September REport from Dave Lehrschaal



The Southern Indiana Region's year has seemed to fly by. We've completed our 5th of 7 points events for both our Autocross and Rally programs. It's the time of the year when we review our earned points totals, drop worst events, and then calculate just how far ahead (or behind) we are relative to our buds. In my case, I've found myself 1 point (yes just one!) behind Jon Crowe after 5 events. We have 3820 and 3821 points respectively out of a potential 4000 points after dropping one. I'm sure that 4000 points are possible because once again Paul Dornburg is leading all with 4000 points. I don't know how the season will end up, but I'll bet Jon and I watch each other's finishes through the season end.

I should mention that I've managed to move down in the standings as Jon and others have been moving up. John McCarthy, MacKenzi Crowe, Scott Campbell, and others have steadily moved up. Each has found driving strategies that are working well for them. The season's not over and I'm sure every position will see challenges!

Our Rallies have been no less challenging. We have five members with between 17 and 20 points. This includes 2 regular A-class competitors (Bob Sonntag and Terry Davis), 2 regular B-class competitors (Jim Cannon and Ernie Roales), and my favorite navigator, Paul Dornburg, who has run in both classes to try and challenge the current points leader. There are still points opportunities and as in Autocross the Rally positions will be challenged through the last event!

This year has seen both programs attract healthy numbers of participants with some of the best times and scores achieved within our Guest and Weekend Member Classes. We are seeing new members. Our Patch Party effort was fantastic. Our Women on Track initiative continues to gain momentum. Thanks to the efforts of our SIR membership and your hard-working BOD, it's been a very good year! I've enjoyed working with the BOD and our special membership.

As we look to next year we need to think about our 2019 SIR Board of Directors. Our By-laws call for nominations of BOD candidates during our October membership meeting and the election to take place during our November membership meeting. It is time to begin speaking with those members you are considering for nomination to confirm their interest in serving. It is also a time for our members to consider self-nomination for these positions. Our organization is built on the strengths and various skills of our members. Please consider volunteering. I will step aside as the R.E. at the end of this year. I've been very proud to be a part of the Southern Indiana Region and I will work to support the new R.E.

I can't complete this edition of the Pit Stop without mentioning the 2018 SCCA Solo Nationals. The SIR will be represented by 10 members this year! Given the size of our Region, 10 participants traveling 12 hours to compete is outstanding. I think it speaks volumes about our interest in the sport and about the supportive relationships the members of this club have. We plan to display the Southern Indiana Region banner in Lincoln. I hope one of us wins. At a minimum, they'll know we were there! Wish us luck and follow us on the SCCA Nationals live and standings link.

Our next membership meeting will be held on Tuesday, September 11, 2018 at Smitty's Italian Steakhouse in Evansville. We'll begin meeting informally around 6:00 PM, begin eating around 6:30, and then start the meeting at 7:30 PM (Central). We hope to see you there!

August 21, 2018

Secretary's note: The August and September board meetings were combined and rescheduled due to availability of personnel on the original dates.

Present: Dave Lehrschall, Regional Executive; Richard Grav; Assistant Regional Executive; Bob Sonntag, Treasurer; Paul Blaylock, Activities Chair; Jr Crowe, Assistant Activities Chair; Lora Blaylock, Secretary; Paul Dornburg, *Pit Stop*; MacKenzi Crowe, Women's Chair; Dawn Sturgeon, SIR Women on Track Committee Chair; Stacy Grav, guest.

RE Dave welcomed all to the meeting and called for officer reports. Treasurer Bob reported that the club's funds are in good shape, and we received a thank you from Fairlawn United Methodist church for the donation in memory of former SIR Member Ron Groenert. Paul Dornburg asked for folks to turn in *Pit Stop* items by Tuesday, August 28. Women's Chair MacKenzi shared that she has a few more Women on Track stickers available, and she will be paying keen attention to the new child's area at nationals in a few weeks, hoping to bring back some good event childcare ideas and tips. SIR Women on Track Chair Dawn is looking into obtaining string backpacks with the Women on Track logo to be used as awards and/or incentives/attention getters.

