

championship points' events held for each. Sadly, we are ending the year with a postponement of our awards banquet into next year and the cancelation of our November fun autocross event. The sometimes weather-interrupted Thanksgiving fun autocross fell victim to surging COVID-19 cases and additional group gathering restrictions. This was not an easy decision for the board. Most of us participate in every Southern Indiana Region event. Many will travel as far as Lincoln, Nebraska for

the Nationals, and drive to participate in other SCCA region's events. Missing a chance to drive across town for an event is disappointing for all of us.

Many of you joined us for Zoom meetings and the SIR COVID-19 policy rollout earlier in the year. You know that the board has invested a lot of time and energy into getting this policy in place, sold to the airport authority, and the policy communication to our members. Not everyone is happy with the decision to cancel this year's November, fun autocross event. We're not happy that we had to make this decision either. We felt we needed to make the decision to keep our members', participants', and walk-up observers' safe.

We would really like to participate in a local autocross and to give non-members a chance to experience autocross. This has been a draw for new members. The unsecure venue and the history of observers showing up in large numbers was one of the biggest issues. We considered switching to the Lawrenceville site, but it requires months to get airport, then FAA, and finally sanction approvals. We could not get that done. The latest restriction on crowd sizes and being told that we couldn't hold this event if we were going to exceed the 50 person participation level was a key factor. We would have to count the observers as well as the drivers in our group. We would reach the group limit even with a plan for registration limited to 2020 autocross participants only.

I do appreciate the feedback that I've received, and I understand your frustration. We're all frustrated. The board spent a tremendous amount of time working on plans that would allow us to compete with the safety of our participants and observers in mind during this pandemic. With your cooperation we have kept our participants safe and followed our required COVID-19 policy to maintain the support of our autocross facilities' hosts. We don't own these properties and our activities don't show in their strategic business plans. Our first priority is our participant's safety, but we also need to remember that bad press for the city or airport due to negative press for them due to our event might end our privilege of using the city's Roberts Park or the airport in the future. We continually look for additional venues. We have no other options, today.

We will plan on another Zoom meeting for our next membership meeting on December 8th, at 7:00 PM. The meeting invitation link and password will be sent to our SIR e-mail distribution two days beforehand. Smitty's is open with social distancing guidelines in place. Several of our members plan to attend our meeting from Smitty's. Contact Bob at treasurer@sirscca.org if you plan to join them at Smitty's so they may plan accordingly. Windy Hollow Adventure Rally

The last rally of the 2020 season was contested on a sunny Sunday in Daviess county Kentucky. It started from the Windy Hollow restaurant and went south and east towards Whitesville before meandering west and north to end up in the area of the Dairy Queen on US-231. This event would determine the champions for the year. It was between team Roales, Ernie and Sue, and the team of Terry Davis/Bob Sonntag. Four other teams joined including James Bowman and his Mom Diana who drove from the Lexington KY area to participate.

Team Roales were the first car out followed by Davis/Sonntag. The Roales were looking for a win in class B so they could tie Davis and Sonntag for the championship. Terry and Bob were hoping for a class A win so they could claim the championship outright. Things didn't start well for them as they had an uncharacteristic +57 at the first checkpoint while Ernie and Sue had an -11. Richard Litov and Mike Zeller got off to a splendid start with a zero at checkpoint 1 but it went down hill from there starting with a missed turn halfway to the second checkpoint. Third starting Dave and Suellyn Lehrschall hit checkpoint 1 just 2 seconds late. It was a portend of things to come. James and Diana had a -24 at checkpoint 1 while early season B class leader Jim Cannon, with new navigator Paula Blaize, had a -38. Terry and Bob recovered to record zeros at the next 2 checkpoints while the Lehrschalls continued to score well with a -2 and a -10. After checkpoint 4 was the halfway break and the Lehrschall's (41) had 60-point lead in A class over Terry and Bob. (101) Richard and Mike were just out sightseeing at this point. In B class Ernie and Sue (37) had a 46-point lead over James and Diana (83) who were just ahead of Jim and Paula. (88)

After the rest stop Dave and Sue continued their precise rallying with 6 single digit scores and a zero for the final 7 checkpoints for a total score of 84. Terry and Bob had 4 single digit scores and a zero but their 33 at the 5th checkpoint sealed their fate and gave them a total score of 186. In B class the Roales had 5 single digit scores to finish with a score of 85. The Bowmans scored well and finished second in class B with a 163 final score. Cannon and Blaize started the second half with a checkpoint 5 score of 115 which shot their chance at a class win. They finished with a 291.

