## November REport



We have one of our most important events coming up. It is our November 12<sup>th</sup> Southern Indiana Region membership meeting. This meeting presents an opportunity for our membership to elect next year's SIR Board. We have sent out ballots to our membership and you may mail these per the ballot instructions or bring them to the meeting. If you mail your ballot, please mail it as soon as possible, because only those ballots received before our November 12<sup>th</sup> meeting will be counted. The ballots include a listing of the October nominated Board candidates. Please review these nominees and vote for your choice or write in your choice for SIR Officers. If you write in a choice make sure that member is a willing choice.

Our SIR motorsports events season is winding down. That's not to say it's over. We still have lots going on. Bob Sonntag's rally is coming up on Sunday, November 10<sup>th</sup>. It will begin at the Hardee's located at 4400 Covert Ave., Evansville, IN 47714. Registration and Tech Inspection will be open from 12:30 to 1:00 PM Central with the first car off at about 1:30 PM.

If the weather cooperates, we should also have one last autocross to finish the season. This year's Roberts Park Fun Autocross is planned for Sunday, December 1<sup>st</sup>. This event always attracts a lot of local competitors. The course will be shorter than our usual Lawrenceville courses, but it is always a challenging course. The limited amount of paved surface means that we will only have room for street cars and no trailered cars. We will start a little earlier to ensure we have plenty of daylight for the later runs. Course setup will begin at 7:00 AM, Tech and Registration at 8:00 AM, and the Drivers Meeting at 10:00 AM. We should finish around 4:00 PM. (All times are Central). If the weather looks iffy keep an eye on our Facebook page and our email list for announcements.

Our next membership meeting will be held on Tuesday, November 12, 2019 at Smitty's Italian Steakhouse in Evansville. We'll begin meeting informally around 6:00 PM, begin eating around 6:30 PM, and then start the meeting at 7:30 PM (Central). We hope to see you there.

### **Board of Directors Meeting**

**October 1, 2019**

Ninki Japanese Bistro

Present: MacKenzi Payne-Crowe, Regional Executive; Bob Sonntag, Treasurer; Paul Blaylock, Activities Chair; Jr Crowe, Assistant Activities Chair; Lora Blaylock, Secretary; Paul Dornburg, *Pit Stop*; Dave Lehrschall, Advisor; Terry Davis, guest.

#### **Officer reports**

- MacKenzi called the meeting to order and thanked Terry for joining the meeting.
- Bob reported that the club has ample funds, and that a fresh supply of wristbands is on the way.
- Paul Dornburg reminded all the *Pit Stop* deadline is Wednesday, 10/23. An error was missed before the October edition was sent to the press and will be fixed for the online version.
- MacKenzi reported that Stacy (Women's Committee Chair) has been unable to attend meetings but has been following the board's events through online sources.
- Dave reported that tech at the most recent autocross featuring the start at the far end of the course went well, and the crew was firm about not accommodating late arrivals. It was suggested that parking be reviewed before using the 'reverse' setup again.

#### **Old Business**

- It was confirmed that there are no needed changes to the bylaws at this time.
- The 'app' rally was also reviewed. It went well, and folks liked it. The 'app' can be applied to an existing rally without difficulty and eliminates the need for checkpoint workers. The only issue Paul Dornburg found was that he couldn't edit the start time at the last minute, but it was easy to fix errors from those phones that didn't pick up the late change.
- Paul Dornburg reported that the official 501(c)(3) letter has been received. He will follow through with any year-end forms that we must file. He has also been keeping an eye on all our online info streams and trying to keep them in sync.

