Annual Waivers

The SIR BoD encourages each SCCA member to get his or her free annual waiver. To help "motivate" SIR members to do that, we charge SIR members using an event SpeedWaiver an extra \$5. We have also stopped using the paper event waiver.

Here's the step-by-step process in a slightly different form than is typically at the end of each edition of Pit Stop.

- 1) Have a reasonable picture of your face ready to upload from the device you use to get your annual waiver. Your full face must be visible. No helmet, no dark glasses, no mask, etc.
- 2) Log into my.scca.com.
- 3) On a PC, mouse over the "Online Store" on the menu line. It's two in from the right.
On a smart phone, expand the menu, then expand the "Online Store" option. It's two up from the bottom of the list.
- 4) Select the "License & Waivers" option.
- 5) Add the "Annual Waiver Adult" option to the cart.
- 6) Follow the instructions on the screen AND remember to follow through on the checkout process.
 - o I'da listed those steps too but I can't get a second annual waiver. (Sorry.)
- 7) There is a "real-person" review (mostly to check pictures) that happens in the SCCA office. If you've completed your side of the process outside of SCCA office hours, there will be at least a day's delay in the issuance of the annual waiver. There are no annual waivers left in a pre-review state by the end of business on Fridays.

This also seems like a good time mention that the SCCA Minor Event waiver is now available only online and requires support from the SCCA staff. Thus, there is no way to get a minor waiver on a weekend. Plan accordingly. The process begins with steps 1 through 4 above.

10 teams assembled at the Lic's Deli & Ice Cream Shop in Owensboro, KY, for the 2nd round of the 2025 SIR Rally season. They came from far away in Findlay & Columbus, OH, Robinson, IL, Jasper/Petersburg, IN, Louisville, KY, and from nearby Evansville, IN.

It was a good battle in A Class between Team Sellers/Ford and Team Lehrschall. The Lehrschalls led at the halfway point by 3 seconds and started the 2nd half with scores of 1 and 2. But a score of 22 in on leg 5 was their undoing. Team Sellers/Ford scored just 13 points including a zero on the last leg to take the win with 44 points. Making an uncharacteristic mistake early on doomed Team Davis/Sonntag despite having just 4 total points on 4 legs which included 2 zeroes. Results for Points Autocross #2 WHEW!

Class Results Summary

For the second autocross of 2025 Paul Dornburg was event marshal/course designer for the WHEW! Autocross.

A good turnout of 39 drivers made for a long day on the site. Runs started around 11:30 am and finished just a little after 4:00 pm.

It was the debut of a new to SIR timing system. There was new hardware from FarmTek and new cloud-based software from CLOKKR.

The new hardware from FarmTek is pretty much the current gold standard of systems available. Wireless timing lights that can be spread farther apart will lessen the chances of being run over by an errant car. A 7" tall scoreboard was included in the new hardware and clearly shows times down to the thousandth of a second. The new lights also trip as a car enters the beam which is the opposite of the old system that tripped when the car drove out of the lights. No long runs of wire to the timing heads was an improvement so we don't have to worry about rain immobilizing our timing system, stumbling over wires, nor driving over wires which could disable the system. Another new piece of hardware was a laptop. Paul spotted a deeply discounted display model at his Best Buy store and bought it for \$294 + tax. After some work to remove the Microsoft requirements the new laptop boots up in seconds and connects to the cloud through a personal hot spot on any cellular device.

The software is something new to autocross as it is based in the cloud and results can be read on a smart device in real time. Other systems offer real-time results, but this one does not rely on the local computer to store the operating system, it is all done in the cloud. In the event of a computer failure all one has to do is fire up another computer, log in to the CLOKKR website, and continue.

With Jon Schwartze away at an SCCA National Tour event in Peru, IN, someone new set quick to of day. Jarrod Davis put down a blistering 51.574 to beat Jr. Crowe's 52.579 by a little over a second. Jr. was quickest in PAX results with a 43.062 indexed time. Autocross points had Jr. at the top followed by Paul Dornburg, Jarrod Davis, Barry Beaman, and Don Beaman.

Notes from the Director's Chair Area 4 Director Update for May 2025

June has me visiting Road America for the June Sprints (6/5-6/9) and volunteering as Pace Car pilot at a WMR Regional at Grattan Raceway (6/14, 6/15). Meanwhile, the CRB and BoD are getting ready for a face to face meeting in Kansas City in July and the CRB is working hard to prepare for the Runoffs at Road America.

Here's what I did since my last report.....

Video Conference Meetings:

Club Racing Board (CRB) (5/6): I reported on my conversation with Sean Hedrick (Spec Miata Advisory Committee Chair). He had some useful ideas about reaching out to the drivers corps to get them more engaged. There was a conversation about entry numbers for the program so far this season. It appears we are down a bit from last year. This is probably due to a variety of economic conditions which have created uncertainty in budgeting. We discussed the agenda for our upcoming face to face meeting in Kansas City. We also chatted about the preparation for the Runoffs. The results of all of the CRB rules changes can be seen here.

Electrified Vehicle Advisory Committee (EVAC) (5/14): The committee hosted a couple of guests (Jim Garry-NEDiv Solo Safety Steward and Chris Robbins-SCCA Regional Development Director). The EVAC offered guidance to Jim on how his division could implement some basic awareness and safety protocols for EV participation at Solo events. Chris shared how we could use previously created content to generate modules on EV safety for the online Solo Safety Steward refresher course as well as other online safety courses. We also discussed how to integrate the Prototype Electric (PE) and Electric Touring (ET) into the GCR.

Board of Directors (5/19): Due to the Memorial Day holiday, this meeting was held a week earlier than normal. Our financial posture is fine. We are still a bit behind budget but have plenty of time to adjust. We discussed a format change for our F2F meeting in Kansas City in July (7/25, 7/26). The new BoD Chair (Bob Crawford) wants to be able to spend more time on pertinent topics and less on staff updates. This would allow for deeper dives into salient discussions. We also wrapped up the topic of the gender pronouns in our documents. A plan is now in place to revise all SCCA documents (rules packages, by laws, training manuals, etc.) over the next few months. Please be patient as this will take some time to achieve.

SCCA Events:

OVR @ MidOhio (5/16-5/18): I travelled to this event as both Area 4 Director and CRB Chair. I wanted to see how the event was run by the region and national staff. I also used the trip to schedule conversations with several people while I was at the track. The weather was chaotic. 90+F on Thursday for load in, almost as warm on Friday and then cold and windy with on and off showers for Saturday and Sunday. Very nasty storms Friday night/Saturday morning left some canopies in disarray. Ugh! By and large the races went off smoothly. The Production cars had a lap one incident that caused a full course yellow for the rest of the session on Saturday. The remaining groups all went fairly well. I'd count the event as a qualified success. While the entry count was down from 2024, the region put on a pretty good event.