As you can see in the results below team Lehrschall bested team Roales by 1 point, 84 to 85, for low total of the rally. The class B win by the Roales put them in a tie for the season championship with Terry and Bob. Congratulations to both teams for persevering in this virus plagued season.

2021 Board of Directors



Regional Executive: MacKenzi Payne-Crowe is returning to the role as Regional Executive in 2021. MacKenzi has been a club member since 2013 and was the 2019 Regional Executive. She's been an advocate for more female participation since 2016 when she was first affiliated with the Board. She has been to the last 4 Solo Nationals with a 2018 3rd place trophy her best finish so far. While at the Solo Nationals she has been to the annual Women's Luncheon meeting to discuss furthering the role of Women in the SCCA. This year she was 12th in autocross points and 17th in Berry points.



Assistant Regional Executive: Jonathan Crowe, also known as Jr., is starting his 5th year on the Board. He joined the SCCA in July of 2010 and was persuaded to join the board in 2016. His primary interest is autocross and he's been to the last 4 Solo Nationals. Jr. finished 2nd again in the 2020 autocross points driving Kenzi, the Crowe family Porsche Cayman. He was also 7th in Berry points this year.



Secretary: Ernie Roales has been an SCCA member since 2009 and in in his 2nd year as club secretary. He intends to compete for all the club trophies in 2021. ERnie has been the event marshal for a few autocrosses known as "Quick & Dirty". He also hosts a road rally in the Robinson IL area. In 2020 ERnie tied for 1st in rally points, finished 2nd in Berry points, and 14th in autocross points, after a transmission problem with his Civic.



Treasurer: Bob Sonntag is a long time SCCA member, 40 years, most of which are with SIR although he did spend a few years in the southwest when his job changed. He's been a board member for a long time holding most of the positions available over the years. He's won the club's Berry Trophy many, many time as well as the Autocross and Rally trophies many times. His favorite SCCA activity is rallying. He enjoys putting them on as well as competing. This year he was 1st in Berry points (again), tied for 1st in the rally points, and finished 25th in autocross points after not competing in the first 2 events.



Activities Chair: Dave Lehrschall is our AC after a year as the Regional Executive. Dave's been an SCCA member for 16 years and joined our region in November of 2012. Dave is always eager for warm weather so he can autocross his red 2020 Mustang. He has gone to the last 4 Solo Nationals competing in F Street. In 2020 he was 6th in autocross points, 5th in rally points, and 6th in Berry points.



Assistant Activity Chairman: Barry Beaman has been a long-time car guy and has been with the club since 2001. This is his second year as AAC. When driving his red Honda S2000 he is always at the top of the list of competitive autocrossers in our club, winning championships in 2011 and 2017. In 2020 Barry was 8th in Berry points and 3rd in autocross points.



Women's Chair: Dawn Sturgeon joins the Board having served previously as a committee member. She joined our region in 2016 and autocross is her primary interest although she has entered a few rallies. She has been to the Solo Nationals a few times competing in D Street in her Subaru. In 2020 she was 17th in autocross points and 28th in Berry points.



Pit Stop Newsletter editor: Since 2000, Paul Dornburg has been on the Board every year, except 2014. Paul joined the SCCA in 1996 and it took 4 years for Ken Andrew to talk him into joining the Board. Paul starts his 12th year as the newsletter editor. He also has a 5-year stint as Regional Executive 2006 to 2010. Paul's favorite club activity is autocrossing where he's been the autocross points champion 9 times since 2000. He also has a Rally championship somewhere in the 20+ years he's been with the club. This year he was first in autocross points for the third year in a row. He also was tied for 6th in rally points and he was 3rd in Berry points.



Advisor: Although not an official Board member now, Terry Davis has filled almost all the Board spots since joining the club back in 1972. (48 years) He attends almost all the Board meetings to offer advice, guidance and history. He also makes the requests for event sanctions for all our autocrosses and rallys. He's been going to the Solo Nationals for over 20 years and is a constant competitor in all our events. In 2020 he was tied for 1st in rally points, 4th in Berry points, and 26th in autocross points.
