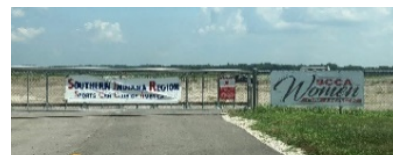

Call to Order by Regional Executive MacKenzi Crowe at 6:44 PM via Zoom with 8 attendees.

Officer Reports:

- **Treasurer:** Bob Sonntag shared that the balance on-hand is \$5,309.36 plus he shared supplemental reports on monthly balances and a Bowler recap.
- **Activities Chair:** Dave Lehrschall stated he has completed Road Rally Safety Steward online training and suggests several others also complete that and the Comp Regs may need corresponding updates.
- **Pit Stop Editor:** Paul Dornburg reported the deadline for newsletter submissions is June 30th.
- **Women's Chair:** Dawn Sturgeon will be distributing flyers for the Ladies Only autocross at Cars and Coffee this coming Sunday.
- **Advisor:** Terry Davis reported he is up to date on sanction and insurance requests.

Old Business

- **Bowler Event:** Paul recapped event club netted approx. \$760. Discussion on whether to award Berry Points to volunteers. Motion to do so by Dave with second by Terry. The motion passed.

Report from Great Lakes Division Solo at Grissom AFB, Peru, IN – Ernie Roales

Saturday started rainy but it cleared off before our runs started and we ran on a dry course. There were 114 entries that got a total of 6 runs. My class, D Street, had 8 entries and I finished 2nd in the class. The winner was in another Honda Type R with new Falcon tires. I was 18th in indexed time. The course was very swoopy with times around 50 seconds.

Sunday was dry and warmer. The course was very swoopy but with a couple of tighter sections and ran 1.5 to 2 seconds slower than the Saturday course. I finished second again to the same driver and I got a similar index finish. It was a great time with lots of friendly people. – ER

Gabe Fehribach Racing at Watkins Glen

The weekend of June 18-20 saw SIR member Gabe Fehribach compete in the final of ten regular season Hoosier Tire Super Tour events of the year at Watkins Glen International (WGI) in beautiful west-central New York. WGI has a long history of esteemed racing series on its track from Formula 1, CART, and IndyCar to the current IMSA and NASCAR series.

All-in-all it was a flawless weekend for the #9 Formula Enterprises 2 (FE2) driver in only his second trip to WGI. The only trouble was a slower (and apparently clueless) FE2 competitor chopping Gabe's nose during practice on Friday morning at turn 8, bending his front wing into the shape of a taco. Following two sessions of qualifying, one on Friday afternoon and one on Saturday morning, Gabe would line up 4th of nine FE2's with an 11th overall grid spot of 22 cars with a time of 1:54.177. It was Gabe's goal to beat 1:55.000 this weekend, so check off that goal.

The 25 minute or 14 lap Race 1 on Saturday afternoon would go green the whole way from the start. Overall winner John McAleer in his mega-quick Elan DP02 Prototype 1 (P1) ensured the field saw all 14 laps before the 25-minute time expired. When a front-running FE2 retired with an engine issue around lap 9, Gabe needed to ensure his 3rd-place finish by hitting all of his marks and bring the car home; he did just that and finished on the lead lap with the P1. Staying with the front-runners, lapping slower cars and making a last-lap pass on a fast Formula Atlantic, Gabe finished 3rd in the FE2 class and 7th overall! The SIR member out-did his qualifying time by setting a 1:53.913 on lap 8 just before reaching some of the back-markers that would slow his remaining laps. At the podium celebration, Hoosier Tire Super Tour race director Doug Nickel approached Gabe and congratulated him on his return and accomplishment after the huge wreck last Summer. Doug looks forward to seeing Gabe more often. The #9 was chosen for post-race technical inspection and passed with flying colors.

Race 2 on Sunday would be 35 minutes or 14 laps, whichever came first, and again the field would see 14 laps before time expired thanks to McAleer. A hard crash of a P1 car at turn 8 would bring out a full course yellow on lap 2 for two laps. Going green at the end of lap 4, Gabe stuck with the lead group the rest of the race. This time he would finish 4th of 9 FE2's and 7th overall again. He missed out on P3 by just 5.9 seconds to the 2019 Formula Enterprises champion. The next closest FE2 in 5th place was 28.82 seconds adrift, about 1/4 lap behind. His top speed in the speed trap was 140.0 mph on lap 5 and his fastest lap was 1:52.781 on lap 10.

Gabe's next scheduled event is the Runoffs at Indianapolis at the end of September. While nothing is scheduled in between, he could compete at a Majors or divisional event to keep the momentum going.

- Results displayed elsewhere in this newsletter may include non-region SCCA members.
- Berry points are awarded to all participants at any club event that is deemed a point paying event. The number of points that can be earned are described in the Comp Regs.
- Rally points are awarded as described in the Comp. Regs.
- Autocross points are determined by adding a driver's single quickest run from each heat, then multiplying that total by the car's class index number. That resulting number is compared to the driver that establishes the quickest total by dividing the driver's indexed total by the quickest indexed total times 1000. The quickest driver gets 1000 points.
- Autocross class points are determined by a driver's single quickest run of the day.
- Rookie points are calculated by the number of points earned divided by the number of points available during the June to November period of the entrants Rookie year.
