Call to Order at 6:30 by Junior Crowe

#### Officer Reports

- **Secretary:** ERnie Roales moved that the minutes be accepted as published in the Pit Stop. Second by Terry Davis. Motion carried.
- **Treasurer:** Bob Sonntag reports a balance of total funds of \$6,770.34 and no outstanding payables. Treasurer's report accepted.
- Pit Stop: deadline of Wednesday, August 30th, reported by RE JR Crowe.
- Activities Chair: Steve Backer had nothing to report.
- Assistant Activities Chair: Jim Cannon had nothing to report.
- Advisor: Terry Davis advises that all sanction/insurance up to date.

- Bob Sonntag proposed a policy on dealing with problem charge cards used in MSR:
  - "For those with a current history of MSR payment failures (their prior two contiguous event registrations), the club will charge their card after the close of registration and before the event. Should that charge fail, cash must be presented at registration check-in to complete the registration. Otherwise, the potential entrants are deemed to have failed to complete the registration before event registration closed." Motion by Bob; second by Terry Davis; motion carried.
- Comp Reg change suggested by Dave Lehrschall to decrease the maximum checkpoint score for rallies was discussed. The consensus was to make no change. The maximum checkpoint score remains 1800.

The following weekend, I was at the CAM Solo event in Indiana (8/11, 8/12) as well as a Club Racing event at MidOhio (8/13). That was followed by flagging a Club Race at Grattan (8/19, 8/20). September doesn't slow down as I'll be at the Solo Nationals (9/3-9/9) and the Runoffs (9/23-10/2).

As an aside, I bought a new EV on 7/31 and as of this writing she has 4,515 miles. Trips to KC, Grissom/MidOhio, Grattan and the Halkias memorial service all added up to a lot of cockpit time these past few weeks. With Championship season upon us, there will be many more in the next month before my hip replacement surgery on 10/5. With all of that on my plate next month, I may not have time to craft an October update for you. But I'll be sitting around a lot after my surgery so count on one in November.

So, here's what I did this past month.....

#### Video Conference Meetings:

- Club Racing Board (CRB) (8/1): As I was driving to Kansas City for the CRB and BoD meetings, I was not able to sit in on this meeting. The results of all of the CRB rules changes can be seen <a href="here">here</a>.
- ➤ Electrified Vehicle Advisory Committee (EVAC) (8/9): With a bit of a hiatus due to the BoD meeting, we reviewed our action items and plotted a course for moving forward during championship season.
- ➤ Board of Directors (BoD) (8/22): The BoD got an update from Heyward Wagner on the incident at the Hillclimb event that had a fatality.
- ➤ BoD (8/28): We had a short agenda as championship season is coming up and all programs are preparing for that. Our financials look fine. We are behind the curve a bit as YTD entries and sanction fees are down due to poor weather in the early part of the year.

#### SCCA Events:

- CRB meeting (8/3): We discussed some of the long term, strategic topics that were brought up back at the spring face to face meeting. How would the Runoffs change in the next few years? What classes would be involved? How would the Club Racing program differ from its current incarnation? We also chatted about more immediate issues like "halos" on formula cars, the SMX class, in car flagging systems, etc.
- ➤ BoD meeting (8/4, 8/5): The BoD meeting would last two days so we could cover the usual oversight items (financials, program status, Enterprises, etc.) but also work on our own governance (bylaws, term limits, etc.). It was an effective series of meetings, and we continue to lay the groundwork for future success. We have a very good set of Directors all working for the greater good of the Club.

## **ADULT ANNUAL WAIVERS**

SCCA Members over the Age of Majority (typically 18 years of age) can add an Annual Waiver digitally through the Member Account Portal.

### MINOR ANNUAL WAIVERS

A minor taking part in an SCCA event as a competitor, on track participant, or volunteer or worker with access to restricted (hot) areas must have an **Annual Minor Waiver** on file for the calendar year. Age of Majority is 18 years except in AL and NE at 19; MS at 21.

The Annual Waiver Minor License will be issued to the Minor by the SCCA National Office when the following requirements are met:

Parent 1 logs into his/her account and digitally completes "Annual Waiver Minor Parental Consent"



Parent 2 logs into his/her account and digitally completes "Annual Waiver Minor Parental Consent"



Minor logs into his/her account and digitally completes "Annual Waiver Minor"


#### WHAT'S NEXT?

  - o Incomplete: waiver invalid, requirements not yet met
  - Terminated: waiver invalid, photo not acceptable; process must be restarted

### PROOF OF MEMBERSHIP/ANNUAL WAIVER AT EVENTS

- → An Annual Waiver is valid with an active membership
- → Acceptable forms of proof of membership at events include physical or digital membership cards with 'Valid Thru' date equal to or after the event date:
  - o Physical membership card prints when membership renews (once per year)
  - Digital membership card available 24/7/365 on any mobile device
    - Retrieve on demand at your convenience; card is always current
    - Add a shortcut to your phone's home screen
      - Tap "My Membership Card" from "My Profile Page"
      - Tap Share icon (iPhone @ bottom, iPad @ top, Android @ menu icon, upper right)
      - Tap "Add to Homescreen" from the menu
      - Type in a name for your shortcut e.g. "My SCCA Card"
      - Tap "Add"
