November REport from Dave Lehrschall

We have one of our most important events coming up. It is our November 14th Southern Indiana Region's membership meeting. This meeting presents an opportunity for our membership to elect next year's SIR Board. We will also vote on the By-laws Committee's recommendations for amendments to the SIR By-laws. We have sent out ballots to our membership and you may mail these per the ballot instructions or bring them to the meeting. If you mail your ballot, please mail it as soon as possible, because only those ballots received before our November 14th meeting or presented during that meeting will be counted. The ballots include a listing of the October nominated Board candidates and descriptions of each proposed amendment. Please review these options and vote for your choice or write in your choice for SIR Officers.

Our SIR motorsports events season is winding down. That's not to say it's over. We still have lots going on. Bob Sonntag's Rally is coming up on November 5th. I'm hoping to find a navigator for the event. Though I'm out of the running for the Rally and Berry Points, I think the crowd at the top of the standings for these will make it a very interesting event. We'll meet at the Hardees located at 4249 US 41, Evansville, IN 47711. Registration and Tech Inspection will open at 12:30 PM Central with the first car off at about 1:00 PM.

If the weather cooperates we should also have one last Autocross to finish the season. Terry Davis is the Event Marshal for this year's Roberts' Park Fun Autocross planned for November 26th. This event always attracts a lot of local competitors. The course will be shorter than our MAAC courses, but Terry always manages to create a challenging technical course. The limited amount of paved surface means that we will only have room for street cars and no trailered cars. We will start earlier to ensure we have plenty of daylight for the later runs. Course setup will begin at 7:00 AM, Tech and Registration at 8:00 AM, and the Drivers Meeting at 10:00 AM. We should finish around 4:00 PM. (All times are Central).

Speaking of Autocross, this is where I have occasionally mentioned something about Jr. Crowe's performance. I received a little "grief" over mentioning Jr. so often. Therefore, I will not talk about Jr. or the last Autocross event and Mr. Crowe's top indexed finish over a large field of competitors in a borrowed car or the close finish payback to a very fast Richard Grav. All of this happened during a "rain event". The first runs were basically dry. It rained during the second set of runs and most of us ran 3 to 4 seconds slower, but the event was still very competitive. Ernie Roales designed a course that had a good mix of challenges with some tight sections and some interesting slaloms. What seemed like a 200 degree 15 ft. decreasing radius was especially fun after the rain fell. I never did feel like I negotiated that turn correctly. Maybe Ernie will bring it back in a future course design.

Our next SIR board meeting is scheduled for November 7th. You are always invited to attend our SIR board meetings and to contact the board to let us know how we can improve your Southern Indiana Region.

Our next membership meeting will be held on Tuesday, November 14th, 2017 at Smitty's Italian Steakhouse in Evansville. We'll begin meeting informally around 6:00 PM, begin eating around 6:30, and then start the meeting at 7:30 PM (Central). We hope to see you there.

SIR SCCA Board of Directors Meeting October 3, 2017

Present: Dave Lehrschall, Regional Executive; Richard Grav, Assistant Regional Executive; Paul Blaylock, Activities Chair; Jr Crowe, Assistant Activities Chair; Bob Sonntag, Treasurer; Lora Blaylock, Secretary; Paul Dornburg, *Pit Stop*; MacKenzi Crowe, Women of SIR; Terry Davis, guest.

Regional Executive Dave called the meeting to order, welcoming all. Secretary Lora is glad everyone is here. Treasurer Bob noted that the club's cash flow is good, and balances are ample to cover expected costs. Paul D thanked Richard for getting *Pit Stop* up on the web and looking good, as Paul had encountered difficulty with the email list. Paper copies should be in mailboxes by the end of the week. MacKenzi noted that she has shared an article (via email and social media) from Mazda Motorsport regarding the SCCA Women's initiative as well information from the Women's luncheon at SOLO Nationals to the membership. Dave led a brief discussion on connecting individual entrants who need a rally partner: general email to the group list, call specific people directly, or by a post on the Facebook event.

Moving to old business, Bob shared a memo detailing the proposed changes to the By-laws. These will be shared to the website in full and available at the October meeting. Proposal #1 will be an omnibus-type motion that will cover housekeeping and modernization changes related to gender neutral language, electronic communication, and removal of geographical areas that are not a part of SIR anymore. Proposal #2 defines two standing committees: a membership committee and Women of SIR. Proposal #3 will add a Women's Chair position to the board. Proposal #4 as presented involved two changes attempting to clarify filling the Advisor to the Board position, including requirements of potential nominees to that position. Following much discussion over the concern that the requirements were too steep and the addition was already addressed in the current bylaws, it was decided to edit Proposal #4 to only include an addition to Article IV, clarifying that each individual (on the board) shall possess one vote and hold only one office.

