SIM Racing

Hey everyone! A few of us are going to do a little group racing session at Fastest Lap on Sunday, January 11th at 12pm CT and would love to have more people! You will need to book your time from this link here> <https://www.myfastestlap.com/booking> - Choose January 11th, at Noon CT, and at least the 1 hour session. They will fill up fast, as they only have 8 simulators. You do not have to pay until the day of, after your session is over. Please email me/Jon if you book a session, just so we know who will be showing up! Book now, don't wait! If for some reason that time slot fills, choose the next closest time option.

Depending on turnout, we usually do a practice session, qualifying session, and then a short race. Tons of cars to choose from.. Miatas, GT3, LMDH, Formula, NASCAR, Sprint Cars, you name it. Last time we did the GT3 cars, but we don't have to decide on that until we get there.

Fastest Lap is a sim racing arcade with very immersive driving simulators. They are located at 941 N Park Dr, Evansville, IN 47710. They are very heavy duty and expensive simulators, so you will feel the forces of the car, the wind (yes, WIND), and you'll be moving around on a platform. (They can turn it off if you don't like it/can't handle it). You are more than welcome to book as many sessions as you want. I will personally be doing the 2 hour session. Hope to see you there!