As always, improvements can be made for future rallies but the Blaylocks were really pleased at the reception of their Brew to Bru rally. They appreciated Matt Beasley's comments as he checked the route for them. Dave consulted with Jeff Metz on his first autocross, which went off without a hitch. Jr's August 19 autocross also went well, and the Crowes were grateful to the crew at the MAAC for allowing them to RV Camp at the site. Jr is interested in working on the course map, creating a parts library of items that can be dragged and dropped by course creators. Finally, in review, it was noted that the August Membership meeting at the Log Inn was well attended. Thanks to Bob for coordinating the reservations.

The board discussed difficulties in hearing at the venue, and perhaps in the future, we could ask for our group to be placed away from other groups.

There was a question about the PAX index on the website - apparently the link is broken. Richard will take care of it. At the September meeting, the membership will be reminded that it is time to begin thinking about officer nominations. Please be sure to speak to the potential officer before making an official nomination. Dave noted that he does not plan to serve as RE again next year. The board discussed whether dues needed to be raised for 2019. Following discussion, a motion was made, seconded, and approved to not change the dues amount. Paul Dornburg noted that no changes to the By-Laws are needed this year.

Dave wondered if we should advertise our 2019 events in a local Car Show booklet. The deadline is soon. Paul Dornburg will migrate 2018 events to 2019 for everyone to review. While we do try to put certain events on certain weeks, there are exceptions that always come up. Of note this year is that we will not hold an autocross event for Toyota employees. Dawn will see if supplier Toyota Boshoku would be interested in having an event in the future. In addition, Paul Dornburg noted that the local Porsche Club of America has been invited to compete at our autocrosses in their own class, as a date to have a separate PCA autocross was not available this year.

Paul Blaylock will have another look at the calculation scheme for the Rookie trophy. Perhaps evaluating how well a rookie does in the events entered, with a minimum number of events factored in would be an alternative. Please send ideas to Paul Blaylock by September 15.

Bob reported that the entry gate at the MAAC is breaking down. We are using it more now that it needs to stay closed during events. After discussion, Bob will follow up with the MAAC to see if the \$5 per car we pay for events is enough to help repair the gate. Also discussed is the lack of a good system for manning the gate has not yet been developed. What about moving the tech station closer to the gate?

As there was no further business, the meeting adjourned.

Regional Executive Dave Lehrschall did preside over a brief business meeting, where officer reports were dispensed with upon motion and second. Awards were presented for two recent autocrosses. A counter-clockwise course started off with a pair of slaloms and U-turns, a left-hand sweeper, and a whop-de-do finish. 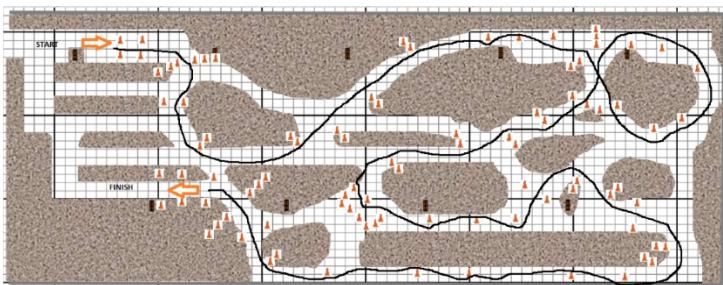

For the 1st time all year we ran in the clockwise direction for Jr. Crowe's "Are We There Yet?" autocross. But we still went counter-clockwise around the big circle!

40 competitors showed up to take a shot at the 50+ second course on what turned out to be a 90+ degree day.

Shortly after the start you took a hard right through the start lights followed by a hard, tight left turn to a hard on the gas short straight to another brake hard left to a long bend to the right. At the end of the bend was a 3-cone slalom that shot you at the entry to the big 360-degree left turn. After the circle it was a right left right complex before the "stop-the-car!" box to the left. First gear through another 3-cone slalom to a 90-degree left, a

more than 90 right to another hard left before a gradual right leading to the big slalom. One could try and keep a tight line and start the slalom on the right and exit on the left for the last right to the finish. Or, one could go left into the slalom carrying more speed and exit on the right where you had to slow anyway to make the last right. A pair of Pauls were at the top of the time sheets. Paul Gibson visited from the Columbus region and beat our previously undefeated Paul Dornburg. Gibson garnered the 1000 points with a 85.886 followed by Dornburg's 86.959. Richard Grav, Don Kelley and Jr. Crowe were 3rd through 5th respectively. Trophies will be presented at the September club meeting.
