French Lick Karting

Hello everyone! We are going to get together for another winter event, but this time at French Lick Indoor Karting! We are BOOKED for Sunday, February 15th with arrival time at 10:30 EST. The price is \$55 per person, due at arrival. PLEASE contact me if you are planning to go, I have to follow up with them before the 15th with our final number. It will only be our group on the track, no random walk-ins joining our races.

If we for some reason can't get 8 people, it will be 3 regular time trial races, fastest lap wins. If we can get 8 people, we will do a sprint race format which is a 5-lap qualifier, 10 lap heat, and then 15 lap race, scored in the order that you finish. If we go over 10+ people, we'll have to upgrade to the Grand Prix race and may have to do more than one heat, not a big deal, just more racing! This isn't an "SIR Exclusive" event, so bring family/friends if you'd like! (Ages 14+ for OUR races.) There is a pretty nice arcade as well for the younger kids if you bring the whole family!

2026 Entry Fees & Weekend Memberships

For those that read meeting minutes or attended the January membership meeting this will be old news and for the rest, it's news.

After much board discussion over at least two SIR BoD meetings, the 2026 entry fees have been raised slightly and the autocross entry fee expanded.

Starting with the simplest case first, the Weekend Membership fee has been raised from \$20 to \$25. The SCCA has raised the amount regions are invoiced for each Weekend Membership by \$5. SIR passing that along to Weekend Memberships at autocross events and for those drivers in our rally events using Weekend Memberships.

The region will continue to pay for needed Weekend Memberships for navigators in our rally events.

A free one-time-only Trial Membership is available to those that would like to experience an SCCA event from within a vehicle on course. For autocross events, that's riding along as a passenger at one event. In rally events, that's the opportunity to be the navigator one time. (The driver must always be either an Annual/Lifetime member or a Weekend Member.) After using the one-time-only Trial Membership, to be a passenger again at an autocross, a Weekend (or Annual/Lifetime) Membership is required. Likewise, to be a navigator again requires a Weekend (or Annual/Lifetime) Membership.

The per car rally entry fee has been raised from \$37 to \$40. SIR will continue offering the "pay to play" \$5 discount to those having run the previous rally in the year.

The autocross entry fee has also been raised from \$37 to \$40. New is the option for out-of-region entrants to pay a larger entry fee (an addition \$20, \$60 total entry fee) to have the same number of runs as SIR members with two bonus runs. SIR region members CANNOT pay the larger entry fee to have the extra runs. The ONLY way for SIR members to get those extra "bonus" runs is to work the corresponding patch party days.

As a way of explanation, the autocross entry fees are structured to maintain our ability to muster a workforce for patching efforts. As the board explored alternatives, too often we noticed that any difference in the entry fee for the additional runs would be exceptionally tempting those we expect to help with our patching effort. Basically, those that autocross regularly with SIR. An additional \$50/event could have too many opting to buy the extra runs and not earn them. If we lose too much workforce, the work expected of the remaining workforce increases. That decreases the motivation to be in the workforce, and bing, bang, boom, we no longer have the workforce needed to maintain autocross site.

The patch party days are open to all. Anyone working the appropriate patch party days earns the associated bonus run. SIR member or not. SCCA member or not.

We continue to offer a \$10 discount to students. We have discontinued the \$5 discount for multiple entries in the same household.

SIR members without FREE SCCA Annual Waivers using the event SpeedWaiver will be charged \$5 for each use of the event SpeedWaiver. That's a hint! Get your SCCA Annual Waiver.
