Event Results – More Scrambled Legs Road Rally

“Some days even a blind squirrel can find a nut”. . . Team Davis’s day of “More Scrambled Legs”.

As we climbed into the car after the drivers meeting Karen said “My head really isn’t screwed on straight today. I don’t think we’re going to do very good”. Since Karen is the navigator, her responsibility is to tell me where to go and when to get there. All I do is point the car and watch the “Rabbit”. The “Rabbit” is my old cell phone mounted on the dash running Rally Rabbit 2.0 to show us our current average speed. Everything that takes smarts comes from the right seat. Oh well, we just do this for fun, the results aren’t that important. But... Winning is more fun. Right!

As we left the start point to begin the odometer check leg I attempted to reset the car’s trip odometer to compare it to the odometer on our rally odometer. Oops. I changed the car to kilometers an hour instead of miles. My head isn’t screwed on very well either. We quickly fixed that problem, but the distraction hurt our leg one score. Still 10 isn’t a bad score for us. Rally on.

Our club uses the Richta GPS scoring system for rallies. We have our GPS device, my new cell phone, on a clipboard on Karen’s lap so she can keep up with our scores as well as having it handy to enter time allowances. Leg 2’s checkpoint is approaching and passes. The score is displayed. “A zero!” . Karen’s head appears to be screwed on a bit tighter. The course is fun using the country roads to the west of Evansville. A nice challenge that keeps the driver busy. Leg 3. “Another zero!” Karen reads. “Damn, we’re doing OK”, I said. Internally I was wondering how long it was going to take us to screw this up. Leg 4. “Zero!” Now I’m thinking there is something wrong with the GPS scoring system, or those were really just on course, un-scored checkpoints, but, it still sounds good. Leg 5. “Zero!” I’m convinced that something is wrong with the scoring system, but what can I do about it. My job is to point the car and watch the rabbit. Leg 6. “Another Zero” Karen says. “We’re screwed for sure”, I’m thinking. Leg 7 “One.” Hmmmm. Perhaps it is scoring OK. That checkpoint was the start of a mid event break and we needed it. Eleven points at half way is really, really good for us. I’m guessing that Jim and Dawn, our competitors in class A, are doing better, but I’m not asking or telling.

The second half of the rally we started with a one, three and zero. Then we trailed off to an eleven and five. Thirty one for a hundred miles of rally divided into twelve legs. We are unlikely to improve on this, but we promise to try. Oh yeah. Jim and Dawn **did not** do better.

Thanks to Bob Sonntag for setting up the event. Much fun.
