## **Annual Waivers**

The SIR BoD encourages each SCCA member to get his or her free annual waiver. To help "motivate" SIR members to do that, we charge SIR members using an event SpeedWaiver an extra \$5. We have also stopped using the paper event waiver.

Here's the step-by-step process in a slightly different form than is typically at the end of each edition of Pit Stop.

- 1) Have a reasonable picture of your face ready to upload from the device you use to get your annual waiver. Your full face must be visible. No helmet, no dark glasses, no mask, etc.
- 2) Log into [my.scca.com](http://my.scca.com).
- 3) On a PC, mouse over the "Online Store" on the menu line. It's two in from the right.  
On a smart phone, expand the menu, then expand the "Online Store" option. It's two up from the bottom of the list.
- 4) Select the "License & Waivers" option.
- 5) Add the "Annual Waiver Adult" option to the cart.
- 6) Follow the instructions on the screen AND remember to follow through on the checkout process.
  - o I'da listed those steps too but I can't get a second annual waiver. (Sorry.)
- 7) There is a "real-person" review (mostly to check pictures) that happens in the SCCA office. If you've completed your side of the process outside of SCCA office hours, there will be at least a day's delay in the issuance of the annual waiver. There are no annual waivers left in a pre-review state by the end of business on Fridays.

This also seems like a good time mention that the SCCA Minor Event waiver is now available only online and requires support from the SCCA staff. Thus, there is no way to get a minor waiver on a weekend. Plan accordingly. The process begins with steps 1 through 4 above.

It's not been the best Spring for Team Davis. Some medical ills kept us from participating in the season's first two rallies. June 29<sup>th</sup> was looking good for our first attempt to compete this season. Hmmmmm. Starts in Jasper. We can find Jasper. Starts on Central time in a part of Indiana that is on Eastern time. Seems odd but we can deal with it.

The car needed prepped for competition. A quick litter removal from the interior and a drive through car wash and the car is set. My old phone with a cracked screen is mounted in its place on the dash, the Rabbit Rally 2.0 app is started and timing control center is set. The navigator's clipboard holding the stopwatch and phone for the Richta scoring app completes the rally tools for the team.

A bit of rain was encountered on the drive to Jasper. However the rest of the day was rain free until we headed north for home after the event. Steve Backer had set up a course to follow one of his bike rides. Don't ever dare him to race on a bike. Our Prius strained so much on some of the hills I thought I should help pedal.

Since I wasn't pedaling, the course was a lot of fun. Until we rolled into Ferdinand. The instruction as we entered town was Left at T CAST 35. I stopped at the T, reset Rally Rabbit to monitor the new CAST, turned left and floored the Prius to accelerate to the new average. ### Notes from the Director's Chair Area 4 Director Update for July 2025

July has the CRB and BoD face to face meetings in Kansas City and the CRB is working hard to prepare for the Runoffs at Road America.

I've been asked by Frank Schwartz (divisional Club Racing points keeper) to alert the membership about a couple of things. One, the GLDiv points are now stashed in the cloud. Go to the [GLDiv site](#), choose Programs and then Road Racing. When the page loads, choose "Click here for current points standings". You'll find the spreadsheet there. Two, decals are required to participate in the Regional Championship Series (RCS). These decals should be available at the track. Check with the folks in Tech. If you have any questions, please drop an email to [Frank](#) and he'll help you out.

Here's what I did since my last report.....

#### Video Conference Meetings:

- Club Racing Board (CRB) (6/3): The group discussed SMX at length. The sealed engine idea has been turned into a "What do you think" (WDYT) and will be sent to the populous in the next Fastrack. SMX data reports were reviewed. The FSRAC will be conducting a survey of FV drivers about a tire rule. Once again, we continued the discussion on the agenda for our upcoming face to face meeting in Kansas City. We also chatted about the preparation for the Runoffs. The results of all of the CRB rules changes can be seen [here](#).
- Electrified Vehicle Advisory Committee (EVAC) (6/11): This meeting was cancelled due to family being in town.
- Board of Directors (6/23): We reviewed the report on the 2024 audit. It showed some very good numbers for the year. As for 2025, our financial posture is fine. We are still a bit behind budget and corrections are being made to accommodate the minor shortfall. We discussed a 'member behaving badly' with Chris Robbins. We reviewed the SCCA Foundation grant process and will work to streamline it for future recipients. We also discussed the logistics of our F2F meeting in July.

#### SCCA Events:

- CHI @ Road America (6/6 - 6/8): For this event I had my CRB Chair hat on. Like the MidOhio trip, I also used the visit to schedule conversations with several people while I was at the track. I had a broad agenda and would need all three days to accomplish it. Fortunately, the weather cooperated this year. I had my ebike and I rode 23 miles inside the track during the weekend as meetings and conversations were held at a wide variety of locations. In the end, I am glad I went. I was able to split time between "business" and watching sessions. What a great facility.....I can't wait for the Runoffs so I can go back.
- WMR @ Grattan Raceway (6/14, 6/15): Once again, I was asked to drive the pace car and I happily accepted.
