#### **September RE Report**



I can't say that this year has flown by for the Southern Indiana Region. We have worked extremely hard on many projects and put in a lot of hours to keep things moving. The good news is that, after a starting delay, we are successfully managing both rally and autocross events. The bad news is that we are missing some regular members at these events. Given the COVID-19 threat and concerns for self and family, we are seeing more entrants than I expected. We will continue to focus on safety, and we will carry many of the changed procedures into the future.

It has been a long year. It is also my 7<sup>th</sup> year as an SCCA regional executive. (4 with the Southern Indiana Region and 3 with the Pan American Region in El Paso). I will not repeat as RE next year. My consulting business has picked up and volunteer work will leave this 3-time retiree little time for more than

autocross, rally's, and "honey-do's". As you begin thinking and talking about the SIR officers' nominations in October and the election of officers in November, please think about who you would like to serve in that and other positions.

Even though our rally and autocross seasons got off to a late start, the event managers and rally masters have done an outstanding job and these events have been some of the best events I can remember. We ran Paul Dornburg's autocross on Sunday that was approximately 1 mile in length with a 60-mph slalom, 180 degree turns and nice, fast sweepers. It was great! Our COVID-19 changes and a previous day's course set-up activities allowed nearly 40 drivers to have 8 runs each and still get back to Evansville long before dark. We are following the COVID-19 safety guidelines and having lots of fun. Come join us if you can.

By the time you read this, Sunday's rally will be completed, but there are more planned. I'm teaming up with Bob Rothermel for Terry Davis' rally on Sunday. Each rally team requires two people. We can help arrange teams if you find yourself without partner. Each team will have to decide how they will deal with social distancing, masks, etc. The rally's are now run primarily with the Richta app. I like this. Participants see their results at the time they pass each check point. If you're running slower or faster than you should run, you will see this and may adjust. Don't forget to check our SIR calendar for the next rally and autocross events.

We will plan on another Zoom meeting for our next membership meeting on September 15, at 7:00 PM. The meeting invitation link and password will be sent to our SIR e-mail distribution two days beforehand. Smitty's is open with social distancing guidelines in place. In case you don't know registration for all events will be done on www.motorsportreg.com, no exceptions

One will need to set up an account on MSR with your SCCA information as well as some other data. Registration closing date will be in the description of each event on MSR. One will enter payment information but will not be charged until after the event. That way if you are unable to get to the event, we will not have to process a refund. If you already have an account, make sure you update the "region of record" field with our region.

At autocrosses we have loaner helmets, but we only have 7 helmets. Helmets will be loaned on a first come first serve basis. We strongly suggest you purchase your own helmet to avoid contamination issues or that you find out too late that the helmets have been spoken for. certification chart.

If you do borrow a helmet for an event you will not share it with anyone else and you will disinfect it after returning it. We will have disinfectant on site. You should know your helmet size and that can be found by googling "helmet sizing chart" and reading the chart.

We strongly suggest that SCCA members fill out an annual waiver form. Download this form IN COLOR and bring it to the event. <a href="https://www.scca.com/downloads/14418-scca-adult-annual-waiver-1306-01-16/download">https://www.scca.com/downloads/14418-scca-adult-annual-waiver-1306-01-16/download</a> We will take the form and submit it to the SCCA and they will issue a hard card for the year. You must have a headshot in your SCCA profile for the hard card to be issued so make sure you have created your account and have uploaded a picture to your profile.

Also note that time schedules may change for events. In some cases, entry to the autocross site will only be for a limited period.

August 23<sup>rd</sup> was points autocross #4 for 2020. Paul Dornburg was the course designer. He designed a course with a start that would take away some of the advantage of launch control that is prevalent on the newer cars. He also had long open slaloms that would help the bigger cars but also help the more agile cars. 37 competitors showed up to try the course and see if they could improve over their last event results. Here's a quick analysis of the 16 drivers that have been at every event this year. It is their average points total after 4 events minus their average points total after 3 events.
