacKenzi Crowe was unable to attend, but Dave shared that she is doing a great job in working to increase women's participation in activities. The group has enjoyed several social activities, and has another event - at the Evansville Breakout Room - scheduled for April 25. Let MacKenzi know if you'd like to come with an email to women@sirscca.org. All women - no need to be an SCCA member - are welcome! A women-only Autocross has been scheduled for Saturday, June 10. Ride-alongs and instruction will be available. Men will comprise the support/work staff for the event. Workers will be eligible for Berry points. There will be a maximum of 60 entrants for the day, but one does not need to be a SIR member to attend and compete. Dave also noted that MacKenzi and her car, Barbie, have been featured in a story on Mazda.com, and have also received national SCCA recognition for her work encouraging more women to autocross.

The Bylaws will be reviewed and any changes to be made will be voted on at May's membership meeting. The current Bylaws are available for your reading pleasure on the SIR website. Have a read through and send any suggestions for updates or changes to the committee (via treasurer@sirscca.org) by the end of April.

A Test and Tune event is scheduled for Saturday, May 20 at the MAAC. A short course featuring slaloms and a large radius turn will be featured. Come out and see how your winter car improvements turned out! It will also be a good time for ride alongs and tips. The regular autocross fees will apply. If you are a 'weekend member', your Saturday membership fee will carry over to Sunday (autocross fees will still apply for Sunday). Watch your information streams for details.

Dave thanked everyone for coming, and reminded all to tip our server, who has served tonight's group solo. The door prize was won by Bob Sonntag, after which the meeting adjourned.

Who's Eligible?

All event participants are eligible. SIR or SCCA membership is not required.

Program Description

Those working a qualifying activity (determined by the SIR/SCCA board) are entitled to one extra run in each heat of an SIR/SCCA autocross. These "bonus runs" are scored and count like any other run. The expected result is that those that have worked all of the qualifying events will have eight (8) runs in a typical autocross and those that have not qualified for the bonus program will have only six (6). Those qualified for only a single bonus run must take the bonus run in the first heat or forfeit it.
