2024 Patch Parties

Another successful autocross course patching effort is in the book. The work was done over 3 days on 2 consecutive weekends. Day 1, Saturday April 20, saw most of the holes sawed, jackhammered, and dug out. We returned for day 2 on Sunday and finished off the holes. By the end of the first weekend all the holes were dug out and all the quick-patch areas were filled.

A strong turnout of 26 people made the concrete pour day go very smoothly. In fact, the only hiccup was the cement mixer springing a coolant leak. We scrambled around and were able to put a temporary patch on the leaking coolant line so the mixer could make it back to it's base. That repair work got us a \$75 discount on the cement cost.

Notes from the Director's Chair - Area 4 Director Update for May 2024

The meetings about racing are over and now it's time, literally, for the rubber to hit the road. I'll be heading to Mid-Ohio for the Hoosier Super Tour event hosted by OVR this month.

So, here's what I did this past month.....

Video Conference Meetings:

- Club Racing Board (CRB) (4/2): The CRB had its usual monthly meeting and they ran through scores of letters. The group also tied up some loose ends from our at the face to face meeting that was held in Kansas City last month. As the Hoosier Super Tour is well under way, a conversation was had about attendance at the June Sprints. Preparations are being made for the Runoffs as well. The results of all of the CRB rules changes can be seen [here](#).
- Electrified Vehicle Advisory Committee (EVAC) (4/10): The Rally Cross Board (RXB) Chair (Gonzalo San Miguel) sat in on our meeting. His committee is wrestling with some EV related classification rules and was seeking guidance from us on how to construct the language needed. This was a big step for us. We are now at the point where the EVAC has other program boards requesting guidance. This level of legitimacy is very much appreciated. We continue to work on a "Fact Sheet" for regions and venues to use when investigating EV participation. We have worked on the various definitions of "hybrid" for the SCCA. As there are so many variants of a hybrid EV, we need to specify the language for our members. This will help see what cars can compete and how we deal with them. We also discussed a new letter that came to us via the CRB letter portal.
- Board of Directors (BoD) (4/22): We reviewed the Non-Disclosure Agreement (NDA) that has been written for the Directors to sign. As you can imagine, we discuss many details of Club operations that need to remain in confidence. If a Director deliberately leaks some of these details, it can be disastrous for the Club.....on a variety of levels. We also reviewed the compensation package that we've offered Mike Cobb. I gave an EVAC update for the group.
- CRB (4/25): A group from the CRB, BoD and Staff met via Zoom call to collate the ideas we worked on at our face-to-face meeting. Progress is being made but further work continues to be done.

SCCA Members over the Age of Majority (typically 18 years of age) can add an Annual Waiver digitally through the Member Account Portal.

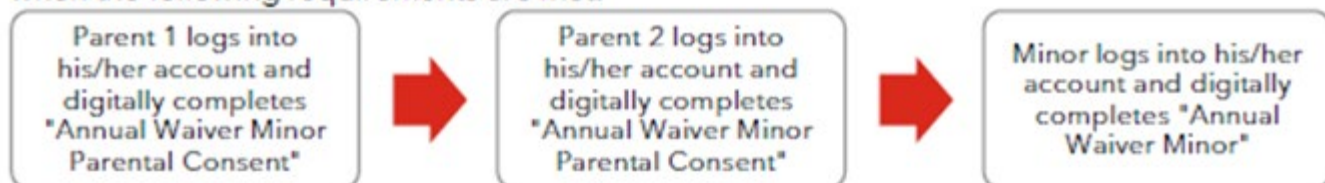

MINOR ANNUAL WAIVERS

A minor taking part in an SCCA event as a competitor, on track participant, or volunteer or worker with access to restricted (hot) areas must have an **Annual Minor Waiver** on file for the calendar year. Age of Majority is 18 years except in AL and NE at 19; MS at 21.

The Annual Waiver Minor License will be issued to the Minor by the SCCA National Office when the following requirements are met:

 - b. Parents must have the Minor's name, date of birth & SCCA Member #
 - c. Minors must have names and SCCA Member #s for parents/legal guardians
4. Follow the prompts at the top right of the screen
 - a. Legal Sole Custodians must indicate **sole custody** with checkbox
5. Complete checkout

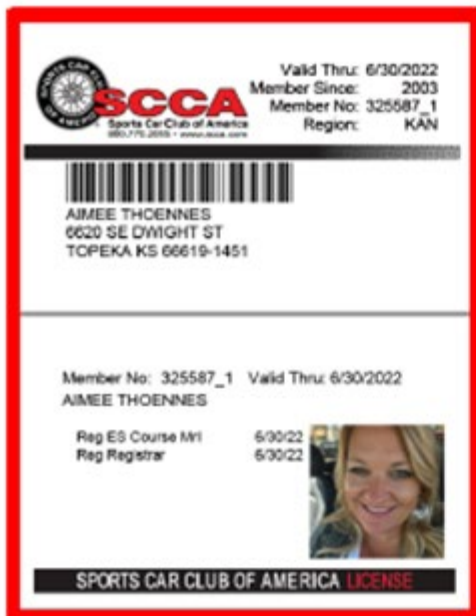
- Check inbox for email confirming "under review"
- Check inbox for email indicating status and next steps: active, incomplete or terminated (should arrive in less than 24 hours, not including weekends/holidays)
 - **Active:** waiver valid through December 31 - "ready to go!"
 - **Incomplete:** waiver invalid, requirements not yet met
 - **Terminated:** waiver invalid, photo not acceptable; process must be restarted