Ballots for the By-law changes as well as 2018 officers will be prepared and mailed two weeks before the November Membership meeting. All members of the current board are happy to continue in their positions in 2018, but the floor will be open for nominations of additional candidates at October's membership meeting. If the By-law Proposals 2 and 3 are adopted by the membership, the board intends to appoint someone in December to fill the new board position. Updates to the Competition Regulations will be taken care of by the board sometime in 2018.

The board discussed the recent TMMI autocross, wondering if there was a way to increase participation by TMMI. Dave noted that he felt TMMI's planning of the company-wide picnic the following day hurt our numbers. The board will try again to schedule this event earlier in the year in 2018. It was noted that the earlier-in-the-day schedule worked well, with gratitude to Paul Dornburg for heading to the MAAC a day early to set up the course. Dave reminded the board that he will be retiring from TMMI before next year's event comes around, and recommended the board work with Jeff Metz as the liaison with TMMI.

Recent events have enjoyed good attendance when an 'email blitz' was employed: the Yockey rally had a lot of email reminders and was well attended, while fewer emails were sent for the Rothermel rally, and only 2 teams participated.

Bob noted that we have a reserve date at the MAAC available: 10/22. Do we want to hold a fun (no points) autocross? Paul D volunteered to marshal the event, pending consultation with his schedule. He will give a firm answer before the Tuesday membership meeting. If Paul is not available, we will release the date. Terry noted that he has had difficulty getting an answer about the availability of Roberts Park for our Thanksgiving fun autocross on November 26th. He will continue in his efforts.

Paul D confirmed that the Christmas Party is scheduled for Friday, December 1st, and reminded all to consider candidates for the Indian award. A request to present a brief year-end financial report at the December party was received.

Jr. noted that he is talking to people at Alcoa to have them sponsor a TMMI-like autocross event for their employees. He will keep us updated on any progress.

Dave noted that as he looks forward to having more time to devote to club interests following his retirement, he is considering attending a Great Lakes divisional meeting (generally held several hours away). He thinks there may be value in sharing what we're doing and work on communications between us and other clubs. We may be able to enlist wider help for publicity and sponsorship of events. As there was no further business, the meeting adjourned.

SIR SCCA Membership Meeting October 10, 2017

Regional Executive Dave Lehrschall welcomed all to the meeting on the Patio at Smitty's. Treasurer Bob Sonntag noted that the club's finances are in good order. Assistant Activities Chair Jr Crowe was real happy be in attendance. Paul Dornburg noted the deadline for Pit Stop items and articles is October 25th. Assistant Regional Executive Richard Grav was damn glad to be there, and noted that some updates to the website may be delayed as he will be on vacation in the next week or so.

The club has enjoyed three competition events in the past month, and trophies were awarded to the victors. In Bob Rothermel's rookie rally, Round and Around, team Davis/Sonntag won the day in Class A, with a score of 155. Paul Dornburg's Pointer City autocross on September 17th saw good competition in twelve classes in addition to a five-car weekend member class. Paul D put in the best time of the day at 41.767 in the Green 911 in the combined class Super Street Modified and D Prepared, which saw five entrants. The four-car all-Miata class of E Street and E Street Ladies saw good competition, with Jr Crowe taking home the trophy with a time of 46.520. Steve Yockey and Ernie Roales' Donut Rally had five teams vying for perfection. Once again, class A won the day, with team Davis/Sonntag putting in a score of 151, and, like the previous rally, scoring a -3 on one leg! In class B, the top two teams bought well, and Jr and MacKenzi Crowe came out winners despite reportedly being lost for an hour.

Dave reported that the club has the MAAC reserved for October 22nd in the event an earlier autocross date had to be rescheduled due to weather. Following a show of hands, it was deemed that there is not enough interest to hold an autocross that day. Instead, we will look forward to the final rally of the season on November 5, when Bob Sonntag and Terry Davis will lead an afternoon of adventure beginning at the Hardee's on North 41. On November 26th, the Sunday following Thanksgiving, we will hold our annual 'fun' autocross at Roberts Park. Don't forget that there is no room for trailers there, so plan accordingly.

October brings a time of nominations and proposals for the membership to consider. Next month, we will vote on proposed changes to the club's By-laws. These proposals were reviewed at the September meeting and are available in full detail on the club

website. Included in the changes is the creation of a new board position. If this proposal passes, the board will appoint an interested party to fill the new position for 2018. A ballot for both the By-laws changes and 2018 Board members will be mailed to the membership later this month.

In preparing to open the floor for officer nominations, Dave reported that all board members have expressed willingness to continue in their current positions, but welcome all who are interested in serving. The following accepted nominations for 2018 board service:
