The Southern Indiana Region of the Sports Car Club of America has an exciting new year ahead of it! Your SIR board of directors has been at work planning our 2020 calendar of events and scheduling supporting activities. There are always a lot of things going on between our meetings and competitive events. The winter off-season is also very busy. This year we are working to include another Owensboro Motorsports Festival weekend and to provide autocross support for the Midwest Muscle-car Challenge.

As we start off a new year, I want to share a few of my 2020 goals for the SIR. Most of these involve increased participation in SIR activities by our membership. I believe this increased participation presents both short-term and long-term benefits to our club. The first is simply the survival of the Southern Indiana Region. Don't panic! The SIR is doing well, but while I can't speak for everyone, I can say that after numerous board positions including my seventh stint as Regional Executive (3 in the Pan American Region) the club must always be actively working on recruiting new members and recruiting future club officers. Some of us are getting a little older and won't always be able to cut, dig, and pour concrete or to fill the board positions as they should be filled.

We have had opportunities to share our rally and autocross stories with potential members and our 2020 calendar of events including membership meetings will give us more opportunities. My hope is that these few events will see more than our usual half-dozen members in attendance. We have 40 to 50 people attend autocross events and 10 to 20 attend our rally events. I think it would speak more powerfully of what great activities these SIR events are if we had more than a handful of the regular event attendees show up to talk about and share their experiences. Our planned 2020 Owensboro Motorsports Festival and Midwest Muscle-car Challenge involvement will put us face to face with people, who love to drive cars. We'll have great opportunities to talk to first time rally or autocross participants about how their experiences relate to our SIR events. I like car shows and I like the Cars and Coffee events, but we need to talk to proud car owners, who want to drive their cars competitively.

The SIR will continue to hold our membership meetings on the second Tuesday of each month with a couple of exceptions as noted in our 2020 calendar. These meetings are literally many things to different people. To the SIR membership the meetings provide opportunities to distribute critical club information, to vote on club initiatives, and to socialize with other club members. To visiting prospective members the meetings, give a view of who we are and hopefully an enticing view of the club events and operations. To the restaurant owners and servers these meetings represent a potential for the space we occupy to return a fair business income. This is important. If we do not have enough members show up regularly to make the provided meeting room profitable, we might lose it and those SIR opportunities I mentioned. Smitty's Italian Steakhouse on Evansville's Franklin Street has been a regular sponsor of these meetings providing a nice room for us at no cost to the SIR. Please plan to attend the SIR meetings and enjoy a meal. If you are in Smitty's at another time, please identify yourself as an SIR member.

If you have never attended an SIR rally, I really hope you'll try it this year. I'm a gearhead. I disassemble and reassemble stuff on my car just to do it. I'm a lead-foot. I slow down as I approach roundabouts to allow traffic to clear so I may drift my way around those beautiful traffic management constructions with what's left of my hair on fire. Rallies are different, but they are a blast! Yes, there are some technical instructions that you must learn, but if you can learn to play Euchre, you can learn the basics of rally guidelines. Like in Euchre you'll team with someone as you compete. If you don't have a rally partner, please contact me or the SIR event's Rally Master and we'll pair you with someone. If you would like you may ride along to see what goes on during a rally event as an observer. You may also watch for our finalized 2020 schedule and Bob Sonntag's Rally school to be held in February.

Finally, I want to ask you to start thinking about supporting an SIR-sponsored Tire Rack Survival School event. These events do more than just generate revenue for the SCCA regions. They also prepare young drivers to handle the vehicle they normally drive, but under extreme conditions. Many will get the only training they'll ever experience with ABS initiation, understeer or oversteer corrections, and more. We won't be teaching competitive driving, but we will be working on safer driving.

This should be a great year for the Southern Indiana Region!

SIR SCCA member Gabe Fehribach started racing open wheel in 2019. He started off attending Bondurant Racing School's Grand Prix Racing 4-Day class where he finished at the top of his class. He burned through a set of racing tires down to the cords in his Hellcat in just three days! Day four was spent in a Formula Mazda on Bondurant's full racecourse. His next stop was attending Bertil Roos's Advanced Formula Racing class at Palm Beach International Raceway, where he spent his time in an F2000 and earned pole position in both races to finish out the class.

After meeting with different teams, he decided on running Formula Enterprise 2 (FE2) with the now six-time SCCA Formula Enterprise national champions Alliance Autosport. (Interesting facts: Alliance Autosport supported both the first and second place finishers in the 2019 SCCA national championship in the FE class and had a podium finish in the faster FE2 class.)

His first race with the team was at the mega-fast Watkins Glen International, where he earned double podiums and even led FE2 at one point in race 2 on Sunday. His fastest trap speed at entry to turn one was reportedly 132mph.

His next stop was at a rain-drenched Mid-Ohio weekend. Both practice and qualifying for Race 1 were in the dry but 30 minutes before the race was to begin, the skies opened up their wet fury. The change in weather forced the team to scramble on a setup change, which included ride height, sway bars, wet tires, downforce, etc. Gabe had never run in the rain in an open wheel car, so race 1 was to be his first lesson. With the rain coming down his focus was to earn some seat time and bring the car home, which he did quite successfully. National champion team owner Scott Rettich later told the team that Mid-Ohio is the toughest track in the country to race in the rain. He added that if you can race in the rain there, you can race anywhere. One of the team's Spec Racer Ford Gen 3's had such a bad wreck that weekend that the impact actually cracked the engine block; the driver walked away OK.

