Board of Directors Meeting

August 6, 2019

Ninki Japanese Bistro

Present: Bob Sonntag, Treasurer; Paul Blaylock, Activities Chair; Jr Crowe, Assistant Activities Chair; Lora Blaylock, Secretary; Paul Dornburg, *Pit Stop*; Dave Lehrschall, Advisor, Terry Davis, guest.

Board reports:

- Jr called the meeting to order, filling in for MacKenzi, who is unwell this evening. He, along with the rest in attendance, congratulated Paul Dornburg on the success of the Owensboro Motorsports Festival.
- Paul Dornburg noted that the August *Pit Stop* was printed in color due to his error. The deadline for the September issue is early - August 21, please.
- We currently stand at 136 members, a good number despite losing 10 over the last 2 months due to non-renewal.
- Lora will correct an error in the July board minutes, changing "paddock" to "grid."
- Advisor Dave polled the group on the value of publishing current point standings with a dropped event already calculated. The majority thought this could be confusing, with Paul Blaylock expressing surprise at how many folks make the effort to track points on their own.
- Bob reported that we earned over \$450 on the demonstration rally for the Owensboro Motorsports Festival.
- Paul Dornburg confirmed that we are able to hold a charitable event per discipline - one each for rally and autocross.

Old business:

- Terry is prepared to send the Columbia Shopping email to the membership and will talk about it at next week's membership meeting.
- Dave reported that the second KY Region Street Survival School went well, despite low attendance: only 7 drivers. The host region gets a stipend for hosting the event: \$800 plus \$60 per student. There is reportedly support from Evansville local dealership D-Patrick on holding one here in the future. Dave will continue educating himself on the event, with an eye for SIR possibly hosting one early next summer.
- Paul Dornburg noted that additional drivers from SIR tripled the money collected over the prior three weeks at the final Diamond Lake Dash competition attached to the Owensboro Motorsports Festival.
- Paul is nearing a date for the "test" phone app rally: late September or early October. (September 29th) This event will replace the cancelled Rally #2 from earlier in the year, so we will have 7 events on the rally schedule. He is awaiting the app's release so he can test it and finalize the route.
- The board discussed the Assistant Regional Executive position; Mike Monulio has had changes in his work and school requirements that don't allow him time to fill the job. In addition, his membership is currently lapsed, which makes him ineligible to serve on the board. He has expressed willingness to leave the position, and the board will accept that with understanding and regret if that move is confirmed. It is felt that the position is best left open at this time, as annual elections are right around the corner.

New business:

- MacKenzi (via the agenda) would like to see some mention of the contents of the minutes during membership meetings. Lora is happy to provide a brief summary/highlights.
- Should we discontinue printing *Pit Stop* on paper? It would save the club around \$800 a year. Paul Dornburg will add a request to the next few issues asking folks to indicate their preference of a paper or electronic version.
- The board thanked Paul Dornburg for asking Yancy to service all the club equipment at the end of the season, noting that we intend to pay regular prices.
- A list was comprised (and will likely be added to) of items that need to be repaired on the trailer: leaky windows and back door, RCA connections through the trailer wall, and connectors for the timing equipment.
- Terry modeled a "new" SIR logo shirt that he purchased from Pearl Embroidery. He is happy to be coordinate others' orders for the \$37 item, with a cutoff date at next week's membership meeting.
- Dues have not changed in a number of years, currently standing at \$18. Following discussion, it was moved, seconded, and unanimously agreed to raise them to an even \$20.
- Dave reported that he has been approached by a representative from the local Mini car club. They are interested in doing an autocross as part of a larger national event. The date is fixed - Thursday, July 9, 2020, and they would like to hold it at Kentucky Motor Speedway. Much discussion ensued - KMS is a banked oval track, not a good space for an autocross. The board would much prefer to host the event at the MAAC or Roberts Park. The club's cost of the event will include insurance costs, so the board suggests charging \$1,250 plus \$25 per car. It was moved, seconded, and agreed, that Dave will reply to the Mini club, offering for SIR to host an autocross at the MAAC or Roberts Park for them at the above-mentioned price. (Thanks, Dave!)

As there was no further business, the meeting adjourned on motion and second.

Regional Executive MacKenzi Payne-Crowe called the meeting to order and welcomed all to the famous Log Inn. (The club's August meeting is traditionally held here, as Scorpio's is closed every August.)

- Newsletter editor Paul Dornburg invited submissions for *Pit Stop* with a deadline of August 21.
- Treasurer Bob Sonntag noted that the club's financial obligations are current, and SIR earned nearly \$500 from a demonstration rally at the recent Owensboro Motorsports Festival.
- Activities Chair Paul Blaylock noted there was a great turnout for Bob Rothermel's recent rally and called the assembly's attention to this Sunday's autocross by Jr Crowe, "Tire Saver Nationals." The autocross will be short and fast, with a start inspired by previous Solo Nationals courses.
- Secretary Lora Blaylock summarized last month's membership minutes, following a directive by the Board to do so.
- MacKenzi reported that Assistant Regional Executive Mike Monulio has had a change in job and school responsibilities, forcing him to resign his board position. Elections for 2020 officers will soon be upon us, so the Board has decided to leave the position vacant until such time.
- MacKenzi encouraged everyone to watch tomorrow's (August 14) *Lifestyles* program on WEHT-TV as she and Jr (call him "Hollywood") as well as Paul Dornburg will promote the club on the lunchtime show.
- Finally, she reminded all that SIR folks will soon be on their way to Solo Nationals - think speedy thoughts and safe travels for them!
- Awards were presented for both July Autocrosses.
 - ERnie Roales' Quick and Dirty v7.19 saw 47 entrants in 16 classes, with two Pauls taking first and second place. Paul Dornburg continues his stretch of winning the day, but Paul Gibson gave a good chase. Three classes had enough entrants to award first and second place trophies, reminding all that it's not a bad thing to have two drivers for the same car.
 - Jeremy Crowe's inaugural effort, "Stay Unconquered", saw 32 entrants in 13 classes. Close competition was the order of the day with almost half the field earning 900 or more points.
- Terry Davis is taking orders tonight for embroidered SIR logo shirts - they are a sport polo with the club logo on them and cost \$37. The order deadline is tonight, so see Terry before you head home!
- Terry also reminded those assembled to take advantage of the private sale coupon at the Columbia Employee Store. An email was recently sent to all club members with the coupon attached. If you're having trouble finding it, be in touch with Terry or a board member.
- Paul Dornburg shared another "Who Reads *Pit Stop*?" quiz to determine the door prize winner of the evening. Five members had 7 (of 10) correct answers; tie-breaker questions reduced the number to 2. The winner was eventually determined by high card draw. Congratulations, Bob Sonntag!

MacKenzi closed the meeting by thanking our server for the evening and wished everyone a safe drive home.
