October RE Report



This has been a strange and stressful year for most of us. It has also been a year filled with success for the Southern Indiana Region. We continue to present rally and autocross events and we've attracted potential new members to many of these. I want to thank all, who have supported the SIR and continue to support it through the COVID-19 pandemic.

I'm having a great week for an autocrosser. I had delayed the purchase of new tires until this week. My tires weren't showing chords, but then they weren't showing much tread either. Saturday, I signed on to our www.sirscga.org website and then clicked onto our TireRack link to be sure the club would get a percentage of the sale. The tires arrived today (Tuesday) and they'll be mounted by my favorite installer tomorrow morning. Why am I so happy? New tires are always a good thing for autocross but having new tread just as the weather forecast is updated to include rain is a real stroke of luck. I'm a big fan of my tire brand on a dry surface, but when the tread has been nearly erased and the course or highway is wet, they can become scary slick!

I need a good autocross performance. Points autocross #6 is coming up on October 4th followed closely by the last points event #7 and the end of our 2020 SIR Autocross Championship. Tires alone won't do it, but I'm concentrating really hard on the two to three dozen key autocross actions I've been taught and asking myself, "What would Junior do?" Surely, there is an answer here that can help me catch Jon and that darn BMW!

Suellyn and I have been working on our rally, the Hunt for Orange October. This will take place on October 25th. We've changed it up significantly from last year's version. Exceptional visual acuity nor professional rallyist experience with tricky route instructions will not be required. We think it will be a straightforward rally. We will be using the Richta app so you will need to download the app on your I-phone or Android device.

The October 13th membership meeting will include nominations for our Southern Indiana Region's 2021 officers. Please consider making nominations or nominating yourself. I won't say that the work is easy. My experience with the SIR board of directors over the last many years tells me that all have committed time and honest consideration of the membership as they have performed their duties. I have also seen that they always work as a team and support each other. New board members should count on the support of experienced board members as they assume their new roles. Remember to ask your potential nominee whether they would accept the role if elected.

Bob Sonntag and Paul Dornburg have worked through a survey using SurveyMonkey to get your feedback regarding how we might conduct an SIR Awards Banquet. Please take the time to respond to this. It will help the board as it works on the potential banquet plans.

In case you don't know registration for all events will be done on www.motorsportreg.com, no exceptions

One will need to set up an account on MSR with your SCCA information as well as some other data. Registration closing date will be in the description of each event on MSR. One will enter payment information but will not be charged until after the event. That way if you are unable to get to the event, we will not have to process a refund. If you already have an account, make sure you update the "region of record" field with our region.

At autocrosses we have loaner helmets, but we only have 7 helmets. Helmets will be loaned on a first come first serve basis. We strongly suggest you purchase your own helmet to avoid contamination issues or that you find out too late that the helmets have been spoken for. The guidelines for helmet certification can be found here on the SCCA website:

If you do borrow a helmet for an event you will not share it with anyone else and you will disinfect it after returning it. We will have disinfectant on site. You should know your helmet size and that can be found by googling "helmet sizing chart" and reading the chart.

We strongly suggest that SCCA members fill out an annual waiver form. Download this form IN COLOR and bring it to the event. <https://www.scca.com/downloads/14418-scca-adult-annual-waiver-1306-01-16/download> We will take the form and submit it to the SCCA and they will issue a hard card for the year. You must have a headshot in your SCCA profile for the hard card to be issued so make sure you have created your account and have uploaded a picture to your profile.

Also note that time schedules may change for events. In some cases, entry to the autocross site will only be for a limited period.

T: Trophy winner.

What a fine day for an autocross was September 20th. 32 drivers were onsite for points autocross #5 on a course designed by MacKenzi Crowe. So how would the drivers do on this beautiful day? Would they improve on their previous scores or decline? Of the 16 drivers that have been at every event, 9 did poorer than the last event, 6 improved while one remained the same. Paul Dornburg predicted Jr. Crowe would score a 987 but he was wrong as Jr. came in with a 983, one of the decliners. Barry Beaman slipped too, 964 for AX4 to 953 for AX5. Don Kelley improved +2 to 933 from 931 in the previous event. The next 3 all declined a lot. Dave Lehrschall -46 (worn tires?), Ernie Roales -30 (broken transmission and him trying to drive Dave's Mustang) and John McCarthy was -29 from autocross 4. MacKenzi Crowe only was down -7 on her own course. By the way, MacKenzi also broke the streak of DNFs by course designers as she was on course all day and improved by 5 seconds from run 1 to run 8. Jeff Jackson and Scott Campbell were both up a little bit, +6 & +8, respectively. Jim Cannon was +20 while Steve Backer suffered car problems and wasn't able to complete his last 4 runs, -171. Darwin Graham was +20 for his day while Carolyn Dornburg, although improving from a 71.4 to a 53.3, was off -39 from AX4. Drew Gerth was down slightly, -10 and Andrew Davis was the most improved with a +29.

The course included many long corners which required patience not to over drive. The approach to the crossover after the start could be made in one long turn if done correctly. The long straight after the crossover let everyone's car breath and those American V-8s sounded sweet as did Bob Sonntag's rotary powered LeGrand. The slalom tested one's cars ability to transition while the right turn off the slalom needed lots of brakes and looking ahead to make a long corner to the short straight and some wiggles that lead to the left hand sweeper on the far end of the course. A small 3-cone slalom was next before the charge up the hill to a difficult right hander. After that turn if you got the car over to the right you could slip into the finish quickly before standing on the brakes for your timing slip. Times were generally in the low 50 second range with a few drivers turning mid to high 40s. 46.0, 47.3, 48.0 & 48.4 to name a few were turned by Sonntag, Dornburg, Mike Mounlio, and Jr. Crowe respectively. Next up is the October 4th Gran Prix Deux by the Campbells.