His 2020 season will start with a new seat fitting in his own car in February. He looks to be on track for the "March into Spring at VIR" event at Virginia International Raceway in March.



2020 Board of Directors



Regional Executive: Dave Lehrsall is back as our Regional Executive after one year as the Board Advisor. Dave's been an SCCA member for 15 years and joined our region in November of 2012. Dave is eagerly awaiting the warm weather so he can autocross his brand new 2020 Mustang. He has gone to the last 4 Solo Nationals competing in F Street. In 2019 he was 8th in autocross points, tied for 3rd in rally points, and 6th in Berry points.



Assistant Regional Executive: Jonathan Crowe, also known as Jr., is starting his 4th year on the Board. He joined the SCCA in July of 2010 and was persuaded to join the board in 2016. His primary interest is autocross and he's been to the last 4 Solo Nationals. Jr. finished 2nd in the 2019 autocross points driving the Crowe family Porsche Cayman. He was also 9th in rally points and 5th in Berry points this year.



Treasurer: Bob Sonntag is a long time SCCA member, 39 years, most of which are with SIR although he did spend a few years in the southwest when his job changed. He's been a board member for a long time holding most of the positions available over the years. He's won the club's Berry Trophy many, many times as well as the Autocross and Rally trophies many times. His favorite SCCA activity is rallying. He enjoys putting them on as well as competing. This year he finished 1st in the rally points, 1st in Berry points and 11th in autocross points.



Secretary: Ernie Roales has been an SCCA member since 2009 and is a new Board member for 2020. He has previously served on the board a few years ago. He intends to compete for all the club trophies in 2020. ERnie has been the event marshal for a few autocrosses known as "Quick & Dirty". He also hosts a road rally in the Robinson IL area. In 2019 ERnie was 3rd in Berry points, 5th in autocross points and tied for 3rd in rally points.



Activity Chairman: Carrie Moore has previous experience with our board from a few years ago before her family moved to Savannah, GA for a period of time. She returned to the Evansville area in October of 2008 and immediately attended the October club meeting with her then new baby boy Miles. After a brief hiatus from the club, Carrie came back in 2018 to compete in the rally series. In 2019 she finished 17th in Berry points and 2nd in rally points.



Assistant Activity Chairman: Barry Beaman has been a long-time car guy and has been with the club since 2001. This is his first time on the board. When driving his red Honda S2000 he is always at the top of the list of competitive autocrossers in our club winning championships in 2011 and 2017. In 2019 Barry was 13th in Berry points and 4th in autocross points. You'll see him at autocross tech inspections.



Women's Chair: MacKenzi Payne-Crowe is returning to her role as Women's Chair in 2020. MacKenzi has been a club member since 2013 and was the 2019 Regional Executive. She's been an advocate for more female participation since 2016 when she was first affiliated with the Board. She has been to the last 4 Solo Nationals with a 2018 3rd place trophy her best finish so far. While at the Solo Nationals she has been to the annual Women's Luncheon meeting to discuss furthering the role of Women in the SCCA. This year she was 33rd in rally points, 16th in autocross points and 15th in Berry points.



Pit Stop Newsletter editor: Paul Dornburg has been on the Board every year except 2014 since 2000. Paul joined the SCCA in 1996 and it took 4 years for Ken Andrew to talk him into joining the Board. Paul starts his 11th year as the newsletter editor. He also has a 5-year stint as Regional Executive 2006 to 2010. Paul's favorite club activity is autocrossing where he's been the autocross points champion 8 times since 2000. He also has a Rally championship somewhere in the 20+ years he's been with the club. This year he was first in Autocross points for the second year in a row. He also was tied for 7th in rally points and he was 7th in Berry points.



Advisor: Although not an official Board member now, Terry Davis has filled almost all the Board spots since joining the club back in 1972. (47 years) He attends almost all the Board meetings to offer advice, guidance and history. He also makes the requests for event sanctions for all our autocrosses and rallies. He's been going to the Solo Nationals for over 20 years and is a constant competitor in all our events. In 2019 he was 1st in rally points, 11th in autocross points and 4th in Berry points.

SCCA: A club with many interests

Many faceted in its endeavors, the Sports Car Club of America (SCCA) might best be described as a service organization. It serves over 50,000 members throughout the United States by sanctioning and administering a variety of automotive related activities through more than 115 independently chartered regions. No other single motor sports organization in the world conducts more events than the SCCA. These events range from amateur and professional road racing to road rallies, autocrosses, rally crosses, hill climbs and auto shows. The SCCA is an ever-growing organization for the automotive enthusiast. Because the SCCA is member oriented, the club stresses participation on a broad basis. Regardless of your experience or background, if you are an automotive enthusiast there is a place for you in the SCCA. The avenues available range from amateur or professional road race driver to weekend rally or autocross driver to race worker or official. In order to successfully sanction and conduct a comprehensive autocross/rally/road racing program many experts in timing and scoring, communications, safety inspection, medical, flagging, course/race control and other skills are needed. Schools are held to train the drivers and workers and various degrees of licenses are awarded based on knowledge, ability and experience.

Pit Stop is the official publication of the Southern Indiana Region of the Sports Car Club of America, Inc. and is published monthly at PO Box 1112, Evansville, IN 47706.
