Sometimes I talk about the months of December through April as our Southern Indiana Region's "downtime." I need to correct this. We have all kinds of stuff going on during this period. While we don't have championship rally or autocross points events during this time, it is certainly not a quiet time. Many of our members are working on adjustments to their cars hoping they can improve on last season's performance. Some SIR members like Mike Mounlio are working on major car changes. Aside from the individual wrench-turning there is a lot of work going on to prepare for our 2020 season.

A draft calendar is our usual starting point. We work to avoid family holidays and scheduling too many championship points events in a short period of time. Three or four weekends of competition in a row may suit

some. But because we know that our members have other interests and responsibilities, we try to include open weekends between our events. Working from the draft, we submit a proposal to the authorities at the Mid-American Air Center (MAAC) in Lawrenceville, IL for our autocross schedule and usage plan. These dates must be set in place months in advance to arrange for events' insurance approvals. After we receive the MAAC's schedule approval the plan is submitted to the FAA. The FAA approval is not a sure thing. They take activities on secure sites very seriously. The MAAC and FAA expect users of the airport property to not only pay for the usage, but to also respect the property. Our annual concrete repair work is more than an autocross supporting activity. Bob Sonntag does a great job of explaining how along with our usage fees our investment in concrete and repair man-hours benefits the MAAC. We need the MAAC and these Patch Party efforts are critical. Once these autocross dates are confirmed we go forward with notifying our insurance company and the SCCA of these dates. Our calendar is tweaked as needed and then released for publication. SIR informational flyers and schedule cards are then printed.

Our annual Rally School will be held again in February. Bob Sonntag will be leading this. The event will be held on February 22<sup>nd</sup>, 2020 from 10:00 am to 1:00 pm at the EVPL Central at 200 SE Martin Luther King Jr Blvd in Evansville, IN. Key topics will include definitions, main road rules, and best practices. The school will be held in the Large Group Room of Central Library in downtown Evansville. That's up the steps and to the left. A graduation party trip to Hacienda for lunch is likely. Class tuition will be \$5 per person. Bring paper and writing implements. There will be tests.

Bob will follow up the next week with a fun rally, Leap Day Rally "Strive to be Average", on February 29<sup>th</sup>, 2020 from 12:00 pm to 4:00 pm starting at the Willard Library, 21 N First Ave, Evansville, IN.

We've moved the Solo Safety Steward and Autocross Introduction training classes to coincide with the Test n' Tune event on May 2<sup>nd</sup>, the day before our first championship points autocross event.

We have early autocross-related activities beginning with our Sunday, March 1<sup>st</sup> Patch Party Preparatory Visit from 10:00 am to 2:00 pm at the Lawrenceville-Vincennes Airport, Lawrenceville, IL. This is typically a board activity, but all are welcome to attend. Areas of the autocross site that are to be repaired or expanded will be marked this day. If you'd like to have input on the areas of the site that need to be repaired, please join us. (The rain date will be March 7<sup>th</sup>). Please check our calendar for all the Patch Party Cut, Dig, and Fill dates and e-mail me if you plan to attend or have questions. (re@sirscca.org)

Paul Dornburg and Terry Davis are planning an early fun autocross, the Snow Buster Autocross, for Sunday, March 8<sup>th</sup>, 2020 from 7:00 am to 4:30 pm at Roberts Park in Evansville, IN. Please watch the website and SIR membership e-mails for weather updates. If the weather is decent, we'll be autocrossing. If it is too cold or nasty for corner station work, we'll post event cancelation updates. SIR members should bring their membership cards to speed registration. There will be no trailered cars permitted, because there isn't enough room for trucks, trailers, and competing cars. The SCCA has noise restrictions. Remember, no un-muffled cars or muffled, but loud cars will be allowed. (If you must ask, it's too loud). We are in a residential area and want to be good neighbors so we can use this site again.

Membership meetings will be held on the second Tuesday of each month and our Board of Directors meeting on the first Wednesday of each month. Our next membership meeting will be held on Tuesday, February 11<sup>th</sup>, at Smitty's Italian Steakhouse on Franklin Street in Evansville. We'll begin meeting informally around 6:00 PM, begin eating around 6:30, and then start the meeting at 7:30 PM (Central). We hope to see you there! Dave Lehrschall

# SIR SCCA Board Meeting, January 8, 2020

# Aldersgate UMC, Lincoln Ave., Evansville, IN

Meeting called to order at 6:30 pm by Dave Lehrschall, regional executive

In attendance: Bob Sonntag, treasurer; Carrie Moore, activities chair; Barry Beaman, assistant activities chair; Paul Dornburg, newsletter editor; Jonathan Crowe, assistant regional executive; MacKenzi Payne-Crowe, Women's chair, via phone. Absent, ERnie Roales, secretary. Paul Dornburg taking minutes.

The first order of business was to appoint an advisor for the year. Carrie made a motion to make Terry Davis advisor. Bob seconded the motion. All voted in favor. Terry Davis is the 2020 advisor.