#### **New Business**

- MacKenzi led a discussion of board positions for 2020. Who is interested in continuing in their position, moving to a new position, or retiring?
  - Jr is ready to move on from the Tech/AAC position
  - MacKenzi is interested in returning to the Women's Chair, about which she is quite passionate.
  - Others are also thinking of making changes.
- MacKenzi will send an email encouraging the membership to consider board service, and to talk to others before nominating them at the October Membership meeting.
- Dave reported that he has worked most recently with Jacob Campbell on his autocross, and he is happy to do the same with other new autocross designers but noted that he needs a few weeks lead time to make it happen.
- Thanks to Paul Dornburg for quickly replacing the autocross printer after the old one died. We now have spare parts as well as a working printer! Paul is also talking to Gene Young about a new display.
- Looking ahead to the 2020 schedule, Paul Dornburg has pre-set dates based on the 2019 calendar, and asks the board to have a look at where things landed.
- Bob is checking with the country club for any menu changes for the annual banquet and will confirm the date of same.
- He also confirmed with the board that the October 13<sup>th</sup> "extra" date at the MAAC can be cancelled, provided the October 6<sup>th</sup> autocross doesn't get rained out.
- The site and insurance for the December 1<sup>st</sup> fun autocross are in place. Paul Dornburg is working to codify the weather constraints for go/no go and will share soon. Only changes due to inclement weather are expected at this point. Equipment logistics were discussed, and Dave (thanks!) will bring the trailer to Evansville.
- Paul Dornburg will share information about the Central Division Hall of Fame nominations to the club's Facebook page. MacKenzi will remind all via email of next week's membership meeting.
- Paul Dornburg has a stash of old *Pit Stop* issues and will take them to Watkins Glen for historic storage.
- He also noticed that the former Lincoln Mall in Owensboro, now a church, might be a likely site for a Street Survival School. There is ample parking without obstruction. He will talk to the officers of the church which has taken over the former mall.
- Terry reported that he spoke with a member of the SIR Brit and Mini club about why SIR declined to put on the autocross for the Mini group. We may hear back from them with new interest.
- Bob reported a conversation with the new assistant manager at the MAAC about getting more folks to the airport. There may be future opportunities for SIR to support the MAAC in this as well as earn funds for the club.
- The board also discussed and then tabled the idea of keeping some equipment currently stored in the trailer elsewhere at the MAAC.
- The Board discussed the Indian award.

In closing, MacKenzi noted that she will be away for the November membership meeting and is working on someone to take her place.

As there was no further business, the meeting adjourned.

### Membership Meeting

October 15, 2019

(Secretary's note: the meeting was held a week later than usual as the regular date coincided with the annual Fall Festival on Franklin Street.)

- Regional Executive MacKenzi Payne-Crowe called the meeting to order and welcomed all back to the main dining room at Smitty's on Franklin Street.
- Activities Chair Paul Blaylock reminded all to mark their calendars for the rally on October 27.
- Treasurer Bob Sonntag reported that the club's finances are excellent shape coming into the end of the year.
- Secretary Lora Blaylock assured all that the Board is, as always, hard at work to benefit the club, and reminded all to read the minutes of the club in *Pit Stop*.
- MacKenzi reported that the board has recommended to increase club dues to \$20, whether an individual or family membership. Treasurer Bob made a motion to raise dues to \$20, which was seconded and passed with one opposing vote.
- The club was reminded of three upcoming events:
  - Rally #6 on October 27: Dave Lehrsfall's rally "The Search for Orange October" will begin at the Penn Station restaurant on Green River and Lynch Roads.
  - Rally #7 on November 10<sup>th</sup>, Bob Sonntag's rally "Parks and Rec" will start at the Hardee's on Covert Avenue.

- Awards were handed out for the Windy Hollow App rally, which featured the use of a smartphone app to record checkpoint times. 4 teams vied for perfection on September 29 in Owensboro, with 7 zeroes achieved over 13 checkpoints. Terry Davis & Bob Sonntag won the day in class A with a score of 23. Harold and Karen Davis won B Class with a score of 86. Watch for more rallies to use the app in the future.
- 39 entrants buzzed cones at the MAAC on September 15 with a familiar name (Paul Dornburg) taking top honors of the day once again. He had close competition from Jim Cannon, who borrowed Jon Schwartze's BMW, and ended only 2 points behind Dornburg. There were 7 folks in a combined DS, DSL, and ES class, with three trophies awarded.
