April RE Report

Two thirds of our autocross course work is done. All we have to do is pour concrete. 21 people were at the first Dig Day and dug about half the marked holes. The weather was sunny but the wind was brutal. We emptied the dump trailer twice and it holds about 10,000 lbs.

The next day only 10 people showed up, but they worked their butts off, not that the people who worked the first day didn't work hard. When we started around 10 am it was pouring rain. That was good for

dust control, but it made scaping the rocks out of the holes more difficult. Around 11:30 the sun peaked out and the rain stopped for the rest of the day but not the wind. And, just like Saturday, we filled the dump trailer twice.

The concrete pour day is Saturday April 5th, weather permitting. Keep an eye on your email for updates.

The competition season has already started with Team Sonntag/Davis putting on the "Scrambled Legs" road rally. The Class B teams put a whoopin' on the class A teams. Josie and I had the only two-digit score of the event and 4 of the 5 class B cars beat all the A class cars. Come to the club meeting on April 8th to hear the stories/excuses.

Annual Waivers

The SIR BoD encourages each SCCA member to get his or her free annual waiver. To help "motivate" SIR members to do that, we charge SIR members using an event SpeedWaiver an extra \$5. We have also stopped using the paper event waiver.

Here's the step-by-step process in a slightly different form than is typically at the end of each edition of Pit Stop.

- 1) Have a reasonable picture of your face ready to upload from the device you use to get your annual waiver. Your full face must be visible. No helmet, no dark glasses, no mask, etc.
- 2) Log into my.scca.com.
- 3) On a PC, mouse over the "Online Store" on the menu line. It's two in from the right.
 - On a smart phone, expand the menu, then expand the "Online Store" option. It's two up from the bottom of the list.
- 4) Select the "License & Waivers" option.
- 5) Add the "Annual Waiver Adult" option to the cart.
- 6) Follow the instructions on the screen AND remember to follow through on the checkout process.
 - l'da listed those steps too but I can't get a second annual waiver. (Sorry.)
- 7) There is a "real-person" review (mostly to check pictures) that happens in the SCCA office. If you've completed your side of the process outside of SCCA office hours, there will be at least a day's delay in the issuance of the annual waiver. There are no annual waivers left in a pre-review state by the end of business on Fridays.

This also seems like a good time mention that the SCCA Minor Event waiver is now available only online and requires support from the SCCA staff. Thus, there is no way to get a minor waiver on a weekend. Plan accordingly. The process begins with steps 1 through 4 above.

Critique Notes:

Ckpt #1: Second Stop Ahead sign (before crossing US41).

Ckpt #2: Stars & Strips on the left.

Ckpt #3: Armstrong Community Ctr utility pole.

Ckpt #4: Milk jug garden (now blue and yellow survey flags).

Ckpt #5: Road goes right sign outside of Posevville.

Ckpt #6: SRIP "Welcome to Indiana" on left. (As if there was another.)

Ckpt #7: SRIP "ST. PETER'S" on left.

Ckpt #8: SRIP "St. Paul's" and begin end-of-route FZ.

In A, the secret for improved finish was to NOT phone for help. The teams that did took a heavy, but better than max, penalty for the consultation and/or assistance.

- Dave & Steve went from a 60 (w/ good TA usage on the recovery) at Ckpt 3 to not 60...but did then save the 150 for the associated Off Course control. (Coulda finished with a 259.) I'm pretty sure they second guessed themselves into the problem.
- Peggy & Lucy had a little trouble counting to four. Without their consultation, they'd have finished with 391...just 7 seconds adrift of Kayla & Kurt. AND if Peggy & Lucy had stayed ONTO correctly, they'd have finished with a 241 for the lowest A class score.

In B, Team Crowe ruled and finished the day with the lowest score overall, 65. Jim & Carrie made it through the Trapp Road tricky stuff without issue then missed counting to two correctly or something. They finished the day second in class and second overall.

I hope those few observations have motivated one or more of you to write something up about the rally for <u>Pit Stop.</u>

Our next rally is May 18th by Team Davis.

Notes from the Director's Chair Area 4 Director Update for April 2025

Spring is rearing its head which means it's time for regions to work on events for the summer competition season. I have a trip to KC this month and I'm off to MidOhio for the OVR HST in May.

I want to start this month's update by addressing the 800-pound gorilla in the room. On 3/14, a major social media frenzy erupted over some proposed, corrected language in the GCR that was published in FasTrack. While the language in the revised edition was corrected grammatically, a firestorm ignited over some pronouns used in the text. A Chair of the CRB, I can assure everyone that no ill intent was meant. We listened to the feedback, recognized the error and are already working on revising the GCR and all other SCCA rules books to use more inclusive and welcoming terminology. Please bear with us as this will take some time to get it right.

Here's what I did since my last report.....

Video Conference Meetings:

- ➤ Club Racing Board (CRB) (3/4): We discussed a wide variety of topics including GT3 and STU data collection, tire marking, reginal classes, SM and SMX tires, and the Rush sports racer. We also worked on the agenda of the face-to-face meeting out in Kansas City (4/11, 4/12). The results of all of the CRB rules changes can be seen here.
- ➤ Electrified Vehicle Advisory Committee (EVAC) (3/12): Steve Hyatt was our special guest for this meeting. He is the SCCA's representative on the National Fire Protection Association (NFPA). He is on a standing committee that reviews racetrack safety protocols. This group issues revised guidelines every few years and they are currently working on the 2028 version. We agreed to stay in touch as each group could benefit from the sharing of language for their respective committees. We also reviewed the GCR language concerning SCREV. We also discussed Appendix K from the Solo rules.
- Runoffs Tech Staff (3/18): As CRB Chair, I was invited to the quarterly meeting of the Runoffs Technical Staff group. This was made up of various tech inspectors that will attend the Runoffs, the Technical Staff folks and others who were involved with inspecting cars at the Runoffs. As it is early in the season, there wasn't too much to discuss as very few trends have emerged from the early season races. I updated them about items on the CRB agenda that had import to them.
- ➤ Board of Directors (3/24): The new IT Director was introduced to us. His name is Kevin Dayo. Speaking of replacements, Justin Hawkins will be replacing Jeff Dahnert in a few weeks. They'll overlap while the annual audit is performed. Both of these fellows will be great additions to the management team out in Topeka. As to the financials, we are a bit behind the curve so far but it's early and we have plenty of time to catch up. We went into the Executive Session to hear about the firestorm that erupted on 3/14. Kristen Poole gave us details about the number of Facebook posts, views, traffic, etc. As I am not a Facebook guy, I was appalled to see what some people wrote about the situation. She showed some screenshots of posts, and it made me very angry. As I stated above, we are working tirelessly on solving this issue and ask for your patience as we work through this.