# Officer reports:

- Treasurer Bob, we have money. Annual summary sent to Board recently. Bob wants to dispose of some of the club stop watches and is looking at a watch that reads in tenths, hundredths of a minute. All agreed he could pursue that task.
- Activities chair Carrie said once schedule is finalized, she will pursue commitments for event marshals. Carrie will
  put on the first road rally on Sunday, March 15<sup>th</sup>. It will be the "Westside Something" rally. Carrie will talk to Paul
  Blaylock about the points spreadsheet on Drive and ask him to help get her familiarized with it. Paul Dornburg will
  make sure Carrie and Barry are set up as a region officers on the SCCA website so they can view member
  information.
- Assistant activities chair Barry said he had nothing at this time for his first board meeting.
- Newsletter editor Paul said the deadline for Pit Stop submissions is Wednesday, January 29th.
- Women's chair MacKenzi had nothing at this time.
- Assistant regional executive Jonathan had nothing at this time.
- Regional executive Dave wanted to know if the room was okay, was the schedule okay, and how about the pizza?
   Everyone agreed that all were good. He also said he'd try not to talk too much and have the meeting done by 8:00 pm.

# Old business:

- 2020 calendar, the entire calendar was reviewed month by month, here are the highlights
  - o January ok
  - February Bob will put on the rally school on Saturday, February 22<sup>nd</sup> and a Leap Day rally on Saturday, February 29<sup>th</sup>. It'll be called the "Strive to be Average" rally. The school will be at the Evansville Central Library. The rally start point will be announced at the school.
  - March the Patch Party preparatory visit was moved to Sunday March 1<sup>st</sup>. The Snowbuster autocross will be Sunday March 8<sup>th</sup>. The first rally will be Sunday March 15<sup>th</sup>. The Patch Party Cutting Day will be Saturday March 21<sup>st</sup>. The Patch Party Dig Day will be Saturday March 28<sup>th</sup> with a rain date of the next day. Dave Lehrschall will be in charge of recruitment for the workdays.
  - April The last Patch Party day, Fill day, is Saturday April 4<sup>th</sup> with a rain date of the 11<sup>th</sup>. Points rally #2 is Sunday April 19<sup>th</sup>.
  - May The Test and Tune and 1<sup>st</sup> autocross have been moved to the first weekend, the 2<sup>nd</sup> & 3<sup>rd</sup>. We are doing the timing and scoring for the Bowler Transmission Midwest Musclecar Challenge on May 15<sup>th</sup> and 16<sup>th</sup> in Terre Haute, IN. We need workers to be at the event at 8:00 am Eastern time. Points rally #2 is May 31<sup>st</sup>.
  - o June The Ladies autocross and autocross #2 are on June 13<sup>th</sup> & 14<sup>th</sup>. Autocross #3 is June 28<sup>th</sup>.
  - July Autocross #4 is July 12<sup>th</sup>. The "Ice Cream Rally" will be held on the Sunday of the Owensboro-Daviess County Motorsports festival weekend, July 26<sup>th</sup>.
  - August Rally #5 will be on Sunday August 9<sup>th</sup>. The August club meeting will be at the Log Inn on Tuesday August 11<sup>th</sup>. Autocross #5, the "Tri-Something" event will be on Sunday August 23<sup>rd</sup>. It'll be a warmup for the Solo Nationals in September.
  - September The club meeting is on the 3<sup>rd</sup> Tuesday of the month, September 15<sup>th</sup> because a lot of club members will be in Lincoln NE. Autocross #6 will be on Sunday, September 20<sup>th</sup>.
  - o October Autocross #7 will be October 4th. Rally #6 will be Sunday October 25th.
  - November Rally #7 will be Sunday November 8<sup>th</sup>. We will attempt to get the Fun Autocross done earlier in the month. Dave will research activities in that month to see when the Roberts Park lot will be available without conflicts with other organizations.
  - December The Awards Banquet is Friday December 4<sup>th</sup>.
  - Carrie made a motion to accept the calendar as proposed. Jonathan seconded the motion. All were in favor. The schedule is printed in the January Pit Stop
- 2019 SIR Tax filing Bob is working with James Shade, who has volunteered to help the club with the filing, to get this done so the filing notice can be submitted with the charter renewal.
- Autocross trailer repair Dave will move the trailer to Ernie's in Robinson, IL, for repairs. The rear door needs repair as does the lights. Dave will decide on the date of repair party and recruit workers.

- SIR event Lightning policy After much discussion about the lack of any SCCA direction it was decided that Paul Dornburg will prepare a policy to be reviewed at next board meeting. Jonathan found a phone app that can be used to warn of impending storms.
- Paul Dornburg is still working on sourcing a storage container for the autocross sight. We'd like a container to
  store the equipment in to minimize the amount of work needed to load and unload the trailer. Plus, we could roll
  the cone trailer inside it. More next month.
- Paul is also working on online registration via motorsportreg.com. More to come.
- Paul suggested that club members who autocross should have an annual inspection to cut down on the amount
  of work needed at autocrosses. Between pre-registering and annual tech, the time used for those operations
  would be reduced.
- Next week's club membership meeting will be the annual waivers signing. Terry Davis will have the waivers for people to sign and then he will send them to the SCCA. Members need to make sure they have an SCCA account at my.scca.com complete with a headshot so that the SCCA will issue an annual waiver hard card.

