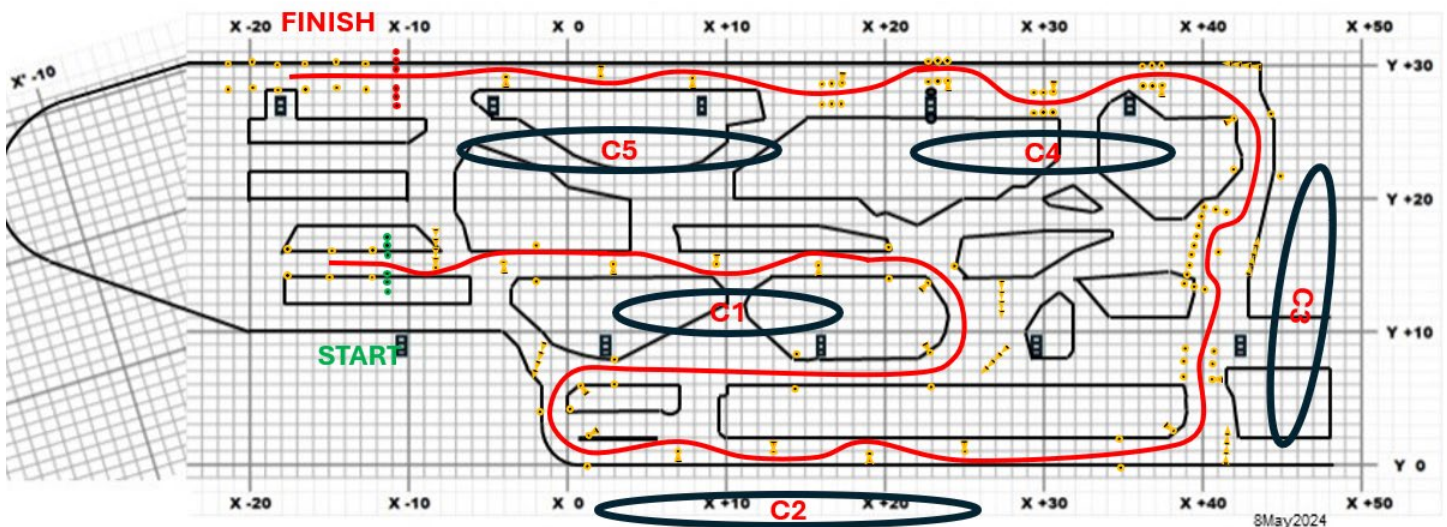


On Saturday May 23rd, we are doing our first Fun Autocross of the year!

Event Results – Autocross Test & Tune and Points Autocross #1 – Quincy’s Quest – by Dave Lehrschaal

Class Results Summary **Quincy's Quest**

On Saturday April 25th, 32 drivers participated in our annual Test & Tune. Those drivers made 317 runs during the day with Terry Lansdale making 24 runs! 15 drivers made at least 10 runs. They started driving at 11:30 am and the last car came off course at 4:53 pm.

The next day 44 drivers gathered at the Mid-American Air Center for the first points autocross of 2026. Dave’s counter-clockwise course had a devilish right-left-right section in the middle course that was bracketed by 2 “hold on” straightaways. It was a fun but taxing course requiring lots of patience in the twisty bits. All results for this event can be found [here](#):

I’ve always enjoyed the first autocross weekend of the season. We start with a fresh count for autocross championship points and for all, a shot at the new year’s championship trophy. Many of us will show up with a different vehicle or at least changes that we hope will give us an edge. Some of us will have read articles on how to master autocrossing skills and will be anxious to try new driving approaches.

So, what better way to start the season than with a Test and Tune course? For the last several years I’ve had the opportunity to design the Southern Indiana Region’s season-opening Test n’ Tune event for Saturday and the first autocross championship points event of the season the next day, Sunday. I like to set up the Test n’ Tune with a combination of course features that challenge both driver and vehicle capabilities. I want to design the Test n’ Tune course, a fun “no points” event, to be more challenging than a regular autocross course so the participants learn more about their vehicles and driving strategies

I recently finished the SCCA autocross course design class. It gave me a few course design ideas and reinforced the emphasis on safety. I thoroughly enjoyed running both days. Yes, they were my designs, but the turns intentionally looked more open than they really were and “looking ahead” was rewarded in many areas. With the help of some hard-working students from the University of Southern Illinois, I reset the course for the autocross for the next day’s points event. It was run in the opposite direction with much of the course unchanged except for added slaloms, opened “pinch-points” at turns, and a your-choice slalom. We had a nice turnout for both days.

I worked a grid assignment on both days. I’ve been a certified solo safety steward for about fifteen years and frequently work as an event SSS. This weekend was fun, but it also reinforced the importance of keeping our eyes open for potential problems, regardless of our worker assignment. A vehicle rolled up in grid and seemed to have an extreme camber setting. I mentioned it to the driver. He checked the tire wear, found it was corded, and called it a day.

The Southern Indiana Region has always put safety first. We’re proud of that. I like knowing we take safety seriously and that we encourage asking questions regarding any safety concerns. We had a safe, challenging, and fun weekend. - Dave Lehrschaal.

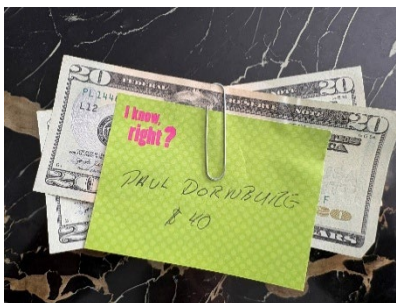