## New Business:

- Leap Day rally? Bob will put it on. "Strive to be Average" on February 29th.
- Rally app checkpoint fee The app developers want to charge a \$3 fee per car for rallys that have 11 or more cars. After some discussion we decided that the fee was fair, and we would continue to use the app for our rallys. Dave made a motion to let Bob manage up to \$50 per event fee. It was seconded and approved. In 2019 SIR put on 2 rallys with the app and both were well received. Those were 2 of 22 put on nationally.
- MAAC Patch Party survey team Dave will be he recruiter for the team that will map out the areas to be repaired this year. The survey day was moved to March 1<sup>st</sup> to avoid the Snow Buster autocross weekend on the 8<sup>th</sup>.
- Patch Parties promotion Bob will take on the task of promoting the Dig and Fill Patch Parties via email. Paul will
  duplicate his announcements on the Facebook page.
- Snow Buster Fun autocross Paul and team will mark the course on Saturday. Providing the weather is good the event will take place on Sunday March 8<sup>th</sup>.
- Website calendar, flyers, cards, should all agree with the 2020 calendar spreadsheet. The website calendar does agree. Facebook events will be setup. Events will also be set up on motorsportreg.com.
- Patch Parties Paul will check with Richard about procuring equipment. There was a discussion about the number of holes that should be patched, and can we back off from the number we have done in the last few years? The preparatory visit will concentrate on the grid area and access to the large paved area used in last year's September event. Other areas will be marked to use the thin patch that was used in a few places last year with good results.
- 2020 SIR Charter renewal All documents are in place for submission except for the tax filing status. Bob and
  James Shade will complete the filing process as soon as possible and forward the notice to Paul for the charter
  renewal submission.
- 2020 SCCA email regarding sanctions and event URLs. We will provide a URL that points to our home web
  page.
- Midwest Musclecar Challenge Mark Bowler asked SIR to support the MMC. Setup will be Friday afternoon May 15<sup>th</sup> at 2:00 pm eastern time with the event being run Saturday May 16<sup>th</sup> at 8:00 eastern time. SIR will design and setup a course and provide timing, scoring and course workers for the event. A motion was made to approve the request. The motion was seconded and approved.
- Owensboro Motorsports festival The festival for 2020 is not definite yet but the "Ice Cream Rally" will take place on July 26<sup>th</sup> whether the festival does or not. Once more details are known about the weekend they will be shared.

The meeting adjourned at 8:15 pm.

## Happy Rallyentines Month!

Every month is a good month for a road rally. This year and this month we also have an extra day. SIR will be making the most of that extra day. We have two rally events this month to help clear cobwebs, refresh rally skills, and have a little fun playing with cars. Our rally 2020 Rally Championship season kicks off next month with Carrie Moore's "Westside Something" rally. Let's be warmed up and ready.

Leaping back to this February, we have our time/speed/distance (T/S/D) rally class on Saturday, February 22. This year's class will focus on being able to follow the route and understanding the main road rules. Class will be held at the Central branch of the Evansville Vanderburgh Public Library and start at 9:30 in the morning. Materials will need to be prepared with some trees spared. Please let me know if you will be attending the rally class. There will be a \$5/person fee to help the with club expenses associated with the onthe-road "Final Exam" lab.

The month concludes with an "annual" Leap Day event. Some might think quadrennial, but I think every 2/29 makes for an "annual" event. Either way, the "Strive to be Average" rally is another Saturday event. The event will start from Willard Library, 21 North First Ave, Evansville. We will gather in the Archives Reading Room (part of the addition) with tech and registration from 12:30 CST to 1:00.

The "Strive to be Average" T/S/D rally will make extensive use of the Richta GPS Checkpoint system. Think fifty timed controls in a route of seventy miles or so. Every team will need an Apple or Android device with the GPS Checkpoint software installed. (It's free from the appropriate app store.) The route is not idiot-proof; but it is rather basic. There are just few different CASTs used in the route. Many of the controls are poorly placed -- shortly before turns that cannot be negotiated at the CAST and/or shortly thereafter. Teams are not expected to do well on half of those controls. Other controls might be just a mile, or two, or three from the previous speed change. Teams should be able to do well on these. Either way each control puts the team back on time headed into the next control. After the odometer check, how early or late can one get when there will be something like 50 controls in about 65 miles? So, maybe low scores ARE to be expected.

Late breakers and hard accelerators may find this rally to be maximum fun.

This should be a fun afternoon enjoying nicely paved roads of southern Indiana and a delightful way to go directly from Willard Library to Smitty's Italian Steakhouse in about 70 miles. Bob Sonntag
